- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power (authority) to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Summarized of the Religious Leaders coming against Jesus previously.
- Summarized of many coming to Jesus for miraculous help.
- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the temple twice.
- Matthew 23:13 13 AV But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.
- Matthew 23:2 Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat: 3 All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not.
- John 9:4 I must work the works of Him that sent Me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father Which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not with Me scattereth.
- Matthew 23:13 NKJV But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in.
- Leviticus Summarized the Pharosees' mis-interpretations of the God's Word.
- Mark 12:28,34 And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, Which is the first commandment of all? 34 And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, He said unto him, Thou art not far from the kingdom of God. And no man after that durst ask Him any question.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Luke 6:28 Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.
- Romans 12:14 Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.
- John 12:42 Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue:
- Luke 9:26 For whosoever shall be ashamed of Me and of My Words, of him shall the Son of Man be ashamed, when He shall come in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the Holy angels.
- Luke 19:46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.

- 2 Corinthians 11:14,15 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Exodus 20:5,6 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; 6 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- Matthew 5:3 <u>Blessed</u> are the <u>poor in spirit</u>: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 4 <u>Blessed</u> are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted. 5 <u>Blessed</u> are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. 6 <u>Blessed</u> are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. 7 <u>Blessed</u> are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. 8 <u>Blessed</u> are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. 9 <u>Blessed</u> are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. 10 <u>Blessed</u> are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 <u>Blessed</u> are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for My sake.
- Matthew5:3Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Strongs #3759 ouai *oo-ah'-ee* AV-woe 41, alas 6; 47 1) alas, woe
- 1 Samuel 2 Summarized of Eli & Sons' sins. 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at my sacrifice and at mine offering, which I have commanded in my habitation; and honourest thy sons above me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel my people?
- 1 Samuel 2:22 Now Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the

- tabernacle of the congregation.
- Strongs #5273 hupokrites *hoop-ok-ree-tace'* AV-hypocrite 20; 1) one who answers, an interpreter 2) an actor, stage player 3) a dissembler, pretender, hypocrite
- Isaiah 5:20 Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!
- Easton's Hypocrite One who puts on a mask and feigns himself to be what he is not; a dissembler in religion. Our Lord severely rebuked the scribes and Pharisees for their hypocrisy Mat 6:2,5,16 The hypocrite's hope shall perish Job 8:13 The Hebrew word here rendered hypocrite rather means the godless or profane, as it is rendered in Jer 23:11, polluted with crimes.
- Summarized modern false doctrines that keep people seeking God from God. Summarized of the attacks against Ezra & Nehemiah.
- Nehemiah 4:17 They which builded on the wall, and they that bare burdens, with those that laded, every one with one of his hands wrought in the work, and with the other hand held a weapon.
- Jeremiah 23:1-8 V1-5 Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of My pasture! saith the LORD. 2 Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel against the pastors that feed my people; Ye have scattered My flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them: behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, saith the LORD. 3 And I will gather the remnant of My flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase. 4 And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD. 5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Jeremiah 23:6 In His days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is His Name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS. 7 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that they shall no more say, The LORD liveth, which brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt; 8 But, The LORD liveth, which brought up and which led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country, and from all countries whither I had driven them; and they shall dwell in their own land.
- Jeremiah 7:16, 11:14, & 14:11 Then said the LORD unto me, Pray not for this people for their good.

- Jeremiah 20:6 And thou, Pashur, & all that dwell in thine house shall go into captivity: & thou shalt come to Babylon, and there thou shalt die, & shalt be buried there, thou, & all thy friends, to whom thou hast prophesied lies.
- Jeremiah 28:15-17 Then said the prophet Jeremiah unto Hananiah the prophet, Hear now, Hananiah; The LORD hath not sent thee; but thou makest this people to trust in a lie. 16 Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will cast thee from off the face of the earth: this year thou shalt die, because thou hast taught rebellion against the LORD. 17 So Hananiah the prophet died the same year in the seventh month.
- Matthew 3:7 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
- Ezekiel 8 Summarized of Ezekiel seeing the evil done in the temple through God's knothole.
- Matthew 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.
- John 3:7,10 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. 10 Jesus answered and said unto him, Art thou a master of Israel, and knowest not these things?
- Matthew 15:19 For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies:
- Matthew 23:33 *Ye* serpents, *ye* generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?
- Summarized of many false teachings of false heavens.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Summarized of the new Buzz-Word of "Shared Values" for the One World Religion.
- Luke 3:7 Then said he to the multitude that came forth to be baptized of him, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
- Luke 7:28 For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.
- Matthew 7:21-29 V21,22 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy Name? and in Thy Name have cast out devils? and in Thy Name done many wonderful works?
- 1 Corinthians 13:2,3 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand

all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. 3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.

- Matthew 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity. 24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of Mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock. 26 And every one that heareth these sayings of Mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it. 28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at His doctrine: 29 For He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.
- 1 Timothy 3:1 This *is* a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop (pastor), he desireth a good work.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few *stripes*. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Luke 12:47 And that servant, which knew his lord's will, & prepared not himself, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.
- Matthew 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.
- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
