## **God Will Bring His People Together Again - Ezekiel 37**

- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Summarized of God judging His rebellious people.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- Ezekiel 37:1-28 V1 The hand of the LORD came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it was full of bones.
- Acts 8:39,40 And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. 40 But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea.
- Ezekiel 8 Referred to the vision through the hole in the wall.
- Ezekiel 37:2 Then He caused me to pass by them all around, and behold, there were very many in the open valley; and indeed they were very dry.
- Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- Ezekiel 37:3 And He said to me, Son of man, can these bones live? So I answered, O Lord GOD, You know.
- Referred to the miracles of Elijah & Elisha.
- John 11 Summarized of Lazarus raised. V25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.
- Ezekiel 37:4 Again He said to me, Prophesy to these bones, and say to them, O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD!
- Summarized of how God worked through Moses to perform many miracles.

- John 11:43 And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- Revelation 19 Referred to Our Lord's return & the resurrection of the dead for the final judgment.
- Ezekiel 37:5 Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones: Surely <u>I will cause</u> breath to enter into you, and you shall live.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- Luke 16 Summarized of the Rich man & Lazarus.
- Exodus 32-34 Summarized of the golden calf incident & Moses interceding for them.
- Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
- Ezekiel 37:6 I will put sinews on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and <u>put breath in you; and you shall live</u>. Then you shall know that I am the LORD.
- Breath of Life represents God's Holy Spirit.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 1 Kings 18 Summarized of the shoot out on Mount Carmel. V21 And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word. V37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.
- John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Ezekiel 37:7-9 So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone. 8 Indeed, as I looked, the sinews and the flesh came upon them, and the skin covered them over; but there was no breath in them. 9 Also He said to me, Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, Thus says the Lord GOD: Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is

- in heaven. 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Luke 10:2 Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.
- Ezekiel 37:10 So I prophesied as He commanded me, and breath came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Ezekiel 37:11 Then He said to me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!
- Leviticus 26 Summarized of God 's judgment on His people.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.
- Luke 8 Referred to the seed producing fruit.
- Ezekiel 37:12 Therefore prophesy and say to them, Thus says the Lord GOD: Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.
- Ezra 1:1,2 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and put it also in writing, saying, 2 Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah.
- Numbers 14:4 And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let

- us return into Egypt.
- Ezekiel 37:13 Then you shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves.
- Ezra & Nehemiah Summarized of the rebuilding of Jerusalem.
- Ezekiel 37:14 I will put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the LORD, have spoken it and performed it, says the LORD.
- Acts 1 versus Acts 2 shows the difference with the Holy Spirit.
- Daniel 9:2,3 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem. 3 And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:
- Ezekiel 37:15,16 Again the word of the LORD came to me, saying, 16 As for you, son of man, take a stick for yourself and write on it: For Judah and for the children of Israel, his companions. Then take another stick and write on it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Israel, his companions.
- Referred to Solomon sinning because of his many ungodly wives.
- Deuteronomy Referred to that the kings were to write out the Law & read it daily, & have just one wife, etc...
- 1 Timothy 3:2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;
- 1 Timothy 3:12 Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well.
- Ezekiel 37:17 Then join them one to another for yourself into one stick, and they will become one in your hand.
- Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
- Ezekiel 37:18-21 And when the children of your people speak to you, saying, Will you not show us what you mean by these? 19 say to them, Thus says the Lord GOD: Surely I will take the stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel, his companions; and I will join them with it, with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they will be one in My hand. 20 And the sticks on which you write will be in your hand before their eyes. 21 Then say to them, Thus says the Lord GOD: Surely I will take the children of Israel from among the

- nations, wherever they have gone, and will gather them from every side and bring them into their own land;
- In 1949 this was fulfilled & more have returned since then.
- Ezekiel 37:22 and I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel; and one king shall be king over them all; they shall no longer be two nations, nor shall they ever be divided into two kingdoms again.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Ezekiel 37:23 They shall not defile themselves anymore with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions; but I will deliver them from all their dwelling places in which they have sinned, and will cleanse them. Then they shall be My people, and I will be their God.
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 V9 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
- Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
- Exodus 19:10 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, 11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.
- Exodus 23:2 Thou shalt not follow a multitude to do evil; neither shalt thou speak in a cause to decline after many to wrest judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Ezekiel 37:24 David My servant shall be king over them, and they shall all

- have one shepherd; they shall also walk in My judgments and observe My statutes, and do them.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- Ezekiel 37:25 Then they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, where your fathers dwelt; and they shall dwell there, they, their children, and their childrens children, forever; and My servant David shall be their prince forever.
- Revelation 16:16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.
- Ezekiel 37:26 Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them, and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them; I will establish them and multiply them, and I will set My sanctuary in their midst forevermore.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
- Revelation 11 Summarized of the 2 witnesses.
- Ezekiel 37:27 My tabernacle also shall be with them; indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people.
- Ezekiel 37:28 The nations also will know that I, the LORD, sanctify Israel, when My sanctuary is in their midst forevermore.
- Judges 2:9,10 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you. 10 For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed.
- Referred to the Prodigal son returning to his senses.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
