- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by casting out demons.
- Mark 9:29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Luke 10:2 Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.
- Leviticus 11 Referred to the laws of clean & unclean foods.
- Mark 7:21-23 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: (etc) 23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Luke 18:1-8 V1 And He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Luke 18:2-8 Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man: 3 And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. 4 And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man; 5 Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me. 6 And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith. 7 And shall not God avenge His own elect, which cry day and night unto Him, though He bear long with them? 8 I tell you that

- He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?
- Deuteronomy 28:53 (NKJV) You shall eat the fruit of your own body, the flesh of your sons and your daughters whom the LORD your God has given you, in the siege and <u>desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you</u>.
- Deuteronomy 28:55 so that he will not give any of them the flesh of his children whom he will eat, because he has nothing left in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you at all your gates.
- Deuteronomy 28:57 her placenta which comes out from between her feet and her children whom she bears; for she will eat them secretly for lack of everything in the siege and <u>desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you</u> at all your gates.
- Job 6:26 Do you intend to rebuke *my* words, And the speeches of a <u>desperate</u> one, *which are* as wind?
- Job 1:22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- Ephesians 5:20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's Perils.
- Acts 16:30,31 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- Job 27:22 It hurls against him and does not spare; He flees <u>desperately</u> from its power.
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.
- Ephesians 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing.
- Isaiah 17:11 In the day you will make your plant to grow, And in the morning you will make your seed to flourish; *But* the harvest *will be* a heap of ruins In the day of grief and desperate sorrow.
