## **The Spirit Of Madness - 1 Samuel 21**

- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Genesis 1:31 And God saw every thing that He had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.
- Matthew 8 Referred to the Gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus.
- Mark 5:15,17 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 17 And they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts.
- Mark 5:3,5 Who had his dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains: 5 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones.
- Mark 5:8 For he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Luke 8:35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the <u>devils were departed</u>, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and <u>in his right mind</u>: and they were afraid.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be <u>in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away;</u> behold, all things are become new.
- Daniel 4 Summarized of Nebuchadnezzar judged.
- Daniel 4:33 The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' feathers, and

his nails like birds' claws. 34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured Him that liveth for ever, Whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and His kingdom is from generation to generation:

- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- 1 Samuel 21:10-15 V10 And David arose, and fled that day for fear of Saul, and went to Achish the king of Gath.
- 1 Samuel 19:9,10 And the evil spirit from the LORD was upon Saul, as he sat in his house with his javelin in his hand: and David played with his hand. 10 And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night.
- 1 Samuel 21:11-13 And the servants of Achish said unto him, *Is* not this David the king of the land? did they not sing one to another of him in dances, saying, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands? 12 And David laid up these words in his heart, and was sore afraid of Achish the king of Gath. 13 And he changed his behaviour before them, and feigned himself mad in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard.

David pretended to have temporary insanity.

- 1 Samuel 21:14,15 Then said Achish unto his servants, Lo, ye see the man is mad: wherefore *then* have ye brought him to me? 15 Have I need of mad men, that ye have brought this *fellow* to play the mad man in my presence? shall this *fellow* come into my house?
- Easton's Revised Bible Dictionary Madness This word is used in its proper sense in Deut 28:34; John 10:20; 1Cor 14:23 It also denotes a reckless state of mind arising from various causes, as over-study Ecc 1:17, 2:12 blind rage Luke 6:11 or a depraved temper Ecc 7:25, 9:3; 2Pet 2:16 David feigned madness 1Sam 21:13 at Gath because he was sore afraid of Achish.
- Proverbs 26:18,19 As a mad *man* who casteth firebrands, arrows, and death, 19 So *is* the man *that* deceiveth his neighbour, and saith, Am not I in sport?
- 1 Corinthians 14:33 For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.
- Deuteronomy 28 Referred to the blessings & curses proclaimed from the 2 mounts.
- Deuteronomy 28:28 The LORD shall smite thee with <u>madness</u>, and blindness, and astonishment of heart:
- Deuteronomy 28:34 So that thou shalt be mad for the sight of thine eyes

- which thou shalt see.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:3 For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God's punishment to a rebellious Israel.
- 1 Samuel 21:13-15 And he changed his behaviour before them, and feigned himself <u>mad</u> in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard. 14 Then said Achish unto his servants, Lo, ye see the man is <u>mad</u>: wherefore *then* have ye brought him to me? 15 Have I need of <u>mad</u> men, that ye have brought this *fellow* to play the <u>mad</u> man in my presence? shall this *fellow* come into my house?
- 2 Kings 9:11 Then Jehu came forth to the servants of his lord: and *one* said unto him, *Is* all well? wherefore came this <u>mad</u> *fellow* to thee? And he said unto them, Ye know the man, and his communication.
- Psalms 102:8 Mine enemies reproach me all the day; *and* they that are <u>mad</u> against me are sworn against me.
- Proverbs 26:18 As a <u>mad</u> man who casteth firebrands, arrows, and death, Ecclesiastes 1:17 And I gave my heart to know wisdom, and to know <u>madness</u> and folly: I perceived that this also is vexation of spirit.
- 1 Kings 3 Summarized of the 2 women & babies.
- 1 Kings 3:25,26 And the king said, Divide the living child in two, and give half to the one, and half to the other. 26 Then spake the woman whose the living child was unto the king, for her bowels yearned upon her son, and she said, O my lord, give her the living child, and in no wise slay it. But the other said, Let it be neither mine nor thine, but divide it.
- 2 Timothy 3:3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,
- Ecclesiastes 2:2 I said of <u>laughter</u>, *It is* mad: and of mirth, What doeth it?
- Ecclesiastes 2:12 And I turned myself to behold wisdom, and <u>madness</u>, <u>and</u> <u>folly</u>: for what *can* the man *do* that cometh after the king? *even* that which hath been already done.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Ecclesiastes 7:7 Surely <u>oppression maketh a wise man mad</u>; and a gift destroyeth the heart.
- Ecclesiastes 7:25 I applied mine heart to know, and to search, and to seek out wisdom, and the reason *of things*, and to know the <u>wickedness of folly</u>, even of foolishness *and* madness:
- Ecclesiastes 9:3 This *is* an evil among all *things* that are done under the sun, that *there is* one event unto all: yea, also the <u>heart of the sons of men is</u> <u>full of evil, and madness *is* in their heart while they live, and after that *they go* to the dead.</u>

- Genesis 4:8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.
- Ecclesiastes 10:13 The beginning of the words of his mouth *is* <u>foolishness</u>: and the end of his talk *is* mischievous madness.
- Isaiah 44:25 (the Lord) That frustrateth the tokens of the liars, and <u>maketh</u> <u>diviners mad</u>; that turneth wise *men* backward, and maketh their knowledge foolish;
- Jeremiah 25:16 And they shall drink, and be moved, and be <u>mad</u>, because of the sword that I will send among them.
- Jeremiah 11:14 Therefore pray not thou for this people, neither lift up a cry or prayer for them: for I will not hear them in the time that they cry unto Me for their trouble.
- Jeremiah 29:26 The LORD hath made thee priest in the stead of Jehoiada the priest, that ye should be officers in the house of the LORD, for every <u>man</u> <u>that is mad, and maketh himself a prophet</u>, that thou shouldest put him in prison, and in the stocks.
- 2 Samuel 16 Summarized of Shimei cursing David.
- 2 Samuel 16:12 It may be that the LORD will look on mine affliction, and that the LORD will requite me good for his cursing this day.
- Psalms 39:7 And now, Lord, what wait I for? my hope is in thee.
- Jeremiah 50:38 A drought *is* upon her waters; and they shall be dried up: for it *is* the land of graven images, and they are <u>mad upon *their* idols</u>.
- Jeremiah 51:7 Babylon *hath been* a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.
- Daniel 5 Summarized of Belshazzar.
- Hosea 9:7 The days of visitation are come, the days of recompence are come; Israel shall know *it*: the prophet *is* a fool, the spiritual man *is* mad, for the multitude of thine iniquity, and the great hatred.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets (of Baal). And He said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- Zechariah 12:4 In that day, saith the LORD, I will smite every horse with astonishment, and his rider with <u>madness</u>: and I will open mine eyes upon the house of Judah, and will smite every horse of the people with blindness.
- Deuteronomy 28:28 The LORD shall smite thee with <u>madness</u>, and blindness, and astonishment of heart:
- Luke 6:11 And they were filled with <u>madness</u>; and communed one with another what they might do to Jesus.

- John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.
- Exodus 8:32 And Pharaoh hardened his heart at this time also, neither would he let the people go.
- Acts 7:54,56-59 When they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth. 56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God. 57 Then they cried out with a loud voice, and stopped their ears, and ran upon him with one accord, 58 And cast him out of the city, and stoned him: and the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul. 59 And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.
- John 10:20 And many of them said, <u>He hath a devil, and is mad;</u> why hear ye Him?
- Acts 12:15 And they said unto her, Thou art <u>mad</u>. But she constantly affirmed that it was even so. Then said they, It is his angel. (Peter)
- Acts 26:11 And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and compelled *them* to blaspheme; and being <u>exceedingly mad against them</u>, I (Saul)persecuted *them* even unto strange cities.
- Acts 9 Referred to Jesus appearing to Saul on the road to Damascus.
- Acts 26:24,25 And as he thus spake for himself, Festus said with a loud voice, Paul, thou art beside thyself; much learning doth make thee mad. 25 But he said, I am not mad, most noble Festus; but speak forth the words of truth and soberness.
- 1 Corinthians 14:23,24 If therefore the whole church be come together into one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in *those that are* unlearned, or unbelievers, will they not say that ye are <u>mad?</u> 24 But if all prophesy, and there come in one that believeth not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he is judged of all:
- 1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
- 2 Peter 2:16 But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the <u>madness</u> of the prophet.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
