## Parable Of The Kinsman Redeemer 3 - Ruth 1C

- John 10:10 The thief comes not, but for to steal, & to kill, & to destroy: I am come that they might have life, & that they might have it more abundantly. Ruth 1 Summarized of Naomi's family situation.
- 2 Peter 2:7 And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked:
- Ruth 1:16,17 And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God: 17 Where thou diest, will I die, and there will I be buried: the LORD do so to me, and more also, if ought but death part thee and me.
- Matthew 1:5 And Salmon begat Booz of Rachab; and Booz begat Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse;
- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- Ruth 1:19 So they two went until they came to Bethlehem. And it came to pass, when they were come to Bethlehem, that all the city was moved about them, and they said, *Is* this Naomi?
- Beth-lehem= "house of bread" Jesus born in Bethlehem, the house of bread. John 6:48 I am that bread of life.
- Ruth 1:20 And she said unto them, Call me not Naomi, call me Mara: for the Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me.
- Proverbs 22:1 A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.
- Genesis 45:7 And God sent me (Joseph) before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance.
- Summarized of Moses prepared by God for a mighty work.
- Ruth 1:21 I went out full, and the LORD hath brought me home again empty: why *then* call ye me Naomi, seeing the LORD hath testified against me, and the Almighty hath afflicted me?
- Luke 15:17 And when he (prodigal son) came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- Daniel 4:34 at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, & mine understanding returned unto me, & I blessed the most High, & I praised & honoured Him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, & his kingdom is from generation to generation:
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.

- 1 Corinthians 11:30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.
- John 15:2 Every branch in Me that beareth not fruit He taketh away: & every branch that beareth fruit, He purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.
- Ruth 1:22 So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess, her daughter in law, with her, which returned out of the country of Moab: and they came to Bethlehem in the beginning of barley harvest.
- Genesis 12 Referred to God calling Abram.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Joshua Referred to the Israelites crossing Jordan at harvest time.
- Strongs #04755. Mara' *maw-raw'*; for <u>04751</u> feminine; bitter; Mara, a symbolic name of Naomi: Mara.
- Luke 15:1-10 V1,2 Then drew near unto Him all the publicans and sinners for to hear Him. 2 And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This Man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.
- Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- John 12:6 This he (Judas Iscaeiot) said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.
- Luke 10 Referred to the Parable of the Good Samaratan.
- Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
- Luke 15:3 And He spake this parable unto them, saying, 4 What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it? 5 And when he hath found it, he layeth it on his shoulders, rejoicing.
- John 10:11 I am the Good Shepherd: the Good Shepherd giveth His life for the sheep.
- Matthew 11:28,29 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
- Luke 15:6-8 And when he cometh home, he calleth together his friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost. 7 I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance. 8 Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house,

- and seek diligently till she find it?
- Deuteronomy 24:1 When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house.
- Luke 15:9 And when she hath found it, she calleth her friends and her neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.
- Luke 18:1,7 And He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; 7 And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?
- Exodus 32 Moses interceded in prayer for 40 days & nights to God for Israel.
- Luke 15:10 Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth.
- Luke 10:2 Therefore said He unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He would send forth labourers into His harvest.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Acts 5 Summarized of God judging Ananias & Sapphira lying to Holy Spirit.
- Exodus 19:10,11 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, 11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.
- Matthew 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.
- Hebrews 12:4 Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin.
- Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,
- Hebrews 12:5,6 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of Him: 6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Hebrews 12:7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? 8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards (illegitimate), and not sons.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into

the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven.

- Romans 10;9,10,13 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Numbers 32:12 Save Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite, and Joshua the son of Nun: for they have wholly followed the LORD.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

## **More Service Notes:**

Hebrews 12:9-17 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? 10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but He for our profit, that we might be partakers of His Holiness. 11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby. 12 Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; 13 And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed. 14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: 15 Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled; 16 Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright. 17 For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.
