- Matthew 6:7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Matthew 5 referred to Jesus correcting miss-use of scripture.
- Matthew 8:25 And his disciples came to him, and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we perish.
- Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. 10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. 11 Give us this day our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. 14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.
- 1 Samuel 17 Summarized of David defeating Goliath.
- John 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask Me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in My name, He will give it you.
- Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.
- 1 Chronicles 21 Summarized of David numbering Israel yet God judged the people.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and

- for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Luke 11:1 And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, <u>teach us to pray</u>, as John also taught his disciples.
- Matthew 23:9 And call no *man* your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.
- John 14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- Mark 13:32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.
- Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Matthew 18:3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- Deuteronomy 10:8 At that time the <u>LORD</u> separated the tribe of Levi, to bear the ark of the covenant of the <u>LORD</u>, to stand before the <u>LORD</u> to minister unto him, and to <u>bless</u> in his <u>name</u>, unto this day.
- 1 Chronicles 23:13 The sons of Amram; Aaron and Moses: and Aaron was separated, that he should sanctify the most holy things, he and his sons for ever, to burn incense before the <u>LORD</u>, to minister unto him, and to <u>bless</u> in His <u>name</u> for ever.
- Nehemiah 9:5 Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, and Pethahiah, said, Stand up and bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be Thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise.
- 2 Chronicles 36:23 Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth hath the LORD God of heaven given me; and he hath charged me to build him an house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Who is there among you of all his people? The LORD his God be with him, and let him go up.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; <u>blessed</u> be the name of the LORD.
- Job 1 Summarized of the afflictions of Job.
- Revelation 6:9-11 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: 10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? 11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren,

- that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.
- Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- Psalms 96:2 Sing unto the <u>LORD</u>, <u>bless His name</u>; shew forth His salvation from day to day.
- Psalms 103:1 « *A Psalm* of David. » <u>Bless the LORD</u>, O my soul: and all that is within me, <u>bless His holy name</u>.
- Psalms 113:2 <u>Blessed be the name of the LORD</u> from this time forth and for evermore.
- Psalms 145:1 « David's *Psalm* of praise. » I will extol thee, my <u>God</u>, O king; and I will bless Thy name for ever and ever.
- Psalms 145:21 My mouth shall speak the praise of the <u>LORD</u>: and let all flesh bless His holy name for ever and ever.
- Daniel 2:20 Daniel answered and said, <u>Blessed be the name of God for ever</u> and ever: for wisdom and might are His:
- Matthew 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, <u>Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest</u>.
- Matthew 23:39 For I say unto you, Ye shall not see Me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed *is* He that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- Matthew 23:37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!
- 1 Corinthians 15:6 After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.
- Mark 11:9,10 And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, <u>Hosanna; Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord</u>: 10 <u>Blessed</u> be the kingdom of our father David, that cometh in the <u>name</u> of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest.
- Luke 13:35 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate: and verily I say unto you, Ye shall not see me, until *the time* come when ye shall say, Blessed *is* He that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- Luke 19:38 Saying, <u>Blessed be</u> the <u>King that cometh in the name of the Lord</u>: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.
- John 12:13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, <u>Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.</u>
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in

heaven.

- Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- Revelation 14:6,7 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, 7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
- Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I <u>come</u> quickly. Amen. Even so, <u>come</u>, <u>Lord Jesus</u>.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Luke 16 Referred to the parable of the rich man & Lazarus.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28 Summarized of Lucifer's fall.

- Matthew 24:22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.
- 1 Corinthians 2:8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Job 27:10 Will he delight himself in the Almighty? will he always call upon God?
- Psalms 40:8 I <u>delight</u> to do thy <u>will</u>, O my God: yea, thy law *is* within my heart.
- Hebrews 10:16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those

- days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Deuteronomy 18:9 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations.
- Leviticus 19 Referred to God's views on immorality.
- Psalms 119:47 And <u>I will delight myself in thy commandments</u>, which I have loved.
- Isaiah 58:14 Then shalt thou <u>delight thyself in the LORD</u>; and I <u>will</u> cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken *it*.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- Isaiah 66:4 I also <u>will</u> choose their delusions, and <u>will</u> bring their fears upon them; because when I called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not hear: but they did evil before mine eyes, and chose *that* in which I <u>delighted</u> not.
- Malachi 3:1 Behold, I <u>will</u> send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to His temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye <u>delight</u> in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
