Jesus Christ Conquers Palsy - Matthew 8B

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Matthew 5-7 Referred to the sermon on the Mount.

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Matthew 8:5-13 And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto Him a centurion, beseeching him, 6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented. 7 And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him. 8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that Thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. 9 For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this *man*, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. 10 When Jesus heard it, He marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. 11 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. 12 But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. 13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. Matthew 8:5 And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto Him a centurion, beseeching him,

Summarized of some Roman religions of that time.

Matthew 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

Matthew 8:6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

Mark 9:29 And He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.

In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just praying for healing.

Matthew 8:7 And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.

Isaiah 58:8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.

Psalms 44:4 Thou art my King, O God: command deliverances for Jacob.

Matthew 8:8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that Thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the

- wind, have taken us away.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Matthew 8:9,10 For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this *man*, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth *it*. 10 When Jesus heard *it*, He marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.
- Mark 7 Summarized of the Syrophenician woman having Jesus deliver her daughter long distance.
- Matthew 8:11,12 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. 12 But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Luke 13:28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you yourselves thrust out.
- Luke 16 Parable of the Rich man & Lazarus referred to.
- Matthew 8:13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.
- Matthew 4:23-25 Referred to Jesus ministering & healing all over the place. Strongs #3885. παραλυτικος paralutikos *par-al-oo-tee-kos*; from a derivative of 3886; as if dissolved, i.e. "paralytic": that had (sick of) the palsy.
- Concise Bible Dictionary Palsy The Greek word, παραλυω, to loosen, shews that the disease was paralysis. Persons thus afflicted were brought to the Lord on beds or couches. Mat 9:2-6 Mark 2:3-10 Luke 5:18,24 Acts 8:7 9:33. The paralysed were a type of that thorough human helplessness which can be relieved and raised up by God only.
- Matthew 4:24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the <u>palsy</u>; and He healed them.
- Matthew & Luke 8 Referred to the gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus. Matthew 8:6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the <u>palsy</u>, grievously tormented.
- Matthew 9:2,6 And, behold, they brought to Him a man sick of the <u>palsy</u>, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the <u>palsy</u>; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee. 6 But that ye may know that

- the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.
- Mark 2:3-5 And they come unto Him, bringing one sick of the <u>palsy</u>, which was borne of four. 4 And when they could not come nigh unto Him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken *it* up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the <u>palsy</u> lay. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, He said unto the sick of the <u>palsy</u>, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.
- Mark 2:9,10 Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the <u>palsy</u>, *Thy* sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk? 10 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (He saith to the sick of the palsy,)
- Luke 5:18 And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a <u>palsy</u>: and they sought *means* to bring him in, and to lay *him* before Him.
- Luke 5:24 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (He said unto the sick of the <u>palsy</u>,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.
- Acts 9:33 And there he found a certain man named Æneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the <u>palsy</u>.
- An example of Godly friends interceding for needy people.
- Luke 5:17-26 V17 And it came to pass on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was present to heal them.
- Mark 12:13 And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch him in his words.
- Mark 10:47,48 And when he (Blind Bartimaeus) heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 48 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me.
- Luke 5:18,19 And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought means to bring him in, and to lay him before Him. 19 And when they could not find by what way they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with his couch into the midst before Jesus.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 9:41 And Jesus answering said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you, and suffer you? Bring thy son hither.
- Luke 5:20 And when He saw their faith, He said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I

- the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third & fourth generation of them that hate me;
- 2 Kings 5:27 The leprosy therefore of Naaman shall cleave unto thee (Gehazi), and unto thy seed for ever. And he went out from his presence a leper as white as snow.
- Luke 5:21 And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?
- Matthew 7:21,23 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven. 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.
- Luke 5:22,23 But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answering said unto them, What reason ye in your hearts? 23 Whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Rise up and walk?
- Leviticus 13 Summarized of the law about one healed from leprosy.
- Luke 5:24,25 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (He said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house. 25 And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.
- Acts 3:8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Referred to healed Ex-Blind Bart. following Jesus & the Gadarene Ex-Demoniac wanted to follow Jesus.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Luke 5:26 And they were all amazed, and they glorified God, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day.
- Matthew 8:10 When Jesus heard *it*, He marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not <u>found so great faith</u>, no, not in Israel.
- Luke 7:9 When Jesus heard these things, He marvelled at him, and turned Him about, and said unto the people that followed Him, I say unto you, I have not <u>found so great faith</u>, no, not in Israel.
- Luke 18:8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, <u>shall He find faith</u> on the earth?
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My words shall not

pass away.

- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Matthew 7 Referred to the parable of the houses built on a Rock or sand. Revelation 13 Referred to those taking the mark of the beast.
- Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- 1 Peter 1:7 That the trial of your <u>faith</u>, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be <u>found</u> unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.
- Matthew 7 Summarized of the false prophets Jesus warned of.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Luke 18 referred to the persistant widow.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
