- Leviticus 24:20 Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done to him again.
- Summarized of the avenger of blood & cities of refuge in the Old Testament.
- John 8 Summarized of the woman caught in adultery. V7 So when they continued asking Him, He lifted up Himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, says the Lord. Summarized the Lord's mottle prayer thus far.
- Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
- Matthew 6:14,15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
- Forgive debts, sins, or tresspasses.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- Ezekiel 8 Summarized of God showing Ezekiel the ungodliness in the temple & the Holy Spirit there also.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Mark 12:33 And to love Him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.
- Matthew 6:14,15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- Matthew 5:41 whosoever shall compel thee to go a mile, go with him twain. Acts 2 Referred to the infilling of the Holy Spirit.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, <u>Father</u>, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.

- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Acts 7:60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

Revelation Referred to the earth consumed by fire at the end.

Psalms 136 every verse ends with "for His mercy endureth for ever."

- Matthew 23 Jesus often says "But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!"
- 1 Samuel 18:14 And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD was with him.

Referred to David's sin with Bathsheba & the killing of Uriah.

Genesis 3 Summarized of Eve's fall.

- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- Daniel 4:16 Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- John 8:41,44 Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God. 44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Deuteronomy 15:7 If there be among you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy gates in thy land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt <u>not harden thine heart</u>, nor shut thine hand from thy poor brother:
- 2 Chronicles 36:13 And he also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by God: but he <u>stiffened his neck</u>, and hardened his heart from turning unto the LORD God of Israel.
- Job 9:4 *He is* wise in <u>heart</u>, and mighty in strength: who hath <u>hardened</u> himself against him, and hath prospered?
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Job 41:24 His <u>heart</u> is as firm as a stone; yea, as <u>hard</u> as a piece of the nether *millstone*.

- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- Psalms 95:8 <u>Harden not your heart</u>, as in the provocation, *and* as *in* the day of temptation in the wilderness:
- Psalms 78 Referred to the 10 times Israelites tested God.
- Exodus 7:3 And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.
- 1 Kings 18 Referred to the shoot-out on Mount Carmel.
- Proverbs 28:14 Happy *is* the man that feareth alway: but he that <u>hardeneth</u> <u>his heart</u> shall fall into mischief.
- Proverbs often warns of the strange woman.
- 1 Peter 3:4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- Isaiah 63:17 O LORD, why hast thou made us to err from thy ways, *and*<u>hardened our heart</u> from thy fear? Return for thy servants' sake, the tribes of thine inheritance.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Leviticus 26 Summarized of God's judgments.
- Jeremiah warned the people to surrender to Nebuchadnezzar.
- Daniel 5:20 But when his <u>heart</u> was lifted up, and his mind <u>hardened</u> in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him:
- Matthew 19:6,8 Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. 8 He saith unto them, Moses because of the <u>hardness of your hearts</u> suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so.
- Mark 3:5 And when He had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the <u>hardness of their hearts</u>, He saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched *it* out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Mark 6:52 For they considered not *the miracle* of the loaves: for their <u>heart</u> <u>was hardened</u>.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Mark 8:17 And when Jesus knew *it*, he saith unto them, Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? perceive ye not yet, neither understand? have ye your <u>heart yet hardened</u>?
- John 16:8,9 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 Of sin, because they believe not on me;
- 1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- Mark 10:5 And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the <u>hardness of your</u> <u>heart</u> he wrote you this precept.
- Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and <u>hardness of heart</u>, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- John 12:40 He hath blinded their eyes, and <u>hardened their heart</u>; that they should not see with *their* eyes, nor understand with *their* <u>heart</u>, and be converted, and I should heal them.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.
- Romans 2:5 But after thy <u>hardness and impenitent heart</u> treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;
- Hebrews 3:8 <u>Harden not your hearts</u>, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:
- Hebrews 3:15 While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, <u>harden not your</u> <u>hearts</u>, as in the provocation.
- Hebrews 4:7 Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, <u>harden not your</u> hearts.
- 2 Kings 9:30-37 30,31 And when Jehu was come to Jezreel, Jezebel heard

- of it; and she painted her face, and tired her head, and looked out at a window. 31 And as Jehu entered in at the gate, she said, Had Zimri peace, who slew his master?
- 1 Kings 18:4 For it was so, when Jezebel cut off the prophets of the LORD, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and hid them by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water.)
- Acts 16:16,17 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: 17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.
- Matthew 3:6 And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins.
- 2 Kings 9:32 And he lifted up his face to the window, and said, Who is on my side? who? And there looked out to him two or three eunuchs.
- Exodus 32:26 Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.
- 2 Kings 9:33 And he said, Throw her down. So they threw her down: and some of her blood was sprinkled on the wall, and on the horses: and he trode her under foot. 34 And when he was come in, he did eat and drink, and said, Go, see now this cursed woman, and bury her: for she is a king's daughter. 35 And they went to bury her: but they found no more of her than the skull, and the feet, and the palms of her hands. 36 Wherefore they came again, and told him. And he said, This is the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, In the portion of Jezreel shall dogs eat the flesh of Jezebel: 37 And the carcase of Jezebel shall be as dung upon the face of the field in the portion of Jezreel; so that they shall not say, This is Jezebel.
- Luke 17:3-5 Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him. 4 And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him. 5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.
- Matthew 18:21,22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until 70 times 7.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, <u>Father</u>, <u>forgive them</u>; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
