Spirit Of Compassion - 1 Peter 3

- Luke 10 Referred to the parable of the Good Samaritan.
- Numbers 14:1 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried; and the people wept that night.
- 1 Peter 3:8-15 Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: 9 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing. 10 For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: 11 Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. 12 For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and His ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil. 13 And who is he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good? 14 But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled; 15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:
- 1 Corinthians 2:16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.
- 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, *be ye* all of one mind, <u>having compassion one of another</u>, love as brethren, *be* pitiful, *be* courteous:
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Titus 2:4 That they (aged women like) may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, etc...
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- 1 Timothy 5:5-12 (Summarized) Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusteth in God, and continueth in supplications and prayers night and day. 9 Let not a widow be taken into the number under threescore years old, having been the wife of one man, 10 Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work. 11 But the younger widows refuse: for when they have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they will marry; 12 Having damnation, because they have cast off their first faith. 13 And withal they learn to be idle, wandering about from

- house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not. 14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully. 15 For some are already turned aside after Satan. 16 If any man or woman that believeth have widows, let them relieve them, and let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed.
- Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is <u>love</u>, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
- Matthew 9:36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil? (Judas)
- Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Romans 1:31 (AV) Without understanding, covenantbreakers, <u>without natural</u> <u>affection</u>, implacable, unmerciful:
- Romans 1:31 (NKJV) undiscerning, untrustworthy, <u>unloving</u>, unforgiving, unmerciful;
- 2 Timothy 3:3 (AV) <u>Without natural affection</u>, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,
- 2 Timothy 3:3 (NKJV) <u>unloving</u>, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,
- Strongs#02550. chamal *khaw-mal*; a primitive root; to commiserate; by implication, to spare: have compassion, (have) pity, spare.
- Strongs#4697. splagchnizomai *splangkh-nid'-zom-ahee*; middle voice from <u>4698</u>; to have the bowels yearn, i.e. (figuratively) feel sympathy, to pity: have (be moved with) compassion.
- Exodus 23:4,5 If thou meet thine enemy's ox or his ass going astray, thou shalt surely bring it back to him again. 5 If thou see the ass of him that hateth thee lying under his burden, and wouldest forbear to help him, thou shalt surely help with him.
- Ruth 1:16 And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God:
- Exodus 2:6-7 (AV) And when she had opened *it*, she saw the child: and, behold, the babe wept. And she <u>had compassion on him</u>, and said, This *is one* of the Hebrews' children. 7 Then said his sister to Pharaoh's daughter, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may

- nurse the child for thee? 8 And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother.
- Exodus 2:6 (NKJV) And when she had opened *it*, she saw the child, and behold, the baby wept. So she <u>had compassion on him</u>, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children.
- Exodus 33:19 (AV) And He said, I will make all My goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.
- Exodus 33:19 (NKJV) Then He said, I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Deuteronomy 13:17 (AV) And there shall cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of His anger, and shew thee mercy, and have compassion upon thee, and multiply thee, as He hath sworn unto thy fathers;
- Deuteronomy 13:17 (NKJV) So none of the accursed things shall remain in your hand, that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of His anger and show you mercy, have compassion on you and multiply you, just as He swore to your fathers,
- Numbers 13 Referred to God's views on idols.
- Exodus 34:14 For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God:
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Deuteronomy 30:3 (AV) That then the LORD thy God will turn thy captivity, and have compassion upon thee, and will return and gather thee from all the nations, whither the LORD thy God hath scattered thee.
- Deuteronomy 30:3 (NKJV) that the LORD your God will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you.
- Leviticus 26 Summarizes God's judgment.
- Deuteronomy 32:36 (AV) For the LORD shall judge His people, and repent Himself for His servants, when He seeth that *their* power is gone, and

there is none shut up, or left.

- Deuteronomy 32:36 (NKJV) For the LORD will judge His people And have compassion on His servants, When He sees that *their* power is gone, And *there is* no one *remaining*, bond or free.
- 1 Samuel 23:21 (AV) And Saul said, Blessed *be* ye of the LORD; for ye have compassion on me.
- 1 Samuel 23:21 (NKJV) And Saul said, Blessed *are* you of the LORD, for you have compassion on me.

Summarized of many times David did not hurt Saul.

- 1 Samuel 26:23 The LORD render to every man his righteousness and his faithfulness: for the LORD delivered thee into my hand to day, but I would not stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed.
- 1 Kings 3:26 (AV) Then spake the woman whose the living child *was* unto the king, for her <u>bowels yearned</u> upon her son, and she said, O my lord, give her the living child, and in no wise slay it. But the other said, Let it be neither mine nor thine, *but* divide *it*. (Summarized)
- 1 Kings 3:26 (NKJV) Then the woman whose son *was* living spoke to the king, for she <u>yearned with compassion</u> for her son; and she said, 0 my lord, give her the living child, and by no means kill him! But the other said, Let him be neither mine nor yours, *but* divide *him*.
- Deuteronomy 17:17 Neither shall he (king) multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold.
- 1 Kings 8:50 (AV) And forgive Thy people that have sinned against Thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against Thee, and give them <u>compassion</u> before them who carried them captive, that they may have <u>compassion</u> on them:
- 1 Kings 8:50 (NKJV) and forgive Your people who have sinned against You, and all their transgressions which they have transgressed against You; and grant them <u>compassion</u> before those who took them captive, that they may have <u>compassion</u> on them
- 1 Kings 11 Referred to God not dealing with Solomon when he went after other gods for David`s sake.
- 2 Kings 13:23 (AV) And the LORD was gracious unto them, and had <u>compassion</u> on them, and had respect unto them, because of His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast He them from His presence as yet.
- 2 Kings 13:23 (NKJV) But the LORD was gracious to them, had compassion on them, and regarded them, because of His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not yet destroy them or cast them from His presence.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of

yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast. Moses interceded often for the sins of the Israelites.

- 2 Chronicles 30:9 (AV) For if ye turn again unto the LORD, your brethren and your children shall find compassion before them that lead them captive, so that they shall come again into this land: for the LORD your God is gracious and merciful, and will not turn away *His* face from you, if ye return unto him.
- 2 Chronicles 30:9 (NKJV) For if you return to the LORD, your brethren and your children will be treated with compassion by those who lead them captive, so that they may come back to this land; for the LORD your God is gracious and merciful, and will not turn His face from you if you return to Him.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- 2 Chronicles 36:15 (AV) And the LORD God of their fathers sent to them by His messengers, rising up betimes, and sending; because <u>He had compassion on His people</u>, and on His dwelling place:
- 2 Chronicles 36:15 (NKJV) And the LORD God of their fathers sent *warnings* to them by His messengers, rising up early and sending *them*, because <u>He had compassion on His people</u> and on His dwelling place.
- Jeremiah 7:25 Since the day that your fathers came forth out of the land of Egypt unto this day I have even sent unto you all my servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending them:
- 2 Chronicles 36:17 (AV) Therefore He brought upon them the king of the Chaldees, who slew their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary, and had <u>no compassion</u> upon young man or maiden, old man, or him that stooped for age: He gave *them* all into his hand.
- 2 Chronicles 36:17 (NKJV) Therefore He brought against them the king of the Chaldeans, who killed their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary, and had <u>no compassion</u> on young man or virgin, on the aged or the weak; He gave *them* all into his hand.
- Psalms 78:38 (AV) But He, *being* <u>full of compassion</u>, forgave *their* iniquity, and destroyed *them* not: yea, many a time turned He His anger away, and did not stir up all His wrath.
- Matthew 9:36 (AV) But when He saw the multitudes, He was <u>moved with</u> <u>compassion on them</u>, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.
- Matthew 9:36 (NKJV) But when He saw the multitudes, He was <u>moved with</u> <u>compassion for them</u>, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.
- Matthew 14:14 (AV) And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and He healed their sick.
- Matthew 14:14 (NKJV) And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude;

- and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.
- Matthew 15:32 (AV) Then Jesus called His disciples *unto Him*, and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with Me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way.
- Matthew 15:32 (NKJV) Now Jesus called His disciples to *Himself* and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat. And I do not want to send them away hungry, lest they faint on the way.
- Mark 5:19 (AV) Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.
- Mark 5:19 (NKJV) However, Jesus did not permit him, but said to him, Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has <u>had compassion on you</u>.
- Luke 15:20 (AV) And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him.
- Luke 15:20 (NKJV) And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.
- Romans 9:15 (AV) For He saith to Moses, <u>I will have mercy on whom I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion</u>.
- Romans 9:15 (NKJV) For He says to Moses, I will have mercy on whomever I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whomever I will have compassion.
- Hebrews 5:2 (AV) Who can <u>have compassion</u> on the ignorant, and on them that are out of the way; for that he himself also is compassed with infirmity.
- Hebrews 5:2 (NKJV) He can <u>have compassion</u> on those who are ignorant and going astray, since he himself is also subject to weakness.
- James 5:11 (AV) Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the <u>Lord is very pitiful</u>, and of tender mercy.
- James 5:11 (NKJV) Indeed we count them blessed who endure. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end *intended by* the Lord that the <u>Lord is very compassionate and merciful</u>.
- 1 Peter 3:8 (AV) Finally, *be ye* all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, *be* pitiful, *be* courteous:
- 1 Peter 3:8 (NKJV) Finally, all *of you be* of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, *be* tenderhearted, *be* courteous;
- Jude 1:22 (AV) And of some have <u>compassion</u>, making a difference:

- Jude 1:22 (NKJV) And on some have compassion, making a distinction;
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the <u>spirit of meekness</u>; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Jonah Referred to Nineveh all repenting at the preaching of Jonah. More Service Notes:
- Psalms 78:38 (NKJV) But He, *being* full of compassion, forgave *their* iniquity, And did not destroy *them*. Yes, many a time He turned His anger away, And did not stir up all His wrath;
- Psalms 86:15 (AV) But Thou, O Lord, *art* a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth.

- Psalms 112:4 (AV) Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: *he is* gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.
- Psalms 112:4 (NKJV) Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness; *He is* gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.
- Psalms 135:14 (AV) For the LORD will judge his people, and he will repent himself concerning his servants.
- Psalms 135:14 (NKJV) For the LORD will judge His people, And He will have compassion on His servants.
- Psalms 145:8 (AV) The LORD *is* gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.
- Psalms 145:8 (NKJV) The LORD *is* gracious and full of compassion, Slow to anger and great in mercy.
- Isaiah 49:15 (AV) Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.
- Isaiah 49:15 (NKJV) Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you.
- Jeremiah 12:15 (AV) And it shall come to pass, after that I have plucked them out I will return, and have compassion on them, and will bring them again, every man to his heritage, and every man to his land.

- Jeremiah 12:15 (NKJV) Then it shall be, after I have plucked them out, that I will return and have compassion on them and bring them back, everyone to his heritage and everyone to his land.
- Lamentations 3:22 (AV) *It is of* the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.
- Lamentations 3:22 (NKJV) *Through* the LORD'S mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not.
- Lamentations 3:32 (AV) But though he cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of his mercies.
- Lamentations 3:32 (NKJV) Though He causes grief, Yet He will show compassion According to the multitude of His mercies.
- Lamentations 4:10 (AV) The hands of the pitiful women have sodden their own children: they were their meat in the destruction of the daughter of my people.
- Lamentations 4:10 (NKJV) The hands of the compassionate women Have cooked their own children; They became food for them In the destruction of the daughter of my people.
- Ezekiel 16:5 (AV) None eye pitied thee, to do any of these unto thee, to have compassion upon thee; but thou wast cast out in the open field, to the lothing of thy person, in the day that thou wast born.
- Ezekiel 16:5 (NKJV) No eye pitied you, to do any of these things for you, to have compassion on you; but you were thrown out into the open field, when you yourself were loathed on the day you were born.
- Micah 7:19 (AV) He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.
- Micah 7:19 (NKJV) He will again have compassion on us, And will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins Into the depths of the sea.
- Zechariah 7:9 (AV) Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and shew mercy and compassions every man to his brother:
- Zechariah 7:9 (NKJV) Thus says the LORD of hosts: Execute true justice, Show mercy and compassion Everyone to his brother.
- Matthew 18:27 (AV) Then the lord of that servant was moved with compassion, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt.
- Matthew 18:27 (NKJV) Then the master of that servant was moved with compassion, released him, and forgave him the debt.
- Matthew 18:33 (AV) Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?
- Matthew 18:33 (NKJV) Should you not also have had compassion on your fellow servant, just as I had pity on you?
- Matthew 20:34 (AV) So Jesus had compassion *on them*, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed him.

- Matthew 20:34 (NKJV) So Jesus had compassion and touched their eyes. And immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him.
- Mark 1:41 And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth *his* hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean.
- Mark 1:41 (NKJV) Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out *His* hand and touched him, and said to him, I am willing; be cleansed.
- Mark 6:34 (AV) And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.
- Mark 6:34 (NKJV) And Jesus, when He came out, saw a great multitude and was moved with compassion for them, because they were like sheep not having a shepherd. So He began to teach them many things.
- Mark 8:2 (AV) I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now been with me three days, and have nothing to eat:
- Mark 8:2 (NKJV) I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat.
- Mark 9:22 (AV) And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.
- Mark 9:22 (NKJV) And often he has thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us.
- Luke 7:13 (AV) And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not.
- Luke 7:13 (NKJV) When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, Do not weep.
- Luke 10:33 (AV) But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion *on him*,
- Luke 10:33 (NKJV) But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion.
- Hebrews 10:34 (AV) For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.
- Hebrews 10:34 (NKJV) for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven.
