Jesus Christ Is Our Compassionate Friend - Matthew 9F

- Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Matthew 9:35-38 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. 36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. 37 Then saith He unto His disciples, The harvest truly *is* plenteous, but the labourers *are* few; 38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth labourers into His harvest.
- Matthew 9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, <u>teaching</u> in their synagogues, and <u>preaching</u> the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing</u> every sickness and every disease among the people.
- Jude 1:3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should <u>earnestly contend for the faith</u> which was once delivered unto the saints.
- Mark 2:27 And He said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:
- Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD:
- Isaiah 53 & Psalms 22 Foretold Jesus the Suffering Servant.
- 1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Strongs #3554. nosos *nos'-os*; of uncertain affinity; a malady (rarely

- figuratively, of moral disability): disease, infirmity, sickness.
- Strongs #3119. malakia *mal-ak-ee'-ah*; from <u>3120;</u> softness, i.e. enervation (debility): disease.
- Matthew 9:36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was <u>moved with</u> <u>compassion</u> on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.
- **Compassion is Love in Action.**
- Strongs #4697. splagchnizomai *splangkh-nid'-zom-ahee*; middle voice from <u>4698</u>; to have the bowels yearn, i.e. (figuratively) feel sympathy, to pity: have (be moved with) compassion.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- Strongs #1590. ekluo *ek-loo'-o*; from <u>1537</u> and <u>3089</u>; to relax (literally or figuratively): faint.
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died;
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's In Perils chapter. V26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in <u>perils among false brethren</u>;
- Titus 3:10 A man that is a heretick after the first & second admonition reject; John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Matthew 9:37 Then saith He unto His disciples, The harvest truly *is* plenteous, but the labourers *are* few;
- 1 Corinthians 12:4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- James 4:4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.
- John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Acts 9 Referred to Saul's conversion on the road to Damascus.
- Matthew 9:38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth labourers into His harvest.
- Luke 4 Referred to when Jesus read Isaiah 61.

Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them. 25 And there followed Him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and *from* Decapolis, and *from* Jerusalem, and *from* Judaea, and *from* beyond Jordan.

Matthew 8 & 9 Jesus fulfilled what He came down to do.

Summarized of Jesus & what He did for our salvation.

- John 3:16-18 V16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.
- John 3:17 For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. 18 He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Luke 4 Summarized of Jesus' testings in the wilderness.

Luke 4:14-21 - 14 And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of Him through all the region round about. 15 And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all. 16 And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up: and, as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read. 17 And there was delivered unto Him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written, (Isaiah 61) 18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He hath anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He hath sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, 19 To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. 20 And He closed the book, and He gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on Him. 21 And He began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

Luke 24:44 And He said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto

- you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning Me.
- Mark 16:14-18 14 Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen Him after He was risen.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Matthew 24:12 & because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- 2 Samuel 15 Summarized of Absalom V6 And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. Genesis 3 Summarized of Adam's fall & hid from God.
- Mark 16:15,16 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Romans 10:9,10,13 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus taking on the Religious Leaders.
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
