Sadducees And Modern Theology - Matthew 22C

- Mark 16:15 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Summarized of Jesus exposing religious leaders' error earlier in the chapter.
- Matthew 22:23-33 V23 The same day came to Him the Sadducees, which say that there is no resurrection, and asked Him,
- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from Him for a season.
- 1 Kings 18 Summarized of Elijah against the false prophets of Baal.
- 1 Kings 19 Summarized of Elijah running from Jezebel's curse of death.
- Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.
- Strongs #4523 Saddoukaios *sad-doo-kah'-yos* AV-Sadducees 14; Sadducees =" the righteous"
- 1) a religious party at the time of Christ among the Jews, who denied that the oral law was a revelation of God to the Israelites, and who deemed the written law alone to be obligatory on the nation, as the divine authority. They denied the following doctrines:
- 1a) resurrection of the body 1b) immortality of the soul 1c) existence of spirits and angels 1d) divine predestination, affirmed free will Summarized of the extra-Biblical doctrines of the Sadducees.
- Acts 23:6 But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men and brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.
- John 11:48 If we let Him thus alone, all men will believe on Him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation.
- Matthew 22:24 Saying, Master, Moses said, If a man die, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.
- John 8 Referred to the account of the woman taken in adultery. Summarized of God's law on this topic.
- Matthew 22:25-28 Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first,

when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue (no children), left his wife unto his brother: 26 Likewise the second also, and the third, unto the seventh. 27 And last of all the woman died also. 28 Therefore in the resurrection whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her.

Summarized of Modern Theology explaining away Jesus' miracles similarly. Summarized of examples of Christians casting out demons after Jesus' resurection. Acts 8, 16, & 19 are some biblical examples.

John 14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. Both are the same word Strongs # 166 Luke 4 Jesus rebuked the devil with "It is written ..."

Matthew 22:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.

- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:

Summarized of Modern Theology denying the scriptures.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Matthew 22:30 For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven.

- Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- Matthew 22:31 But as touching the resurrection of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying,
- Jesus re-quotes to this generation what He said in the Old Testament.
- Matthew 22:32 I AM (that I AM) the God of Abraham, and (I AM) the God of Isaac, and (I AM) the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.
- Luke 20:18 Whosoever shall fall upon that Stone shall be broken; but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.
- Matthew 22:33 And when the multitude heard this, they were astonished at His doctrine.
- Deuteronomy 25:5-10 V5,6 If brethren dwell together, and one of them die, and have no child, the wife of the dead shall not marry without unto a stranger: her husband's brother shall go in unto her, and take her to him to wife, and perform the duty of an husband's brother unto her. 6 And it shall be, that the firstborn which she beareth shall succeed in the name of his brother which is dead, that his name be not put out of Israel.
- Ruth 4:6,8 And the kinsman said, I cannot redeem it for myself, lest I mar mine own inheritance: redeem thou my right to thyself; for I cannot redeem it. 8 Therefore the kinsman said unto Boaz, Buy it for thee. So he drew off his shoe.
- Deuteronomy 25:7-10 And if the man like not to take his brother's wife, then let his brother's wife go up to the gate unto the elders, and say, My husband's brother refuseth to raise up unto his brother a name in Israel, he will not perform the duty of my husband's brother. 8 Then the elders of his city shall call him, and speak unto him: and if he stand to it, and say, I like not to take her; 9 Then shall his brother's wife come unto him in the presence of the elders, and loose his shoe from off his foot, and spit in his face, and shall answer and say, So shall it be done unto that man that will not build up his brother's house. 10 And his name shall be called in Israel, The house of him that hath his shoe loosed.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- Exodus 3:1-6 V1 Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb.

- Summarized of Moses' life then since leaving Egypt.
- Exodus 3:2 And the angel of the LORD (the Lord Jesus) appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.
- Genesis 19 Referred to the Lord Jesus & 2 angels visiting Abraham.
- Summarized of Modern Theology that denies the power of God.
- Exodus 3:3 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt.
- 1 Samuel 4:4 So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth between the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were there with the ark of the covenant of God.
- Acts 8:20,21 But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. 21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Exodus 3:4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I.
- 1 Samuel 3:4 That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Isaiah 6:8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.
- Exodus 3:5 And He said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is Holy ground.
- Numbers 3:4 And Nadab and Abihu died before the LORD, when they offered strange fire before the LORD, in the wilderness of Sinai, and they had no children: and Eleazar and Ithamar ministered in the priest's office in the sight of Aaron their father.
- Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Revelation 4:8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring

them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

- Exodus 3:6 Moreover He said, I AM (that I AM) the God of thy father, (I AM) the God of Abraham, (I AM) the God of Isaac, and (I AM) the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Luke 16:19-31 V19-23 There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: 20 And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, 21 And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. 22 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; 23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Mark 5:16,17 And they that saw it told them how it befell to him that was possessed with the devil, and also concerning the swine. 17 And they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts.
- A Tale of 2 cities Gaderrah told Jesus to leave versus Sychar when all came to Jesus.
- John 4:29,30 Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ? 30 Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.
- Exodus 28:3 And thou shalt speak unto all *that are* wise hearted, whom I have filled with the <u>spirit of</u> wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto Me in the priest's office.
- 1 Corinthians 12 Referred to the spirits of God.
- Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Numbers 5:14 And the <u>spirit</u> <u>of</u> jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be defiled: or if the <u>spirit</u> <u>of</u> jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be not defiled:
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any

- means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- 2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.
- Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

More Service Notes:

- Numbers 5:30 Or when the <u>spirit</u> <u>of</u> jealousy cometh upon him, and he be jealous over his wife, and shall set the woman before the LORD, and the priest shall execute upon her all this law.
- Deuteronomy 34:9 And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the <u>spirit of</u> wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses.
- Luke 16:24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. 25 But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented. 26 And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence. 27 Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house: 28 For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. 29 Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. 30 And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent. 31 And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.
