## **Your Treasures - Godly Or Not - Matthew 6J**

- Matthew 6:19-24 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: 21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. 22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. 23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness! 24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Strongs #3126 mammonas *mam-mo-nas'* AV-mammon 4; 4 1) mammon 2) treasure 3) riches (where it is personified and opposed to God)
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Matthew 6:19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:
- 1 Samuel 1:22 But Hannah went not up; for she said unto her husband, I will not go up until the child (Samuel) be weaned, and then I will bring him, that he may appear before the LORD, and there abide for ever.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye (Eli) at my sacrifice and at mine offering, which I have commanded in my habitation; and honourest thy sons above me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel my people?
- Mark 8:36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?
- Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- John 6:28,29 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is

- the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Acts 4:34,35 Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold, 35 And laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need.
- Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them. 25 And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Exodus 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.
- Mark 5:17 And they (Gadarenes) began to pray Him to depart out of their coasts.
- Luke 12 Referred to the rich man with much crops V20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?
- Matthew 6:22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.
- Mark 9 Referred to the glory of Jesus on Mount of Transfiguration.
- Exodus 34:35 And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the vail upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.

- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- 2 Timothy 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.
- Matthew 6:23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great *is* that darkness!
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Matthew 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not <u>work</u>, neither should he <u>eat</u>.
- Proverbs Referred to Solomon's writings on the slothful.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:12 Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they <u>work</u>, and <u>eat</u> their own bread.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.
- Acts 20:34 34 Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my (Paul's) necessities, and to them that were with me.
- Luke 10:7 And in the same house remain, eating and drinking such things as they give: for the labourer is worthy of his hire. Go not from house to house.
- Matthew 13:52 Then said He unto them, Therefore every scribe *which is* instructed unto the kingdom of <u>heaven</u> is like unto a man *that is* an householder, which bringeth forth out of his treasure *things* new and old.

- Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
- Matthew 19:21 Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go *and* sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have <u>treasure in heaven</u>: and come *and* follow Me.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Mark 10:21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have <u>treasure in heaven</u>: and come, take up the cross, and follow Me.
- Luke 12:33 Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a <u>treasure in the heavens</u> that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth.
- Luke 18:22 Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have <u>treasure in heaven</u>: and come, follow Me.
- 1 Corinthians 3:6-15 V6-8 I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. 7 So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase. 8 Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- 1 Corinthians 3:9 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 1 Corinthians 3:10 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon. 11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; 13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. 14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. 15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

- Luke 8 Summarized the parable of the sower.
- John 9:5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14,15 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.
- John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Matthew 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- John 3:16 For <u>God so loved the world</u>, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye <u>love one</u> <u>another</u>; as I have loved you, that ye also <u>love one another</u>. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have <u>love one to another</u>.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- Matthew 6:12,14,15 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the <u>world</u>, and men <u>loved</u> darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
- John 12:25 He that <u>loveth</u> his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this <u>world</u> shall keep it unto life eternal.
- John 15:19 If ye were of the <u>world</u>, the <u>world</u> would <u>love</u> his own: but because ye are not of the <u>world</u>, but <u>I have chosen you out of the world</u>, therefore the <u>world</u> hateth you.
- 1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:

- John 17:23 I in them, and Thou in Me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the <u>world</u> may know that Thou hast sent Me, and hast <u>loved them</u>, as Thou hast loved Me.
- Ephesians 1:4 According as <u>He hath chosen us in Him before the</u>
  <u>foundation of the world</u>, that we should be holy and without blame
  before Him in love:
- 2 Timothy 4:10 For Demas hath forsaken me, having <u>loved this present</u> world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia.
- James 2:5 Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not <u>God chosen the poor of</u> this world rich in faith, and <u>heirs of the kingdom</u> which He hath promised to them that love Him?
- 1 John 2:15 <u>Love not the world</u>, neither the things *that are* in the <u>world</u>. If any man <u>love the world</u>, the <u>love</u> of the Father is not in him.
- 1 John 3:1 Behold, what manner of <u>love the Father hath bestowed upon us</u>, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the <u>world</u> knoweth us not, because it knew Him not.
- 1 John 3:17 But whoso hath this <u>world</u>'s good, and seeth his brother have need, and <u>shutteth up his bowels *of compassion*</u> from him, how dwelleth the <u>love of God</u> in him?
- 1 Corinthians 11:21 For in eating every one taketh before other his own supper: and one is hungry, and another is drunken.
- 1 John 4:9 In this was manifested the <u>love of God toward us</u>, because that God sent His only begotten Son into the <u>world</u>, that we might live through Him.
- 1 John 4:17 Herein is our <u>love</u> made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this <u>world</u>.
- James 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.
- 2 Kings 17:33 They feared the LORD, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations whom they carried away from thence.
- John 6:28,29 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
