The Rough Road To Maturity - Matthew 20B

- Matthew 19:23 Then said Jesus unto His disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Matthew 20:17-19 And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them, 18 Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn Him to death, 19 And shall deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify Him: and the third day He shall rise again.
- Matthew 20:17 And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them,
- Mark 9:29 And He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Luke 6:12 And it came to pass in those days, that He went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.
- Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.
- Matthew 20:18 Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn Him to death,
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this Man.
- John 11:50 (Caiaphas) Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.
- Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated Me without a cause.

- Mark 14:56 For many bare false witness against him, but their witness agreed not together.
- Mark 14:61,62 But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed? 62 And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- Matthew 28:11 Now when they (women) were going, behold, some of the watch (soldiers) came into the city, and shewed unto the chief priests all the things that were done. (Witnesses that Jesus was Risen)
- Matthew 20:19 And shall deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify Him: and the third day He shall rise again.
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Deuteronomy 31 Summarized of Moses relaying that the Israelites will turn away from God.
- Matthew 16:21 From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto His disciples, how that He must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.
- Matthew 17:22,23 And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, The Son of Man shall be betrayed into the hands of men: 23 And they shall kill Him, and the third day He shall be raised again. And they were exceeding sorry.
- Psalms 22:1-21 V1-8 My God, my God, why hast Thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring? 2 O my God, I cry in the daytime, but Thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent. 3 But Thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel. 4 Our fathers trusted in Thee: they trusted, and Thou didst deliver them. 5 They cried unto Thee, and were delivered: they trusted in Thee, and were not confounded. 6 But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. 7 All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, 8 He trusted on the LORD that He would deliver him: let Him deliver him, seeing He delighted in him.
- Matthew 27:41-43 Likewise also the chief priests mocking Him, with the scribes and elders, said, 42 He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He be the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him. 43 He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now, if He will have Him: for He said, I am the Son of God. (Mocking Jesus)
- Psalms 22:9-21 But Thou art he that took me out of the womb: Thou didst

make me hope when I was upon my mother's breasts. 10 I was cast upon Thee from the womb: Thou art my God from my mother's belly. 11 Be not far from me; for trouble is near; for there is none to help. 12 Many bulls have compassed me: strong bulls of Bashan have beset me round. 13 They gaped upon me with their mouths, as a ravening and a roaring lion. 14 I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels. 15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death. 16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet. 17 I may tell all my bones: they look and stare upon me. 18 They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture. 19 But be not Thou far from me, O LORD: O my strength, haste Thee to help me. 20 Deliver my soul from the sword; my darling from the power of the dog. 21 Save me from the lion's mouth: for Thou hast heard me from the horns of the unicorns.

Psalms 22 & Isaiah 53 Were prophesies of Jesus' crucifiction.

Isaiah 53:1-12 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? 2 For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. 3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. 4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. 5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. 7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. 9 And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. 10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; He hath put him to grief: when Thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, He shall see his seed, He shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. 11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, and

shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. 12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

- Matthew 4 & Luke 4 Referred to Jesus' testings at the beginning of His ministry.
- Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- Summarized of God preparing Moses.
- Romans 5:3,4 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; 4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope:
- Matthew 12:39-41 But He answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet <u>Jonas</u>: 40 For as <u>Jonas</u> was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. 41 The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of <u>Jonas</u>; and, behold, a Greater than <u>Jonas</u> is here.
- Matthew 16:4 A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given unto it, but the sign of the prophet <u>Jonas</u>. And He left them, and departed.
- Luke 11:29,30,32 And when the people were gathered thick together, He began to say, This is an evil generation: they seek a sign; and there shall no sign be given it, but the sign of <u>Jonas</u> the prophet. 30 For as <u>Jonas</u> was a sign unto the Ninevites, so shall also the Son of Man be to this

generation. 32 The men of Nineve shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for they repented at the preaching of <u>Jonas</u>; and, behold, a Greater than <u>Jonas</u> *is* here.

- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- John 14:1-3 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Summarized of Biblical glories when in Heaven.

Revelation 19:11-21 - 11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war. 12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns; and He had a name written, that no man knew, but He Himself. 13 And He was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies which were in heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. 15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it He should smite the nations; and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He hath on His vesture and on His thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. 17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the Great God; 18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great. 19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him that sat on the horse, and against His army. 20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. 21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of Him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of His mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Luke 4:4 And Jesus answered him, saying, <u>It is written</u>, That man shall not

- live by bread alone, but by every Word of God.
- Luke 4:9-12 And he brought Him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto Him, If Thou be the Son of God, cast Thyself down from hence: 10 For it is written, He shall give His angels charge over Thee, to keep Thee: 11 And in their hands they shall bear Thee up, lest at any time Thou dash Thy foot against a stone. 12 And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.
- 1 Corinthians 14:32 And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.
- Luke 4:5-7 And the devil, taking Him up into an high mountain, shewed unto Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. 6 And the devil said unto Him, All this power will I give Thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. 7 If Thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be Thine.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: & nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 4:8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for <u>it is written</u>, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Ephesians 4:15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into Him in all things, which is the Head, even Christ:
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- Luke 10:27 And He answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.
- Mark 2:27 And He said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:
- John 21:14 This is now the third time that Jesus shewed Himself to His disciples, after that He was risen from the dead.
