## **The Spirit Of Idleness - Ecclesiastes 10**

- 1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Acts 4 & 5 Referred to the early disciples sharing together.
- Acts 4:34 Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,
- Matthew 15:8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.
- Genesis 2:2 And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had made; and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had made.
- Exodus 5:8 And the tale of the bricks, which they did make heretofore, ye shall lay upon them; ye shall not diminish *ought* thereof: for they *be* <u>idle</u>; therefore they cry, saying, Let us go *and* sacrifice to our God.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Revelation 19 Referred to our Lord returning again.
- Exodus 5:17 But he said, Ye *are* idle, ye are idle: therefore ye say, Let us go and do sacrifice to the LORD.
- Proverbs 19:15 <u>Slothfulness</u> casteth into a deep sleep; and an <u>idle soul</u> shall suffer hunger.
- Ecclesiastes 3:1,2 To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven: 2 A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted;
- Proverbs 31:27 She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness.
- Proverbs 31:13,15,16 She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands. 15 She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens. 16 She considereth a field, and buyeth it: with the fruit of her hands she planteth a vineyard.
- Proverbs 31:19,24 She layeth her hands to the spindle, and her hands hold the distaff. 24 She maketh fine linen, and selleth it; and delivereth girdles unto the merchant.
- Ecclesiastes 10:18 By <u>much slothfulness</u> the building decayeth; and through <u>idleness of the hands</u> the house droppeth through.
- Luke 6:12 And it came to pass in those days, that He went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.
- Ezekiel 16:49 Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and <u>abundance of idleness</u> was in her and in her daughters,

- neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.
- Genesis 19 Summarized of Sodom's sins judged.
- Job 41 Referred to the chapter on Leviathan V34 He beholdeth all high things: he is a king over all the children of pride.
- Daniel 5:20 But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him:
- Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, That every <u>idle word</u> that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.
- James 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- James 1:26 If any man among you seem to be religious, and <u>bridleth not his</u> <u>tongue</u>, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.
- Matthew 20:3 And he went out about the third hour, and saw others standing <u>idle</u> in the marketplace,
- Matthew 20:6 And about the eleventh hour he went out, and found others standing <u>idle</u>, and saith unto them, Why stand ye here all the day <u>idle</u>?
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for <u>God loveth a cheerful giver</u>.
- Luke 10:2 Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- John 3:16,17 For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.
- Luke 24:11 And their words seemed to them as <u>idle</u> tales, and they believed them not.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they learn *to be* <u>idle</u>, wandering about from house to house; and not only <u>idle</u>, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.
- 1 Timothy 5:11-16 V11 (AV) But the younger widows refuse: for when they have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they will marry;
- 1 Timothy 5:11 (ESV) But refuse to enroll younger widows, for when their passions draw them away from Christ, they desire to marry
- 1 Timothy 5:12 Having damnation, because they have cast off their first faith.
- Jonah Summarized Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.

- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they learn *to be* idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.
- James 3:5 Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!
- Proverbs 26:20 Where no wood is, there the fire goeth out: so where there is no talebearer, the strife ceaseth.
- 1 Timothy 5:14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

**Proverbs 31 Referred to the Virtuous Woman.** 

1 Timothy 5:15,16 For some are already turned aside after Satan. 16 If any man or woman that believes have widows, let them relieve them, & let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed.

Summarized of our Lord Jesus Christ ministering to the people.

Referred to Isaiah 61 Read by Jesus in Luke 4.

Mark 16:17,18 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

- Strongs #07503. raphah *raw-faw*; a primitive root; to slacken (in many applications, literal or figurative): abate, cease, consume, draw toward evening, fail, (be) faint, be (wax) feeble, forsake, idle, leave, let alone (go, down), (be) slack, stay, be still, be slothful, (be) weak(-en). See <u>07495</u>.
- Strongs #07423. r@miyah *rem-ee-yaw*\*; from <u>07411</u>; remissness, treachery: deceit(-ful, fully), false, guile, idle, slack, slothful.
- Strongs #06104. 'atsluwth ats-looth'; rom 06101; indolence: idleness.
- Strongs #08220. shiphluwth *shif-looth*, from <u>08213</u>; remissness: idleness.
- Strongs #08252. shaqat *shaw-kat*\*; a primitive root; to repose (usually figurative): appease, idleness, (at, be at, be in, give) quiet(-ness), (be at, be in, give, have, take) rest, settle, be still.
- Strongs #692. argos *ar-gos*; from <u>1</u> (as a negative particle) and <u>2041;</u> inactive, i.e. unemployed; (by implication) lazy, useless: barren, idle, slow.
- Strongs #3026. leros *lay'-ros*; apparently a primary word; twaddle, i.e. an incredible story: idle tale.
