## **Smiting - Godly Or Not - 2 Kings 13**

- Summarized of modern Religious Leaders miss-using scriptures cursing those they think are against them.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:15 See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;
- 1 Samuel 17:50 So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone, and smote the Philistine, and slew him; but there was no sword in the hand of David.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Genesis 8:21 And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in His heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.
- Exodus 2:13 And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Wherefore smitest thou thy fellow?
- Exodus 3:20 And I will stretch out My hand, and smite Egypt with all My wonders which I will do in the midst thereof: and after that he will let you go.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me. Revelation 19:15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp sword (Word of God),

- that with it He should smite the nations: and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7,9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- 2 Kings 13:14-19 V14 Now Elisha was fallen sick of his sickness whereof he died. And Joash the king of Israel came down unto him, and wept over his face, and said, O my father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof.
- 2 Kings 6 Summarized of Elisha in Dothan smiting the army with blindness. Romans 12:20 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give

him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

- 2 Kings 13:15 And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and arrows. And he took unto him bow and arrows.
- 1 Kings 19 Summarized of God's last jobs for Elijah.
- 2 Kings 13:16-19 And he said to the king of Israel, Put thine hand upon the bow. And he put his hand upon it: and Elisha put his hands upon the king's hands. 17 And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened it. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. And he said, The arrow of the LORD'S deliverance, and the arrow of deliverance from Syria: for thou shalt smite the Syrians in Aphek, till thou have consumed them. 18 And he said, Take the arrows. And he took them. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice, and stayed. 19 And the man of God (Godly prophet) was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed it: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria but thrice.

Many Christians fall short of many of God's blessings by unbelief etc.

- Exodus 23:29,30 I will not drive them out from before thee in one year; lest the land become desolate, and the beast of the field multiply against thee. 30 By little and little I will drive them out from before thee, until thou be increased, and inherit the land.
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own

- salvation with fear and trembling.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 2 Kings 2:9-14 And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me. 10 And he said, Thou hast asked a hard thing: nevertheless, if thou see me when I am taken from thee, it shall be so unto thee; but if not, it shall not be so. 11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven. 12 And Elisha saw it, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces. 13 He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan; 14 And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where is the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

Elisha did twice as many miracles than Elijah did.

- Numbers 24:8 God brought him forth out of Egypt; he hath as it were the strength of an unicorn: he shall eat up the nations his enemies, and shall break their bones, and pierce *them* through with his <u>arrows</u>.
- Deuteronomy 32:23 I will heap mischiefs upon them; I will spend <u>Mine arrows</u> upon them.
- Deuteronomy 32:42 I will make <u>Mine arrows</u> drunk with blood, and <u>My sword</u> shall devour flesh; *and that* with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from the beginning of revenges upon the enemy.
- In the New Covenant we use the Name of Jesus & His blood against the enemy not the Old testament items like the rams horn or holy water, etc.

Acts 2 Referred to the Baptism or Infilling of the Holy Spirit.

- 1 Samuel 20:20-22 And I will shoot three <u>arrows</u> on the side *thereof*, as though I shot at a mark. 21 And, behold, I will send a lad, *saying*, Go, find out the <u>arrows</u>. If I expressly say unto the lad, Behold, the <u>arrows</u> are on this side of thee, take them; then come thou: for *there is* peace to thee, and no hurt; as the LORD liveth. 22 But if I say thus unto the young man, Behold, the <u>arrows</u> are beyond thee; go thy way: for the LORD hath sent thee away.
- 1 Samuel 20:36-38 And he said unto his lad, Run, find out now the <u>arrows</u> which I shoot. *And* as the lad ran, he shot an <u>arrow</u> beyond him. 37 And when the lad was come to the place of the <u>arrow</u> which Jonathan had shot, Jonathan cried after the lad, and said, *Is* not the <u>arrow</u> beyond thee?

- 38 And Jonathan cried after the lad, Make speed, haste, stay not. And Jonathan's lad gathered up the <u>arrows</u>, and came to his master.
- 2 Samuel 22:15 And <u>He sent out arrows</u>, and scattered them; lightning, and discomfited them.
- 1 Samuel 7:10 And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the LORD thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and discomfited them; and they were smitten before Israel.
- 2 Kings 9:24 And Jehu drew a bow with his full strength, and <u>smote</u> Jehoram between his arms, and the <u>arrow</u> went out at his heart, and he sunk down in his chariot.
- 2 Kings 13:15,17,18 And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and <u>arrows</u>. And he took unto him bow and <u>arrows</u>. 17 And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened *it*. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. And he said, The <u>arrow</u> of the LORD'S deliverance, and the <u>arrow</u> of deliverance from Syria: for thou shalt smite the Syrians in Aphek, till thou have consumed *them*. 18 And he said, Take the <u>arrows</u>. And he took *them*. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice, and stayed.
- 2 Kings 19:32 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the king of Assyria, He shall not come into this city, nor shoot an <u>arrow</u> there, nor come before it with shield, nor cast a bank against it.
- 2 Kings 19:14 And Hezekiah received the letter of the hand of the messengers, and read it: and Hezekiah went up into the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD. (& prayed)
- 1 Chronicles 12:2 *They were* armed with bows, and could use both the right hand and the left in *hurling* stones and *shooting* <u>arrows</u> out of a bow, *even* of Saul's brethren of Benjamin.
- 2 Chronicles 26:15 And he (Uzziah) made in Jerusalem engines, invented by cunning men, to be on the towers and upon the bulwarks, to shoot <u>arrows</u> and great stones withal. And his name spread far abroad; for he was marvellously helped, till he was strong.
- Job 6:4 For the <u>arrows of the Almighty</u> *are* within me, the poison whereof drinketh up my spirit: the <u>terrors of God</u> do set themselves in array against me.
- Job 1:21 21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- Job 41:28 The <u>arrow</u> cannot make him flee: slingstones are turned with him into stubble.
- Psalms 7:13 He hath also prepared for him the instruments of death; he ordaineth his <u>arrows</u> against the persecutors.

- Psalms 11:2 For, lo, the wicked bend *their* bow, they make ready their <u>arrow</u> upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the upright in heart.
- Psalms 18:14 Yea, he sent out <u>His arrows</u>, and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfited them.
- Psalms 21:12 Therefore shalt thou make them turn their back, *when* thou shalt make ready *Thine arrows* upon thy strings against the face of them.
- Psalms 38:2 For <u>Thine arrows</u> stick fast in me, and thy hand presseth me sore.
- Psalms 45:5 <u>Thine arrows</u> *are* sharp in the heart of the king's enemies; whereby the people fall under thee.
- Psalms 57:4 My soul *is* among lions: *and* I lie *even among* them that are set on fire, *even* the sons of men, whose teeth *are* spears and <u>arrows</u>, and their tongue a sharp sword.
- Psalms 58:7 Let them melt away as waters *which* run continually: *when* he bendeth *his bow to shoot* his <u>arrows</u>, let them be as cut in pieces.
- Psalms 64:3 Who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words:
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Luke 22:42 Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.

## **More Service Notes:**

- Psalms 64:7 But <u>God</u> shall shoot at them *with* an <u>arrow</u>; suddenly shall they be wounded.
- Psalms 76:3 There brake He the <u>arrows</u> of the bow, the shield, and the sword, and the battle. Selah.
- Psalms 77:17 The clouds poured out water: the skies sent out a sound: <u>Thine</u> arrows also went abroad.
- Psalms 91:5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; *nor* for the <u>arrow</u> that flieth by day;
- Psalms 120:4 Sharp <u>arrows</u> of the mighty, with coals of juniper.
- Psalms 127:4 As <u>arrows</u> are in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the vouth.
- Psalms 144:6 Cast forth lightning, and scatter them: shoot out thine <u>arrows</u>, and destroy them.
- Proverbs 25:18 A man that beareth false witness against his neighbour *is* a maul, and a sword, and a sharp arrow.
- Proverbs 26:18 As a mad *man* who casteth firebrands, <u>arrows</u>, and death,
- Isaiah 5:28 Whose <u>arrows</u> *are* sharp, and all their bows bent, their horses' hoofs shall be counted like flint, and their wheels like a whirlwind:
- Isaiah 7:24 With <u>arrows</u> and with bows shall *men* come thither; because all the land shall become briers and thorns.

- Isaiah 37:33 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the king of Assyria, He shall not come into this city, nor shoot an <u>arrow</u> there, nor come before it with shields, nor cast a bank against it.
- Jeremiah 9:8 Their tongue *is as* an <u>arrow</u> shot out; it speaketh deceit: *one* speaketh peaceably to his neighbour with his mouth, but in heart he layeth his wait.
- Jeremiah 50:9 For, Io, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows shall be as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in vain.
- Jeremiah 50:14 Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no <u>arrows</u>: for she hath sinned against the LORD.
- Jeremiah 51:11 Make bright the <u>arrows</u>; gather the shields: the LORD hath raised up the spirit of the kings of the Medes: for his device *is* against Babylon, to destroy it; because it *is* the vengeance of the LORD, the vengeance of his temple.
- Lamentations 3:12,13 He hath bent his bow, and set me as a mark for the <u>arrow</u>. 13 He hath caused the <u>arrows</u> of his quiver to enter into my reins.
- Ezekiel 5:16 When I shall send upon them the evil <u>arrows</u> of famine, which shall be for *their* destruction, *and* which I will send to destroy you: and I will increase the famine upon you, and will break your staff of bread:
- Ezekiel 21:21 For the king of Babylon stood at the parting of the way, at the head of the two ways, to use divination: he made *his* <u>arrows</u> bright, he consulted with images, he looked in the liver.
- Ezekiel 39:3 And I will smite thy bow out of thy left hand, and will cause thine <u>arrows</u> to fall out of thy right hand.
- Ezekiel 39:9 And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the <u>arrows</u>, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:
- Habakkuk 3:11 The sun *and* moon stood still in their habitation: at the light of thine arrows they went, *and* at the shining of thy glittering spear.
- Zechariah 9:14 And the LORD shall be seen over them, and His <u>arrow</u> shall go forth as the lightning: and the Lord GOD shall blow the trumpet, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south.
