- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.
- **Matthew 5 Referred to the Beatitudes.**
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- Matthew 6:13 (AV) And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: <u>Our Father</u> which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name.
- Romans 4:21 And being fully persuaded that, what He had promised, He was able also to perform.

- Strongs #4506. rhoumai *rhoo'-om-ahee*; middle voice of an obsolete verb, akin to <u>4482</u> (through the idea of a current; compare <u>4511</u>); to rush or draw (for oneself), i.e. rescue: deliver(-er).
- 1 John 5:19 We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Leviticus 17:7 And they shall no more offer their sacrifices unto <u>devils</u>, after whom they have gone a whoring. This shall be a statute for ever unto them

throughout their generations.

- Deuteronomy 32:17 They sacrificed unto <u>devils</u>, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new *gods that* came newly up, whom your fathers feared not.
- 1 Chronicles 21:1 And <u>Satan</u> stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.
- 2 Chronicles 11:15 And he ordained him priests for the high places, and for the <u>devils</u>, and for the calves which he had made.
- Job 1:6-9 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and <u>Satan</u> came also among them. 7 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, Whence comest thou? Then <u>Satan</u> answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. 8 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? 9 Then <u>Satan</u> answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought?
- Job 1:12 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, Behold, all that he hath *is* in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So <u>Satan</u> went forth from the presence of the LORD.
- Job 2:1-4 Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and <u>Satan</u> came also among them to present himself before the LORD. 2 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, From whence comest thou? And <u>Satan</u> answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. 3 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst Me against him, to destroy him without cause.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the <u>LORD</u> gave, and the <u>LORD</u> hath taken away; <u>blessed</u> be the name of the LORD.

- Job 2:4 And <u>Satan</u> answered the LORD, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will he give for his life.
- Job 2:6,7 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, Behold, he *is* in thine hand; but save his life. 7 So went <u>Satan</u> forth from the presence of the LORD, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown.
- Summarized of many of God's devout people being aflicted by the devil.
- Psalms 106:37 Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto <u>devils</u>,
- Psalms 109:6 Set Thou a wicked man over him: and let <u>Satan</u> stand at his right hand. (Christians can break off this curse in Jesus' name & return it to the original demonic senders.)
- Isaiah 14:12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O <u>Lucifer</u>, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!
- Zechariah 3:1,2 And He shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and <u>Satan standing at his right hand to resist him</u>. 2 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, The LORD rebuke thee, O <u>Satan</u>; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: *is* not this a brand plucked out of the fire?
- Luke 4 Our Lord Jesus rebuked the devil during His temptation.
- Matthew 4:1 Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the <u>devil</u>. (& tested by God)
- Matthew 4:5 Then the <u>devil</u> taketh Him up into the holy city, and setteth Him on a pinnacle of the temple,
- Matthew 4:8 Again, the <u>devil</u> taketh Him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth Him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;
- Matthew 4:10,11 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, <u>Satan</u>: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. 11 Then the <u>devil</u> leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.
- Matthew 4:24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with <u>devils (demons)</u>, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- Matthew 7:22 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy name? and in Thy name have cast out <u>devils (demons)</u>? and in Thy name done many wonderful works?
- Matthew 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed with <u>devils (demons)</u>: and He cast out the spirits with *His* word, and <u>healed all</u> that were sick:
- Matthew 8:28 And when He was come to the other side into the country of

- the Gergesenes, there met him two possessed with <u>devils (demons)</u>, coming out of the tombs, exceeding fierce, so that no man might pass by that way.
- Matthew 8:31 So the <u>devils (demons)</u> besought Him, saying, If Thou cast us out, suffer us to go away into the herd of swine.
- Matthew 8:33 And they that kept them fled, and went their ways into the city, and told every thing, and what was befallen to the possessed of the <u>devils</u> (<u>demons</u>).
- Matthew 9:32-34 As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a dumb man possessed with a <u>devil (demon)</u>. 33 And when the <u>devil (demon)</u> was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel. 34 But the Pharisees said, He casteth out <u>devils</u> through the prince of the <u>devils</u>.
- Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out <u>devils (demons)</u>: freely ye have received, freely give.
- Matthew 11:18 For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, He hath a devil.
- Matthew 12:22 Then was brought unto Him one possessed with a <u>devil</u> (<u>demon</u>), blind, and dumb: and He healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.
- Luke 4:21,29 And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears. 29 And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong.
- 1 John 5:19 (AV) And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.
- 1 John 19 (NKJV) We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway (control) of the wicked one.
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 1 John 2:2 And He is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- 1 John 1:7-9 But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin. 8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- Acts 2 Referred to the infilling of the Holy Spirit & the beginning of the Christian Church.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness (demons) in high *places*.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. (Bind the demons in Jesus' name.)
- Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's in perils chapter.
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.
- Mark 1:23-28 And there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out, 24 Saying, Let *us* alone; what have we to do with thee,

Thou Jesus of Nazareth? art Thou come to destroy us? I know Thee who Thou art, the Holy One of God. 25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. 26 And when the unclean spirit had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him. 27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine *is* this? for with authority commandeth He even the unclean spirits, and they do obey Him. 28 And immediately His fame spread abroad throughout all the region round about Galilee.

- Luke 4:35 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.
- Acts 8:4-8 Therefore they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word. 5 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them. 6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. 7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed. 8 And there was great joy in that city.
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

More Service Notes:

- Matthew 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard *it*, they said, This *fellow* doth not cast out <u>devils</u>, but by Beelzebub the prince of the <u>devils</u>.
- Matthew 12:26-28 And if <u>Satan</u> cast out <u>Satan</u>, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand? 27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out <u>devils</u>, by whom do your children cast *them* out? therefore they shall be your judges. 28 But if I cast out <u>devils</u> by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.
- Mark 6 Summarized of unbelief in Nazareth when Jesus returned there.
- Matthew 13:39 The enemy that sowed them is the <u>devil</u>; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.
- Matthew 15:22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, *thou* Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a <u>devil</u>.
- Matthew 16:23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.
- Matthew 17:18 And Jesus rebuked the <u>devil</u>; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.
- Matthew 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the <u>devil</u> and his angels:

- Mark 1:13 And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of <u>Satan</u>; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.
- Mark 1:32 And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased, and them that were possessed with <u>devils</u>.
- Mark 1:34 And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and cast out many <u>devils</u>; and suffered not the <u>devils</u> to speak, because they knew him.
- Mark 1:39 And he preached in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and cast out devils.
- Mark 3:15 And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out <u>devils</u>:
- Mark 3:22,23 And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the <u>devils</u> casteth he out <u>devils</u>. 23 And he called them *unto him*, and said unto them in parables, How can Satan cast out Satan?
- Mark 3:26 And if <u>Satan</u> rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.
- Mark 4:15 And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, <u>Satan</u> cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.
- Mark 5:12 And all the <u>devils</u> besought him, saying, Send us into the swine, that we may enter into them.
- Mark 5:15 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 16 And they that saw *it* told them how it befell to him that was possessed with the devil, and also concerning the swine.
- Mark 5:18 And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the <u>devil</u> prayed him that he might be with him.
- Mark 6:13 And they cast out many <u>devils</u>, and anointed with oil many that were sick, and healed *them*.
- Mark 7:26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.
- Mark 7:29,30 And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the <u>devil</u> is gone out of thy daughter. 30 And when she was come to her house, she found the <u>devil</u> gone out, and her daughter laid upon the bed.
- Mark 8:33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, <u>Satan</u>: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- Mark 9:38 And John answered him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out <u>devils</u> in thy name, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us.
- Mark 16:9 Now when *Jesus* was risen early the first *day* of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven <u>devils</u>.

- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out <u>devils</u>; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 4:2,3 Being forty days tempted of the <u>devil</u>. And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered. 3 And the <u>devil</u> said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread.
- Luke 4:5,6 And the <u>devil</u>, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. 6 And the <u>devil</u> said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.
- Luke 4:8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, <u>Satan</u>: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- Luke 4:13 And when the <u>devil</u> had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.
- Luke 4:33 And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean <u>devil</u>, and cried out with a loud voice,
- Luke 4:35 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the <u>devil</u> had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.
- Luke 4:41 And <u>devils</u> also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking *them* suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.
- Luke 7:33 For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a <u>devil</u>.
- Luke 8:2 And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven <u>devils</u>,
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the <u>devil</u>, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- Luke 8:27 And when he went forth to land, there met him out of the city a certain man, which had <u>devils</u> long time, and ware no clothes, neither abode in *any* house, but in the tombs.
- Luke 8:29,30 (For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the <u>devil</u> into the wilderness.) 30 And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many <u>devils</u> were entered into him.
- Luke 8:33 Then went the <u>devils</u> out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.
- Luke 8:35,36 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus,

- and found the man, out of whom the <u>devils</u> were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 36 They also which saw *it* told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed.
- Luke 8:38 Now the man out of whom the <u>devils</u> were departed besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus sent him away, saying,
- Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all <u>devils</u>, and to cure diseases.
- Luke 9:42 And as he was yet a coming, the <u>devil</u> threw him down, and tare *him*. And Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, and healed the child, and delivered him again to his father.
- Luke 9:49 And John answered and said, Master, we saw one casting out <u>devils</u> in thy name; and we forbad him, because he followeth not with us.
- Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the <u>devils</u> are subject unto us through thy name. 18 And he said unto them, I beheld <u>Satan</u> as lightning fall from heaven.
- Luke 11:14,15 And he was casting out a <u>devil</u>, and it was dumb. And it came to pass, when the <u>devil</u> was gone out, the dumb spake; and the people wondered. 15 But some of them said, He casteth out <u>devils</u> through Beelzebub the chief of the <u>devils</u>.
- Luke 11:18-20 If <u>Satan</u> also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because ye say that I cast out <u>devils</u> through Beelzebub. 19 And if I by Beelzebub cast out <u>devils</u>, by whom do your sons cast *them* out? therefore shall they be your judges. 20 But if I with the finger of God cast out <u>devils</u>, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you.
- Luke 13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom <u>Satan</u> hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?
- Luke 13:32 And he said unto them, Go ye, and tell that fox, Behold, I cast out devils, and I do cures to day and to morrow, and the third *day* I shall be perfected.
- Luke 22:3 Then entered <u>Satan</u> into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- Luke 22:31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, <u>Satan</u> hath desired *to have* you, that he may sift *you* as wheat:
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- John 7:20 The people answered and said, Thou hast a <u>devil</u>: who goeth about to kill thee?
- John 8:44 Ye are of *your* father the <u>devil</u>, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of

- his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- John 8:48,49 Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a <u>devil</u>? 49 Jesus answered, I have not a <u>devil</u>; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.
- John 8:52 Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a <u>devil</u>. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death.
- John 10:20,21 And many of them said, He hath a <u>devil</u>, and is mad; why hear ye him? 21 Others said, These are not the words of him that hath a <u>devil</u>.

 Can a <u>devil</u> open the eyes of the blind?
- John 13:2 And supper being ended, the <u>devil</u> having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's *son*, to betray him;
- John 13:27 And after the sop <u>Satan</u> entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- Acts 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath <u>Satan filled</u> thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back *part* of the price of the land?
- Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the <u>devil</u>; for God was with him.
- Acts 13:10 And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, *thou* child of the <u>devil</u>, *thou* enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?
- Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, *and* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of <u>Satan</u> unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise <u>Satan</u> under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.
- 1 Corinthians 5:5 To deliver such an one unto <u>Satan</u> for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 7:5 Defraud ye not one the other, except *it be* with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that <u>Satan</u> tempt you not for your incontinency.
- 1 Corinthians 10:20 But *I say*, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to <u>devils</u>, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with <u>devils</u>. 21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of <u>devils</u>: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of <u>devils</u>.
