## Parable Of The Kinsman Redeemer 1 - Ruth 1A

- Matthew 13:34 All these things spake Jesus unto the multitude in parables; and without a parable spake He not unto them:
- Ruth 1:1-5 Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons. 2 And the name of the man was Elimelech, and the name of his wife Naomi, and the name of his two sons Mahlon and Chilion, Ephrathites of Bethlehemjudah. And they came into the country of Moab, and continued there. 3 And Elimelech Naomi's husband died; and she was left, and her two sons. 4 And they took them wives of the women of Moab; the name of the one was Orpah, and the name of the other Ruth: and they dwelled there about ten years. 5 And Mahlon and Chilion died also both of them; and the woman was left of her two sons and her husband.
- Matthew 1:5,6 Salmon begot Boaz by Rahab, Boaz begot Obed by Ruth, Obed begot Jesse, 6 and Jesse begot David the king. David the king begot Solomon by her who had been the wife of Uriah.
- Psalms 23:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- Ruth 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons.

Summarized of Joshua through the judges.

- **Deuteronomy 31 & 32 Summarized God's song given by Moses.**
- Judges 2:3 Wherefore I also said, I will not drive them out from before you; but they shall be as thorns in your sides, and their gods shall be a snare unto you.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Judges 3:1-7 Now these are the nations which the LORD left, to prove Israel by them, even as many of Israel as had not known all the wars of Canaan; 2 Only that the generations of the children of Israel might know, to teach them war, at the least such as before knew nothing thereof; 3 Namely, five lords of the Philistines, and all the Canaanites, and the Sidonians, and the Hivites that dwelt in mount Lebanon, from mount Baalhermon unto the entering in of Hamath. 4 And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they would hearken unto the commandments of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses. 5 And the children of Israel dwelt among the Canaanites, Hittites, and Amorites, and Perizzites,

and Hivites, and Jebusites: 6 And they took their daughters to be their wives, and gave their daughters to their sons, and served their gods. 7 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and forgat the LORD their God, and served Baalim (false lord) and the groves.

Matthew 4 & Luke 4 Referred to Jesus being tested in the wilderness.

Job 1&2 Referred to God limiting satan in the testings of Job.

- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;
- Summarized of the Judges. When Israel was obedient, God blessed them. When they went after other gods, God punished them into slavery. When they turned back to God, God sent a judge to free them.
- 1 Samuel 1&2 Summarized of Samuel, Eli & his sons.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Ruth 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons.

Revelation 19 referred to Jesus' return & rule.

- Easton's RBD Famine The first mentioned in Scripture was so grievous as to compel Abraham to go down to the land of Egypt Genesis 26:1 Another is mentioned as having occurred in the days of Isaac, causing him to go to Gerar Genesis 26:1,17 But the most remarkable of all was that which arose in Egypt in the days of Joseph, which lasted for seven years Genesis 41:1-45:28 Famines were sent as an effect of God's anger against a guilty people 2Kings 8:1,2; Amos 8:11; Deut 28:22-42; 2Sam 21:1; 2Kings 6:25-28, 25:3; Jer 14:15, 19:9, 42:17; etc. A famine was predicted by Agabus Acts 11:28 Josephus makes mention of the famine which occurred A.D. 45. Helena, queen of Adiabene, being at Jerusalem at that time, procured corn from Alexandria and figs from Cyprus for its poor inhabitants.
- Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.
- 1 Chronicles 21 Summarized of David numbering Israel & God's judgement.
- 1 Chronicles 21:1 And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and

- for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Numbers 22-24 Summarized of Baalam & Balak.
- Genesis 19:36,37 Thus were both the daughters of Lot with child by their father. 37 And the firstborn bare a son, and called his name Moab: the same is the father of the Moabites unto this day.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- Luke 15 Summarized of the prodical son V17 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation:

- 1 Kings 21 Summarized of Naboth, Abigail & David.
- Ruth 1:2 And the name of the man was Elimelech (God is my King), and the name of his wife Naomi (Pleasant One), and the name of his two sons Mahlon and Chilion (Sickly), Ephrathites of Bethlehemjudah. And they came into the country of Moab, and continued there.
- Matthew 11:28,29 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- Matthew 2:13 And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child

and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

Summarized of Joseph sent into Egypt to protect Israel's family.

Genesis 13 Summarized of Abraham & Lot separating.

Genesis 19 Summarized of Abraham bargaining with Jesus for the righteous.

1 Samuel 16,17 Summarized of David tending the sheep.

Jonah Summarized of Jonah sleeping in the ship running from God.

- 1 Kings 17 Summarized of the widow of Zarephath helping Elijah.
- Ruth 1:3 And Elimelech Naomi's husband died; and she was left, and her two sons.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

- Summarized of the laws on buying back the family's inheritance.
- Ruth 1:5 And Mahlon and Chilion died also both of them; and the woman was left of her two sons and her husband.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of Adam & Eve & the fall of mankind. V3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.
- 1 Timothy 2:14 And Adam was not deceived (he disobeyed), but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
