The Spirit Of Lying - 1 Kings 22

- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Mark 14 Referred to Peter lying, denying the Lord.
- Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- Revelation 13 Referred to the mark of the beast.
- Revelation 20:7,8 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, 8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- 1 Kings 22:22,23 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a <u>lying spirit</u> in the mouth of all his prophets. And He said, Thou shalt persuade *him*, and prevail also: go forth, and do so. 23 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a <u>lying spirit</u> in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.
- Deuteronomy 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.
- 2 Chronicles 18:21,22 And he said, I will go out, and be a <u>lying spirit</u> in the mouth of all his prophets. And *the LORD* said, Thou shalt entice *him*, and thou shalt also prevail: go out, and do *even* so. 22 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a <u>lying spirit</u> in the mouth of these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil against thee.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 1 Kings 18 Referred to the shoot out on Mount Carmel.

- 1 Kings 22:1-53 1 And they continued three years without war between Syria and Israel. 2 And it came to pass in the third year, that Jehoshaphat the king of Judah came down to the king of Israel. 3 And the king of Israel said unto his servants, Know ye that Ramoth in Gilead is ours, and we be still, and take it not out of the hand of the king of Syria? 4 And he said unto Jehoshaphat, Wilt thou go with me to battle to Ramothgilead? And Jehoshaphat said to the king of Israel, I am as thou art, my people as thy people, my horses as thy horses. 5 And Jehoshaphat said unto the king of Israel, Enquire, I pray thee, at the word of the LORD to day. 6 Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets together, about four hundred men, and said unto them, Shall I go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And they said, Go up; for the Lord shall deliver it into the hand of the king. 7 And Jehoshaphat said, Is there not here a prophet of the LORD besides, that we might enquire of him?
- 1 Kings 13 Referred to the old prophet lying to the prophet of God.
- Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
- 1 Kings 22:8 And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, There is yet one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may enquire of the LORD: but I hate him; for he doth not prophesy good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so.
- Romans 11:3,4 Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life. 4 But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal.
- 1 Kings 22:9-11 Then the king of Israel called an officer, and said, Hasten hither Micaiah the son of Imlah. 10 And the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah sat each on his throne, having put on their robes, in a void place in the entrance of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets prophesied before them. 11 And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made him horns of iron: and he said, Thus saith the LORD, With these shalt thou push the Syrians, until thou have consumed them.
- Jeremiah 14:15 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name, and I sent them not, yet they say, Sword and famine shall not be in this land; By sword and famine shall those prophets be consumed.

Jeremiah confronted false prophets Hananiah, Pashur, etc.

1 Kings 22:12-15 And all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver it into the king's hand. 13 And the messenger that was gone to call Micaiah spake unto him, saying, Behold now, the words of the prophets declare good unto the king with one mouth: let thy word, I pray thee, be like the word of one of them,

and speak that which is good. 14 And Micaiah said, As the LORD liveth, what the LORD saith unto me, that will I speak. 15 So he came to the king. And the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall we forbear? And he answered him, Go, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver it into the hand of the king.

Jeremiah 44 Summarized of Israel going to Egypt & God judging them there.

- 1 Kings 22:16-23 And the king said unto him, How many times shall I adjure thee that thou tell me nothing but that which is true in the name of the LORD? 17 And he said, I saw all Israel scattered upon the hills, as sheep that have not a shepherd: and the LORD said, These have no master: let them return every man to his house in peace. 18 And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, Did I not tell thee that he would prophesy no good concerning me, but evil? 19 And he said, Hear thou therefore the word of the LORD: I saw the LORD sitting on his throne, and all the host of heaven standing by him on his right hand and on his left. 20 And the LORD said, Who shall persuade Ahab, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? And one said on this manner, and another said on that manner. 21 And there came forth a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him. 22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so. 23 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- Summarized 1 Kings 22:24-53 But Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah went near, and smote Micaiah on the cheek, and said, Which way went the Spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee? 25 And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see in that day, when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself. 26 And the king of Israel said, Take Micaiah, and carry him back unto Amon the governor of the city, and to Joash the king's son; 27 And say, Thus saith the king, Put this fellow in the prison, and feed him with bread of affliction and with water of affliction, until I come in peace. 28 And Micaiah said, If thou return at all in peace, the LORD hath not spoken by me. And he said, Hearken, O people, every one of you. 29 So the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah went up to Ramothgilead. 30 And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, I will disguise myself, and enter into the battle; but put thou on thy robes. And the king of Israel disguised himself, and went into the battle. 31 But the king of Syria commanded his thirty and two captains that had rule over his chariots, saying, Fight neither

with small nor great, save only with the king of Israel. 32 And it came to pass, when the captains of the chariots saw Jehoshaphat, that they said, Surely it is the king of Israel. And they turned aside to fight against him: and Jehoshaphat cried out. 33 And it came to pass, when the captains of the chariots perceived that it was not the king of Israel, that they turned back from pursuing him. 34 And a certain man drew a bow at a venture. and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: wherefore he said unto the driver of his chariot, Turn thine hand, and carry me out of the host; for I am wounded. 35 And the battle increased that day: and the king was stayed up in his chariot against the Syrians, and died at even: and the blood ran out of the wound into the midst of the chariot, 36 And there went a proclamation throughout the host about the going down of the sun, saying, Every man to his city, and every man to his own country. 37 So the king died, and was brought to Samaria; and they buried the king in Samaria. 38 And one washed the chariot in the pool of Samaria: and the dogs licked up his blood; and they washed his armour; according unto the word of the LORD which he spake. 39 Now the rest of the acts of Ahab, and all that he did, and the ivory house which he made, and all the cities that he built, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel? 40 So Ahab slept with his fathers; and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead. 41 And Jehoshaphat the son of Asa began to reign over Judah in the fourth year of Ahab king of Israel. 42 Jehoshaphat was thirty and five years old when he began to reign; and he reigned twenty and five years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Azubah the daughter of Shilhi. 43 And he walked in all the ways of Asa his father; he turned not aside from it, doing that which was right in the eyes of the LORD: nevertheless the high places were not taken away; for the people offered and burnt incense yet in the high places. 44 And Jehoshaphat made peace with the king of Israel. 45 Now the rest of the acts of Jehoshaphat, and his might that he shewed, and how he warred, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? 46 And the remnant of the sodomites, which remained in the days of his father Asa, he took out of the land. 47 There was then no king in Edom: a deputy was king. 48 Jehoshaphat made ships of Tharshish to go to Ophir for gold: but they went not; for the ships were broken at Eziongeber. 49 Then said Ahaziah the son of Ahab unto Jehoshaphat, Let my servants go with thy servants in the ships. But Jehoshaphat would not. 50 And Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Jehoram his son reigned in his stead. 51 Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel. 52 And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father, and in the way of his mother, and in the way of Jeroboam

- the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin: 53 For he served Baal, and worshipped him, and provoked to anger the LORD God of Israel, according to all that his father had done.
- 1 Samuel 17 Referred to David's stone hitting Goliath's forehead.
- Deuteronomy 33:29 Happy *art* thou, O Israel: who *is* like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who *is* the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found <u>liars</u> unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a <u>lying</u> spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade *him*, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- 1 Kings 22:23 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a <u>lying</u> spirit in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.
- 2 Chronicles 18:21 And he said, I will go out, and be a <u>lying</u> spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And *the LORD* said, Thou shalt entice *him*, and thou shalt also prevail: go out, and do *even* so.
- 2 Chronicles 18:22 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a <u>lying</u> spirit in the mouth of these thy prophets, & the LORD hath spoken evil against thee.
- Job 24:25 And if *it be* not *so* now, who will make me a <u>liar</u>, and make my speech nothing worth?
- Job 1:21 21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- 1 Kings 13:18 He said unto him, I *am* a prophet also as thou *art*; and an angel spake unto me by the word of the LORD, saying, Bring him back with thee into thine house, that he may eat bread and drink water. *But* he lied unto him. (Explained)
- 2 Corinthians 11:14,15 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.
- Psalms 78:36 Nevertheless they did flatter him with their mouth, and they <u>lied</u> unto him with their tongues.
- Isaiah 57:11 And of whom hast thou been afraid or feared, that thou hast <u>lied</u>, and hast not remembered me, nor laid *it* to thy heart? have not I held my peace even of old, and thou fearest me not?
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into

- the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Romans 10:9,10,13 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Acts 5:4 Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. (Explained)
- Psalms 51:4 Against Thee, Thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Thy sight: that Thou mightest be justified when Thou speakest, and be clear when Thou judgest.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Psalms 31:6 I have hated them that regard <u>lying vanities</u>: but I trust in the LORD.
- Ecclesiastes 1:2 Vanity of vanities, saith the Preacher, vanity of vanities; all is vanity.
- Psalms 31:18 <u>Let the lying lips be put to silence</u>; which speak grievous things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous.
- Proverbs 22:1 A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Psalms 52:3 Thou lovest evil more than good; *and* <u>lying</u> rather than to speak righteousness. Selah.
- Psalms 59:12 *For* the <u>sin of their mouth</u> *and* the words of their lips let them even be taken in their pride: and for cursing and <u>lying</u> *which* they speak.
- Psalms 109:2 For the <u>mouth of the wicked</u> and the <u>mouth of the deceitful</u> are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a <u>lying tongue</u>.
- Psalms 116:11 I said in my haste, All men *are* <u>liars</u>.
- Psalms 119:29 Remove from me the way of lying: and grant me thy law

- graciously.
- Psalms 119:163 I hate and abhor lying: but thy law do I love.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications (company) corrupt good manners.
- Psalms 120:2 Deliver my soul, O LORD, from <u>lying lips</u>, & from a <u>deceitful</u> <u>tongue</u>.
- Proverbs 6:16,17 These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: 17 A proud look, a <u>lying tongue</u>, and hands that shed innocent blood,
- Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- Proverbs 10:18 He that hideth hatred *with* <u>lying lips</u>, and he that uttereth a <u>slander</u>, *is* a fool.
- Proverbs 12:19 The <u>lip of truth</u> shall be established for ever: but a <u>lying tongue</u> is but for a moment.
- Proverbs 12:22 <u>Lying lips</u> *are* abomination to the LORD: but they that deal truly *are* His delight.
- Proverbs 13:5 A <u>righteous *man* hateth lying</u>: but a wicked *man* is loathsome, and cometh to shame.
- Proverbs 17:4 A wicked doer giveth heed to <u>false lips</u>; and a <u>liar</u> giveth ear to a naughty tongue.
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet...
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
- **More Service Notes:**
- Proverbs 17:7 Excellent speech becometh not a fool: much less do <u>lying lips</u> a prince.
- Proverbs 19:22 The desire of a man *is* his kindness: and a poor man *is* better than a liar.
- Proverbs 21:6 The getting of treasures by a <u>lying tongue</u> is a vanity tossed to and fro of them that seek death.
- Proverbs 26:28 A <u>lying tongue</u> hateth *those that are* afflicted by it; and a flattering mouth worketh ruin.
- Proverbs 30:6 Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be

- found a liar.
- Isaiah 30:9 That this *is* a rebellious people, <u>lying children</u>, children *that* will not hear the law of the LORD:
- Isaiah 32:7 The instruments also of the churl *are* evil: he deviseth wicked devices to destroy the poor with <u>lying words</u>, even when the needy speaketh right.
- Isaiah 44:25 That frustrateth the <u>tokens of the liars</u>, and maketh diviners mad; that turneth wise *men* backward, and maketh their knowledge foolish;
- Isaiah 59:13 In transgressing and <u>lying against the LORD</u>, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood.
- Jeremiah 7:4 Trust ye not in <u>lying words</u>, saying, The temple of the LORD, The temple of the LORD, The temple of the LORD, are these.
- Jeremiah 7:8 Behold, ye trust in lying words, that cannot profit.
- Jeremiah 15:18 Why is my pain perpetual, and my wound incurable, which refuseth to be healed? wilt thou be altogether unto me as a <u>liar</u>, and as waters *that* fail?
- Jeremiah 29:23 Because they have committed villany in Israel, and have committed adultery with their neighbours' wives, and have spoken <u>lying</u> words in My name, which I have not commanded them; even I know, and am a witness, saith the LORD.
- Jeremiah 50:36 A sword *is* upon the <u>liars</u>; and they shall dote: a sword *is* upon her mighty men; and they shall be dismayed.
- Ezekiel 13:6,7 They have seen vanity and <u>lying divination</u>, saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and they have made *others* to hope that they would confirm the word. 7 Have ye not seen a vain vision, and have ye not spoken a <u>lying divination</u>, whereas ye say, The LORD saith *it*; albeit I have not spoken?
- Ezekiel 13:19 And will ye pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your <u>lying</u> to my people that hear your <u>lies</u>?
- Daniel 2:9 But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, *there is but* one decree for you: for ye have prepared <u>lying</u> and <u>corrupt words</u> to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can shew me the interpretation thereof.
- Hosea 4:2 By swearing, and <u>lying</u>, and killing, and stealing, and committing adultery, they break out, and blood toucheth blood.
- Jonah 2:8 They that observe <u>lying vanities</u> forsake their own mercy.
- John 8:44 Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of

- his own: for he is a <u>liar</u>, and the father of it.
- John 8:55 Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a <u>liar</u> like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying.
- Romans 3:4 God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a <u>liar</u>; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.
- Ephesians 4:25 Wherefore <u>putting away lying</u>, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:9 *Even him*, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,
- 1 Timothy 1:10 For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for <u>liars</u>, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;
- Titus 1:12 One of themselves, *even* a prophet of their own, said, The Cretians *are* alway <u>liars</u>, evil beasts, slow bellies.
- 1 John 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a <u>liar</u>, and his word is not in us.
- 1 John 2:4 He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- 1 John 2:22 Who is a <u>liar</u> but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.
- 1 John 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a <u>liar</u>: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?
- 1 John 5:10 He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a <u>liar</u>; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.
- Revelation 2:2 I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them <u>liars</u>:
- Revelation 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all <u>liars</u>, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
- Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:
