## Kingdom, Power And Glory - Matthew 6H

- Matthew 6:7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.
- Matthew 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.
- Matthew 6:9,10 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. 10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- Revelation 4:10 The four and twenty elders fall down before Him that sat on the throne, and worship Him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying,
- Matthew 6:13 (NKJV) And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.
- Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- Psalms 22:28 For the <u>kingdom</u> *is* the LORD'S: and He *is* the governor among the nations.
- Psalms 45:6 Thy throne, O God, *is* for ever and ever: the sceptre of Thy <u>kingdom</u> *is* a right sceptre.
- Psalms 46:6 The heathen raged, the <u>kingdoms</u> were moved (stirred up): He uttered His voice, the earth melted.
- Psalms 68:32 Sing unto God, ye <u>kingdoms</u> of the earth; O sing praises unto the Lord; Selah:
- Psalms 79:6 Pour out Thy wrath upon the heathen that have not known Thee, and upon the <u>kingdoms</u> that have not called upon Thy name.
- Psalms 102:22 When the people are gathered together, and the <u>kingdoms</u>, <u>to serve the LORD</u>.
- Psalms 103:19 The LORD hath prepared His throne in the heavens; and His <u>kingdom</u> ruleth over all.
- Psalms 145:11 They shall <u>speak of the glory of Thy kingdom, and talk of Thy power</u>; 12 To make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His <u>kingdom</u>. 13 Thy <u>kingdom</u> is an everlasting <u>kingdom</u>, and Thy dominion *endureth* throughout all generations.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy:

- I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Psalms 24:1 « A Psalm of David. » The <u>earth is</u> the <u>LORD'S</u>, and the <u>fulness</u> thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
- Psalms 33:5 He loveth righteousness and judgment: the <u>earth</u> is <u>full</u> of the goodness of the LORD.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Psalms 104:24 O <u>LORD</u>, how manifold are Thy works! in wisdom hast Thou made them all: the <u>earth is full of Thy riches</u>.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- Psalms 119:64 The <u>earth</u>, O <u>LORD</u>, is <u>full</u> of Thy mercy: teach me Thy statutes.
- Psalms 136 every second line is "for His mercy endureth for ever."
- Isaiah 6:3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, *is* the LORD of hosts: the whole earth *is* full of His glory.
- Isaiah 11:9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain: for the <u>earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD</u>, as the waters cover the sea.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 1 Corinthians 10:26,28,29 For the <u>earth is</u> the <u>Lord's</u>, and the <u>fulness</u> thereof. 28 But if any man say unto you, This is offered in sacrifice unto idols, eat not for his sake that shewed it, and for conscience sake: for the <u>earth is</u> the <u>Lord's</u>, and the <u>fulness</u> thereof: 29 Conscience, I say, not thine own, but of the other: for why is my liberty judged of another man's conscience?
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- John 13:27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- 1 Chronicles 29:11 Thine, O LORD, *is* the greatness, and the <u>power, and the</u> <u>glory</u>, and the victory, and the majesty: for all *that is* in the heaven and

- in the earth *is Thine*; Thine *is* the kingdom, O LORD, and <u>Thou art</u> exalted as head above all.
- Psalms 63:2 To see <u>Thy power and Thy glory</u>, so *as* I have seen Thee in the sanctuary.
- Psalms 145:11 They shall speak of the glory of Thy kingdom, and talk of <a href="https://doi.org/10.1007/jhp.nc.10
- Daniel 2:37 Thou, O king, *art* a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, <u>power</u>, and strength, and <u>glory</u>.
- Daniel Summarized of God dealing with Nebuchadnezzar.
- Matthew 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For Thine is the kingdom, and the <u>power</u>, and the <u>glory</u>, for ever. Amen.
- Matthew 24:30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with <u>power</u> and great <u>glory</u>.
- Revelation 19 Summarized Jesus' return.
- Acts 1:11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.
- Mark 9 Referred to the Mount of Transfiguration
- Exodus 32 Referred to The glory of the Lord on Mount Sinai.
- Mark 13:26 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great <u>power</u> and <u>glory</u>.
- Luke 4:6 And the devil said unto Him, All this <u>power</u> will I give thee, and the <u>glory</u> of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Luke 21:27 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.
- Exodus 34:30 And when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone; and they were afraid to come nigh him.
- 1 Corinthians 15:43 It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in <u>power</u>:
- Referred to instances of the actions of Jesus' resurected body.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:9 Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction

- from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of His power;
- Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of *His* glory, and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His <u>power</u>, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;
- Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
- 2 Peter 1:3 According as His divine <u>power</u> hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him that hath called us to <u>glory</u> and virtue:
- Jude 1:25 To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.
- Revelation 4:11 Thou art worthy, O <u>Lord, to receive glory and honour and power</u>: for Thou hast created all things, and for Thy pleasure they are and were created.
- Revelation 5:12,13 Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive <u>power</u>, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and <u>glory</u>, and blessing. 13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and <u>glory</u>, and <u>power</u>, *be* unto Him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.
- Revelation 7:12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and <u>power</u>, and might, *be* unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.
- Revelation 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the <u>glory</u> of God, and from His <u>power</u>; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.
- 1 Chronicles 21:26 And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called upon the LORD; and He answered him from heaven by fire upon the altar of burnt offering.
- Revelation 16:9 And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath <u>power</u> over these plagues: and they repented not to give Him <u>glory</u>.
- Revelation 18:1 And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great <u>power</u>; and the earth was lightened with his glory.
- Daniel 10:13 But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and

- twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia.
- Revelation 19:1 And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:

Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28 Referred to satan's pride & fall.

1 Chronicles 29:10-22 Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed *be* thou, LORD God of Israel our Father, for ever and ever. 11 Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is Thine; Thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and Thou art exalted as head above all. 12 Both riches and honour *come* of Thee, and Thou reignest over all; and in Thine hand is power and might; and in Thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all. 13 Now therefore, our God, we thank Thee, and praise Thy glorious name. 14 But who *am* I, and what *is* my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly after this sort? for all things come of Thee, and of Thine own have we given Thee. 15 For we are strangers before Thee, and sojourners, as were all our fathers: our days on the earth are as a shadow, and there is none abiding. 16 O LORD our God, all this store that we have prepared to build Thee an house for Thine Holy Name *cometh* of Thine hand, and *is* all Thine own. 17 I know also, my God, that Thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things: and now have I seen with joy Thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto Thee. 18 O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of Thy people, and prepare their heart unto Thee: 19 And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep Thy commandments, Thy testimonies, and Thy statutes, and to do all these things, and to build the palace, for the which I have made provision. 20 And David said to all the congregation, Now bless the LORD your God. And all the congregation blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and bowed down their heads, and worshipped the LORD, and the king. 21 And they sacrificed sacrifices unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings unto the LORD, on the morrow after that day, even a thousand bullocks, a thousand rams, and a thousand lambs, with their drink offerings, and sacrifices in abundance for all Israel: 22 And did eat and drink before the LORD on that day with great gladness. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed him unto the LORD to be the chief governor, and Zadok to be priest.

- Hebrews 13:15 By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Isaiah 6:1-4 In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and His train filled the temple. 2 Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. 3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of His glory. 4 And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke.

Acts 9 Referred to Paul's conversion on the road to Damascas.

- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:
- 1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- John 9:4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- Revelation 19:1-21 And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: 2 For true and righteous are His judgments: for He hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. 3 And again they said, Alleluia. And her smoke rose up for ever and ever. 4 And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia. 5 And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great. 6 And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth. 7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His wife hath made herself ready. 8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. 9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God. 10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he

said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. 11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war. 12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns: and He had a name written, that no man knew, but He Himself. 13 And He was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies which were in heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. 15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He hath on His vesture and on His thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. 17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God; 18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great. 19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him that sat on the horse, and against His army. 20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. 21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of Him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of His mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, <u>come</u>, <u>Lord Jesus</u>.
