

## **Deborah and Jael - Godly Women in Difficult Positions - Judges 4**

**Revelation 2&3 Referred to the letters to Churches "Repent or else I will...)**

**1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.**

**Judges 4:1-24 - V1 And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the LORD, when Ehud was dead.**

**Judges 17:6 In those days there was no king in Israel, but every man did that which was right in his own eyes.**

**Judges 17:2 And the LORD sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor; the captain of whose host was Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles.**

**Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.**

**Genesis 18:28 Peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty righteous: wilt thou destroy all the city for lack of five? And he said, If I find there forty and five, I will not destroy it.**

**Judges 17:3 And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel.**

**2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.**

**Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?**

**1 Corinthians 11:30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.**

**1 Samuel 3 Summarized of when the Lord called Samuel & judged Eli.**

**Deborah means Bee.**

**Exodus 23:28 And I will send hornets before thee, which shall drive out the Hivite, the Canaanite, and the Hittite, from before thee.**

**Judges 4:4 And Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel at that time.**

**1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak 2 or 3, and let the other judge.**

**Judges 4:5 And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.**

**2 Samuel 15 Referred to Absalom going out to deceive the people.**

**Judges 4:6 And she sent and called Barak the son of Abinoam out of Kedeshnaphtali, and said unto him, Hath not the LORD God of Israel commanded, saying, Go and draw toward mount Tabor, and take with thee 10,000 men of the children of Naphtali and of the children of Zebulun?**

**Barak means Lightening Flash.**

**Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.**

**Judges 4:7 And I will draw unto thee to the river Kishon Sisera, the captain of Jabin's army, with his chariots and his multitude; and I will deliver him into thine hand.**

**Jeremiah 1:18,19 For, behold, I have made thee this day a defenced city, and an iron pillar, and brasen walls against the whole land, against the kings of Judah, against the princes thereof, against the priests thereof, and against the people of the land. 19 And they shall fight against thee; but they shall not prevail against thee; for I am with thee, saith the LORD, to deliver thee.**

**Isaiah 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.**

**2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.**

**Judges 4:8 And Barak said unto her, If thou wilt go with me, then I will go: but if thou wilt not go with me, then I will not go.**

**Judges 6 Referred to God calling Gideon & the fleece test.**

**Luke 22:32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.**

**Titus 2:4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,**

**Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;**

**Judges 4:9 And she said, I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. And Deborah arose, and went with Barak to Kedesh.**

**1 Timothy 2:12 But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.**

**1 Timothy 3:2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;**

**1 Timothy 3:12 Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well.**

**1 Samuel 17 Referred to Goliath challenging King Saul & the Israelites. V11 When Saul and all Israel heard those words of the Philistine, they were dismayed, and greatly afraid.**

**Judges 4:10-13 And Barak called Zebulun & Naphtali to Kedesh; & he went up with 10,000 men at his feet: and Deborah went up with him. 11 Now Heber**

**the Kenite, which was of the children of Hobab the father in law of Moses, had severed himself from the Kenites, and pitched his tent unto the plain of Zaanaim, which is by Kedesh. 12 And they shewed Sisera that Barak the son of Abinoam was gone up to mount Tabor. 13 And Sisera gathered together all his chariots, even 900 chariots of iron, and all the people that were with him, from Harosheth of the Gentiles unto the river of Kishon.**

**Exodus 14 Referred to when Pharoah & army caught Israelites at the Red Sea. Judges 4:14 And Deborah said unto Barak, Up; for this is the day in which the LORD hath delivered Sisera into thine hand: is not the LORD gone out before thee? So Barak went down from mount Tabor, and ten thousand men after him.**

**1 Samuel 17 Referred to David weapons to defeat Goliath.**

**2 Kings 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.**

**Joshua 5:14 14 And He said, Nay; but as Captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto Him, What saith my Lord unto his servant?**

**Judges 8 Referred to God giving the victory to Gideon.**

**God prepared Samuel, David, etc to do His work.**

**Judges 4:15 And the LORD discomfited Sisera, and all his chariots, and all his host, with the edge of the sword before Barak; so that Sisera lighted down off his chariot, and fled away on his feet.**

**Summarized some mighty Victories of God against the enemy.**

**Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.**

**Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.**

**Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains & rocks, Fall on us, & hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, & from the wrath of the Lamb:**

**Judges 4:16 But Barak pursued after the chariots, and after the host, unto Harosheth of the Gentiles: and all the host of Sisera fell upon the edge of the sword; and there was not a man left.**

**Summarized of many modern error in the churches.**

**Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: & nothing shall by any means hurt you.**

**Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.**

**Judges 4:17** Howbeit Sisera fled away on his feet to the tent of Jael the wife of Heber the Kenite: for there was peace between Jabin the king of Hazor and the house of Heber the Kenite.

**Judges 4:9** And she said, I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. And Deborah arose, and went with Barak to Kedesh.

**Judges 4:18,19** And Jael went out to meet Sisera, and said unto him, Turn in, my lord, turn in to me; fear not. And when he had turned in unto her into the tent, she covered him with a mantle. 19 And he said unto her, Give me, I pray thee, a little water to drink; for I am thirsty. And she opened a bottle of milk, and gave him drink, and covered him.

**Jael means Mountain Goat.**

**Referred to battle tactics of General Jackson.**

**Judges 4:20,21** Again he said unto her, Stand in the door of the tent, and it shall be, when any man doth come and enquire of thee, and say, Is there any man here? that thou shalt say, No. 21 Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.

**1 Chronicles 10:4** Referred to Saul's suicide.

**Judges 4:22,23** And, behold, as Barak pursued Sisera, Jael came out to meet him, and said unto him, Come, and I will shew thee the man whom thou seekest. And when he came into her tent, behold, Sisera lay dead, and the nail was in his temples. 23 So God subdued on that day Jabin the king of Canaan before the children of Israel.

**Many times when the Judges died, the Israelites turned to worship the ungodly gods.**

**Judges 4:24** And the hand of the children of Israel prospered, and prevailed against Jabin the king of Canaan, until they had destroyed Jabin king of Canaan.

**Joshua 1:14** Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle, shall remain in the land which Moses gave you on this side Jordan; but ye shall pass before your brethren armed, all the mighty men of valour, and help them;

**2 Corinthians 10:4** (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

**Ezekiel 13** Referred to the charismatic witchcraft afflicting God's People.
