Jesus Christ Conquers Fever - Matthew 8C

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. Summarized of different healings our Lord Jesus did.

Luke 18 Referred to the Parable of the persistant widow.

- Matthew 8:14 (AV) And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, He saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. 15 And He touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them. 16 When the even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed with devils (demons): and He cast out the spirits with *His* word, and healed all that were sick: 17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare *our* sicknesses.
- Matthew 8 Referred to the previous healing of the man with palsy by the faith of his friends.
- Matthew 8:14 (NKJV) Now when Jesus had come into Peter's house, He saw his wife's mother lying sick with a fever.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- Matthew 8:15 So He touched her hand, and the fever left her. And she arose and served them.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- In Matthew 10; Luke 9 & 10 Jesus sent out the disciples to pray in Jesus' name to heal, etc.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Matthew 8:16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: He Himself took our infirmities And bore *our* sicknesses. (Isaiah 53)
- Strongs #4445 puresso *poo-res'-so* AV-be sick of a fever 2; 1) to be sick with a fever

- Easton's Bible Dictionary Fever Deut 28:22 Mat 8:14 Mark 1:30 John 4:52 Acts 28:8 a burning heat, as the word so rendered denotes, which attends all febrile attacks. In all Eastern countries such diseases are very common. Peter's wife's mother is said to have suffered from a "great fever" Luke 4:38 an instance of Luke's professional exactitude in describing disease. He adopts here the technical medical distinction, as in those times fevers were divided into the "great" and the "less."
- Deuteronomy 28:22 The LORD shall smite thee with a consumption, and with a <u>fever</u>, and with an inflammation, and with an extreme burning, and with the sword, and with blasting, and with mildew; and they shall pursue thee until thou perish.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Strongs #06920 qaddachath *kad-dakh'- ath* AV-burning ague 1, fever 1; 1) fever
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God's judgements to turn His people back to Him. Matthew 8:14,15 And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, He saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a <u>fever</u>. 15 And He touched her hand, and the <u>fever</u> left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.
- Mark 1:30,31 But Simon's wife's mother lay sick of a <u>fever</u>, and anon they tell Him of her. 31 And He came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the <u>fever</u> left her, and she ministered unto them.
- Luke 4:38,39 And He arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever; and they besought Him for her. 39 And He stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them.
- Mark 8:32,33 And He spake that saying openly. And Peter took Him, and began to rebuke Him. 33 But when He had turned about and looked on His disciples, He rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- John 4:52 Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the <u>fever</u> left him. John 4:49 The nobleman saith unto Him, Sir, come down ere my child die. Mark 2:17 When Jesus heard it, he saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call

- the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
- Acts 28:8 And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a <u>fever</u> and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him.
- Romans 12 & 1 Corinthians 12 Referred to the list of Godly gifts included different gifts of healing.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just praying for healing.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Leviticus 26:16 I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague (Strongs #06920 fever), that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to Me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Judges 6:11 And there came an angel of the LORD, and sat under an oak which was in Ophrah, that pertained unto Joash the Abiezrite: and his son Gideon threshed wheat by the winepress, to hide it from the Midianites.
- Job 30:30 My skin is black upon me, and my bones are burned with heat. Psalms 22:15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death.
- Hebrews 4:14,15 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. 15 For we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.
- Isaiah 53:1-12 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? 2 For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. 3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. 4 Surely He hath borne our griefs, and carried our

sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. 5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on Him the iniquity of us all. 7 He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so He openeth not His mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare His generation? for He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of My people was Me stricken. 9 And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth. 10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He hath put Him to grief: when Thou shalt make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see his seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. 11 He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous servant justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities. 12 Therefore will I divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He hath poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the transgressors; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

- Isaiah 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed.
- Isaiah 53:4 Surely He hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols (the occult), and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- 2 Kings 17:33 They feared the LORD, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations whom they carried away from thence.
- John 4:46 So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum.
- John 2 Referred to the miracle of turning water into fresh wine. V10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.
- John 4:47 When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee,

- he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 V9 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- John 4:48 Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.
- John 20:29 Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.
- John 4:49,50 The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die. 50 Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.
- John 11:43 And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- John 4:51-53 And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth. 52 Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him. 53 So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.
- John 4 Jesus revealed Himself to the woman at the well first as a good man, then as a prophet, then as the Messiah.
- Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- John 16:8 And when He (Holy Spirit) is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Romans 1:31 Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful:
