- Matthew 8&9 Summarized of many miracles our Lord Jesus did.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Matthew 9:27-34 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed Him, crying, and saying, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on us. 28 And when He was come into the house, the blind men came to Him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto Him, Yea, Lord. 29 Then touched He their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. 30 And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See *that* no man know *it*. 31 But they, when they were departed, spread abroad His fame in all that country. 32 As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a dumb man possessed with a devil. 33 And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel. 34 But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of the devils.
- Referred to Jairus' daughter raised; the woman healed, & Lazarus raised. Matthew 9:27 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed Him, crying, and saying, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on us.
- Psalms 136 every second line is "for His mercy endureth for ever."
- Luke 18:1 And He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- Matthew 9:28,29 And when He was come into the house, the blind men came to Him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto Him, Yea, Lord. 29 Then touched He their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.
- Acts 8:20,21 But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. 21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

- Matthew 9:30-32 And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See *that* no man know *it*. 31 But they, when they were departed, spread abroad His fame in all that country. 32 As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a dumb man possessed (oppressed) with a devil.
- In the Gospel of Mark, many people are healed by casting out demons.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 9:33 And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.
- 1 Samuel 18:10,11 And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played with his hand, as at other times: and there was a javelin in Saul's hand. 11 And Saul cast the javelin; for he said, I will smite David even to the wall with it. And David avoided out of his presence twice.
- Matthew 9:34 But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils (demons) through the prince of the devils (satan).
- Revelation 2&3 Our Lord Jesus warned "Repent or else ..."
- Isaiah 35:5 Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.
- Isaiah 61 Read by Jesus in Luke 4:21,29 And He began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears. 29 And rose up, and thrust Him out of the city, and led Him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast Him down headlong.
- Isaiah 42:7 To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, *and* them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Psalms 72:12,13 For He shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and *him* that hath no helper. 13 He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.
- Mark 10:46-52 V46 And they came to Jericho: and as He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging. John 9:2,3 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this

- man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- John 5 & 8 Jesus said "Go & sin no more."
- Mark 10:47-49 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 48 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 49 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee.
- Mark 2:3 And they come unto Him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.
- Luke 19: 3 And he (Zacchaeus ) sought to see Jesus who He was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature.
- Mark 10:50,51 And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. 51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto Him, Lord, that I might receive my sight.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith (in Jesus) hath made thee whole. And <u>immediately he received his sight</u>, and followed Jesus in the way.
- Acts 9:18 And immediately there fell from his (Paul's) eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized.
- Mark 10 Referred to the rich young ruler who loved money more than the Lord.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while

- some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Luke 18:35-43 And it came to pass, that as He was come nigh unto Jericho, a certain blind man sat by the way side begging: 36 And hearing the multitude pass by, he asked what it meant. 37 And they told him, that Jesus of Nazareth passeth by. 38 And he cried, saying, Jesus, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 39 And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 40 And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto him: and when he was come near, He asked him, 41 Saying, What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. 42 And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith (in Jesus Christ) hath saved thee. 43 And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise unto God.

Luke 17 Referred to the account of the ten lepers healed. John 11 referred to Lazarus raised.

- Matthew 20:29-34 V29-31 And as they departed from Jericho, a great multitude followed Him. 30 And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, Thou Son of David. (Messiah) 31 And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, Thou Son of David.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- In the Gospel of John Jesus reveals Himself first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Matthew 20:32 And Jesus stood still, and called them, and said, What will ye that I shall do unto you? 33 They say unto Him, Lord, that our eyes may be opened. 34 So Jesus had compassion on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they

followed Him.

- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- Mark 8:22-26 V22-25 And He cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto Him, and besought (begged) Him to touch Him. 23 And He took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when He had spit on his eyes, and put His hands upon him, He asked him if he saw ought. 24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. 25 After that He put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.
- Some times Our Lord healed blindness by using clay; or sending to wash in the pool of Siloam; or speaking the healing, etc.
- Mark 8:26 And He sent him away to his house, saying, Neither go into the town, nor tell it to any in the town.
- John 11:48 If we let him thus alone, all men will believe on him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation. 49 And one of them, named Caiaphas, being the high priest that same year, said unto them, Ye know nothing at all, 50 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.
- Luke 8:38-40 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought Him that he might be with Him: but Jesus sent him away, saying, 39 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him. 40 And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people gladly received Him: for they were all waiting for Him.
- Sometimes Jesus healed long distance like the Syrophenician woman's daughter, & centurion's servant.
- Mark 7:35 And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.
