- John 11:47,48 Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, What do we? for this Man doeth many miracles. 48 If we let Him thus alone, all men will believe on Him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation.
- Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

- Mark16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Mark 8:29,31-33 And He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? - John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Leviticus 26:1 Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

- Mark 7:10-13 For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death: 11 But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, It is Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; he shall be free. 12 And ye suffer him no more to do ought for his father or his mother; 13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Matthew 19:19 (NKJV) Honor your father and *your* mother, and, You shall love your neighbor as yourself.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
