- Matthew 19 Summarized of the rich young ruler.
- Matthew 19:21,22 Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow Me. 22 But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.
- Matthew 16:26 For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Mark 8:36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?
- Luke 9:25 For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away?
- John 3:18 He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- Matthew 19:23 (AV) Then said Jesus unto His disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- Matthew 19:23 (NKJV) Then Jesus said to His disciples, Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven.
- Daniel 4:30 (Nebuchadnezzar) The king spake, and said, Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for the house of the kingdom by the might of my power, and for the honour of my majesty?
- Matthew 19:24 (AV) And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle (gate), than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
- Matthew 19:24 (NKJV) again I say to you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle (gate) than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.
- Matthew 19:25 (AV) When His disciples heard *it*, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be saved?
- Matthew 19:25 (NKJV) When His disciples heard *it*, they were greatly astonished, saying, Who then can be saved?
- Matthew 19:26 (AV) But Jesus beheld *them*, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but <u>with God all things are possible</u>.
- Matthew 19:26 (NKJV) But Jesus looked at *them* and said to them, With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.
- Matthew 19:27 (AV) Then answered Peter and said unto Him, Behold, <u>we have</u> <u>forsaken all, and followed Thee</u>; what shall we have therefore?
- Matthew 19:27 (NKJV) Then Peter answered and said to Him, See, <u>we have</u> <u>left all and followed You</u>. Therefore what shall we have?

- Matthew 4:19,20,22 And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. 20 And they (Peter & Andrew) straightway left their nets, and followed him. 22 And they (James & John) immediately left the ship and their father, and followed him.
- Mark 2:14 And as he passed by, he saw Levi (Matthew) the son of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him, Follow me. And he arose and followed him.
- Acts 8:20,21 But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. 21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Matthew 19:28 (AV) And Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Matthew 19:28 (NKJV) So Jesus said to them, Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration, when the Son of Man sits on the throne of His glory, you who have followed Me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- John 14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.
- Matthew 19:29 (AV) And every one that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for My name's sake, shall receive an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life.
- Matthew 19:29 (NKJV) And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, <u>for My Name's sake</u>, <u>shall receive a hundredfold</u>, and inherit eternal life.
- Matthew 19:30But many *that are* first shall be last; & the last *shall be* first. Matthew 19:30 (NKJV) But many *who are* first will be last, and the last first. Matthew 23 Referred to the Lord exposing the religious hypocrite leaders. Matthew 25 Summarized of the Parable of the Talents.
- Luke 12 Summarized of the rich man building bigger barns to enjoy life. V20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?
- Luke 16:19-31 19,20 There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: 20 And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, Explained the custom of the infirm people begging.
- Job 2:7 So went Satan forth from the presence of the LORD, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown. 8 And he took him a

potsherd to scrape himself withal; and he sat down among the ashes.

- Luke 16:21-23 & desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came & licked his sores. 22 & it came to pass, that the beggar died, & was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, & was buried; 23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, & seeth Abraham afar off, & Lazarus in his bosom.
- Hebrews 9:27 it is appointed to men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Summarized many after death false doctrines purgatory, nirvana, valhala, reincarnation, false heavens, ultimate reconciliation, etc...
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- Luke 16:24,25 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. 25 But Abraham said, son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, & likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Revelation 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Luke 16:26 And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Luke 16:27-29 Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house: 28 For I have five brethren; that he may testify to them, lest they also come into this place of torment. 29 Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses & the prophets; let them hear them.
- In the Gospel of John, Jesus revealed Himself first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will

give you an heart of flesh.

- Luke 16:30,31 And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent. 31 And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- Strongs #86. hades; from <u>1</u> (as negative particle) and <u>1492</u>; properly, unseen, i.e. Hades or the place (state) of departed souls: grave, hell.
- 1 John 2:15,16 Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
- James 4:4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, (idolaters) know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.
- Isaiah 5:20 Woe unto them that call evil good, & good evil; that put darkness for light, & light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, & sweet for bitter!
- Genesis 6:5 (In the days of Noah) And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the <u>love of money is the root of all evil</u>: which while some <u>coveted after</u>, they have <u>erred from the faith</u>, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, It is finished: and He bowed His head, and gave up the ghost.
- 1 Peter 3:18-20 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: 19 By which also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison; 20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.
