## **New Wine Needs New Bottles - Matthew 9C**

- Luke 7:28 For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.
- Luke 11:50 That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation;
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Ephesians 1:14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Acts 1 & 2 Referred to the difference with the Baptism or Infilling of Holy Spirit at Penticost.
- Acts 8:39,40 And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. 40 But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea.
- Matthew, Blind Bart, & the Gadarene all left all to follow Jesus.
- Matthew 9:14-17 Then came to Him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast oft, but Thy disciples fast not? 15 And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber mourn, as long as the bridegroom is with them? but the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast. 16 No man putteth a piece of new cloth unto an old garment, for that which is

put in to fill it up taketh from the garment, and the rent is made worse. 17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.

- Mark 2:18-22 And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto Him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but Thy disciples fast not? 19 And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber fast, while the bridegroom is with them? as long as they have the bridegroom with them, they cannot fast. 20 But the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days. 21 No man also seweth a piece of new cloth on an old garment: else the new piece that filled it up taketh away from the old, and the rent is made worse. 22 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles: else the new wine doth burst the bottles, and the wine is spilled, and the bottles will be marred: but new wine must be put into new bottles.
- Luke 5:33-39 And they said unto Him, Why do the disciples of John fast often, and make prayers, and likewise the disciples of the Pharisees; but Thine eat and drink? 34 And He said unto them, Can ye make the children of the bridechamber fast, while the bridegroom is with them? 35 But the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days. 36 And He spake also a parable unto them; No man putteth a piece of a new garment upon an old; if otherwise, then both the new maketh a rent, and the piece that was taken out of the new agreeth not with the old. 37 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish. 38 But new wine must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved. 39 No man also having drunk old wine straightway desireth new: for he saith, The old is better.
- Matthew 9:14 Then came to Him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast oft, but Thy disciples fast not?
- Mark 2:18 And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto Him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but Thy disciples fast not?
- Luke 5:33 And they said unto Him, Why do the disciples of John fast often, and make prayers, and likewise *the disciples* of the Pharisees; but Thine eat and drink?
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- John 1:36,37 And looking upon Jesus as he (John the Baptist) walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God! 37 And the two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.
- John 3:28,30 Ye yourselves bear me witness, that I said, I am not the Christ, but that I am sent before him. 30 He must increase, but I must decrease.
- Matthew 9:15 And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber mourn, as long as the bridegroom is with them? but the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast.
- Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:
- Numbers 14:22,23,31 Because all those men which have seen my glory, and my miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice; 23 Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it: 31 But your little ones, which ye said should be a prey, them will I bring in, and they shall know the land which ye have despised.
- Hebrews 5:12,13 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.
- Isaiah 58:6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?
- Mark 9:29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.
- Luke 8:37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again.
- Matthew 9:16,17 No man putteth a piece of new cloth unto an old garment, for that which is put in to fill it up taketh from the garment, and the rent is made worse. 17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.
- Acts 8:21 Thou (Simon Magus) hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Luke 5:39 No man also having drunk old *wine* straightway desireth new: for he saith, The old is better.
- 1 Peter 4:4,5 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you: 5 Who shall give account to him that is ready to judge the quick and the dead.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Deuteronomy 1:30 The LORD your <u>God which goeth before you</u>, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes;
- Isaiah 52:12 For ye shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight: for the LORD will go before you; and the God of Israel will be your rereward.
- Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, <u>Yea, hath</u> <u>God said</u>, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- Matthew 26:32 But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee.

- Matthew 28:7 And go quickly, and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead; and, behold, <u>He goeth before you</u> into Galilee; there shall ye see Him: lo, I have told you.
- John 14 Referred to Jesus asking "Peter do you love Me?"
- Mark 14:28 But after that I am risen, I will go before you into Galilee.
- Mark 16:7 But go your way, tell His disciples and Peter that <u>He goeth</u> before you into Galilee: there shall ye see Him, as He said unto you.
- John 10:2,3 But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. 3 To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.
- Matthew 9:17 Neither do men put <u>new wine</u> into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put <u>new wine</u> into new bottles, and both are preserved.
- Mark 2:22 And no man putteth <u>new wine</u> into old bottles: else the <u>new wine</u> doth burst the bottles, and the wine is spilled, and the bottles will be marred: but new wine must be put into new bottles.
- Luke 5:37,38 And no man putteth <u>new wine</u> into old bottles; else the <u>new wine</u> will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish.

  38 But <u>new wine</u> must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved.
- Acts 2:13 Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.
- Strongs #1098 gleukos *glyoo'-kos* AV-new wine 1; 1) the sweet juice pressed the grape, sweet wine.
- Matthew 26:29 But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this <u>fruit of</u> <u>the vine</u>, until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom.
- Mark 14:25 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the <u>fruit of the vine</u>, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.
- Luke 22:18 For I say unto you, I will not drink of the <u>fruit of the vine</u>, until the kingdom of God shall come.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Matthew 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.
- Acts 8:23 For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity. (Simon Magus)
- Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found

David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.

Psalms 51 Referred to David repenting.

- 2 Samuel 12:13 And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.
- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the <u>Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil</u> spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- 1 Samuel 15 Summarized of God sending Saul to destroy Amalek.
- Luke 11:26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.
- 1 Samuel 15:27,28 And as Samuel turned about to go away, he laid hold upon the skirt of his mantle, and it rent. 28 And Samuel said unto him, The LORD hath rent the kingdom of Israel from thee this day, and hath given it to a neighbour of thine, that is better than thou.
- 1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.
- Referred to the account of Saul at the Witch at Endor Saul did or didn't God's way inquire of God.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- 1 Samuel 16:23 And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
- 1 Samuel 18 & 19 Referred to when Saul cast the javelin at David often when the evil spirit controlled him.
- John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.
- Mark 9:29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
