When Jesus Christ Removes His Presence - Matthew 23J

- Ephesians 1:14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of His glory.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Summarized of the Judges. When Israel was obedient, God blessed them. When they went after other gods, God punished them into slavery. When they turned back to God, God sent a judge to free them.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- Ezekiel 8&9 Summarized of the ungodliness in the temple.
- 1 Samuel 4 Referred to the ark taken when Israel was judged.
- Exodus 34:7 Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.
- Matthew 23:34-39 V34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city:
- Acts 21:10 And as we tarried there many days, there came down from Judaea a certain prophet, named Agabus.
- Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:
- Revelation 17:13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.
- Revelation 16:14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.
- Matthew 23:35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.

- Psalms 106:38 And shed innocent blood, even the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood.
- Summarized of King Jaosh going bad & killed Zachariah.
- 2 Chronicles 22 Referred to God judging Sodom & Abraham bargaining with God.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Matthew 23:36 Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation.
- Jonah Summarized of Nineveh repenting & God sparing them.
- Matthew 23:37,38 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not! 38 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.
- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Matthew 23:39 For I say unto you, Ye shall not see Me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- Luke 8:37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again.
- Matthew 28:11 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Luke 15 Referred to the prodigal son who returned to his senses.
- Revelation 7 Referred to 12000 per tribe of Israel saved.
- Luke 19:38-40 Saying, Blessed be the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest. 39 And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples. 40 And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Jeremiah 12:1-13 V1-8 Righteous art Thou, O LORD, when I plead with Thee:

yet let me talk with Thee of Thy judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? wherefore are all they happy that deal very treacherously? 2 Thou hast planted them, yea, they have taken root: they grow, yea, they bring forth fruit: Thou art near in their mouth, and far from their reins. 3 But Thou, O LORD, knowest me: Thou hast seen me, and tried mine heart toward Thee: pull them out like sheep for the slaughter, and prepare them for the day of slaughter. 4 How long shall the land mourn, and the herbs of every field wither, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein? the beasts are consumed, and the birds; because they said, He shall not see our last end. 5 If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee, then how canst thou contend with horses? and if in the land of peace, wherein thou trustedst, they wearied thee, then how wilt thou do in the swelling of Jordan? 6 For even thy brethren, and the house of thy father, even they have dealt treacherously with thee; yea, they have called a multitude after thee: believe them not, though they speak fair words unto thee. 7 I have forsaken Mine house, I have left Mine heritage; I have given the dearly beloved of My soul into the hand of her enemies. 8 Mine heritage is unto Me as a lion in the forest; it crieth out against Me: therefore have I hated it.

- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Jeremiah 12:9,10 Mine heritage is unto Me as a speckled bird, the birds round about are against her; come ye, assemble all the beasts of the field, come to devour. 10 Many pastors have destroyed My vineyard, they have trodden My portion under foot, they have made My pleasant portion a desolate wilderness.
- Referred to God judging false pastors in Jeremiah 23 & Ezekiel 34.
- Jeremiah 12:11,12 They have made it desolate, and being desolate it mourneth unto Me; the whole land is made desolate, because no man layeth it to heart. 12 The spoilers are come upon all high places through the wilderness: for the sword of the LORD shall devour from the one end of the land even to the other end of the land: no flesh shall have peace.
- 1 Chronicles 21 Referred to the Angel of the Lord killing after David numbered Israel.
- Jeremiah 12:13 They have sown wheat, but shall reap thorns: they have put themselves to pain, but shall not profit: and they shall be ashamed of your revenues because of the fierce anger of the LORD.
- Jeremiah 22:1-9 V1-3 Thus saith the LORD; Go down to the house of the king of Judah, and speak there this Word, 2 And say, Hear the Word of the LORD, O king of Judah, that sittest upon the throne of David, thou, and thy

servants, and thy people that enter in by these gates: 3 Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.

Nehemiah 5 Summarized of the people oppressed by the leaders.

- Jeremiah 22:4 For if ye do this thing indeed, then shall there enter in by the gates of this house kings sitting upon the throne of David, riding in chariots and on horses, he, and his servants, and his people.
- 1 Kings 12 Jeroboam given same deal from God but he turned to idols.
- Jeremiah 22:5-9 But if ye will not hear these Words, I swear by Myself, saith the LORD, that this house shall become a desolation. 6 For thus saith the LORD unto the king's house of Judah; Thou art Gilead unto Me, and the head of Lebanon: yet surely I will make thee a wilderness, and cities which are not inhabited. 7 And I will prepare destroyers against thee, every one with his weapons: and they shall cut down thy choice cedars, and cast them into the fire. 8 And many nations shall pass by this city, and they shall say every man to his neighbour, Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this great city? 9 Then they shall answer, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD their God, and worshipped other gods, and served them.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Mark 16:17,18,20 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
- Deuteronomy 31:17 Then My anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide My <u>face</u> from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God *is* not among us?
- Hebrews 12:8,9 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. 9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?
- Mark 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of Me and of My Words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of Man be

- ashamed, when He cometh in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.
- Deuteronomy 31:18 And I will surely hide My <u>face</u> in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.
- Hosea 3:4 For the children of Israel shall abide many days without a king, and without a prince, and without a sacrifice, and without an image, and without an ephod, and *without* teraphim:
- Referred to when Israel & then Judah were captured.
- Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Luke 2:38 And she (Anna) coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of Him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem.
- Luke 2:26-30 And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ. 27 And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the Child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, 28 Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, 29 Lord, now lettest Thou thy servant depart in peace, according to Thy Word: 30 For mine eyes have seen Thy salvation,
- Luke 10:22 All things are delivered to Me of My Father: and no man knoweth Who the Son is, but the Father; and Who the Father is, but the Son, and *he* to whom the Son will reveal *Him*.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- Zechariah 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon Me Whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourneth for *his* only *son*, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.
- Strongs #08469. tachanuwn *takh-an-oon*; or (feminine) tachanuwnah *takh-an-oo-naw*; from <u>02603</u>; earnest prayer: intreaty, supplication.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto

- children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me.
- Isaiah 55:6 Seek ye the LORD while He may be found, call ye upon him while He is near:

- Luke 10:23 And He turned Him unto *His* disciples, and said privately, Blessed *are* the eyes which see the things that ye see:
- Luke 17:22 And He said unto the disciples, The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the Son of Man, and ye shall not see *it*.
- John 8:21 Then said Jesus again unto them, I go My way, and ye shall seek Me, and shall die in your sins: whither I go, ye cannot come.
- John 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I AM *He*, ye shall die in your sins.
- John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day: and he saw *it*, and was glad.
- John 14:19 Yet a little while, and the world seeth Me no more; but ye see Me: because I live, ye shall live also.
- Matthew 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed *is* He that cometh in the Name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.
- Psalms 118:26 Blessed *be* He that cometh in the Name of the LORD: we have blessed You out of the house of the LORD.
- Isaiah 40:9-11 O Zion, that bringest good tidings, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest good tidings, lift up thy voice with strength; lift it up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, Behold your God! 10 Behold, the Lord GOD will come with strong hand, and His arm shall rule for Him: behold, His reward is with Him, and His work before Him. 11 He shall feed His flock like a Shepherd: He shall gather the lambs with His arm, and carry them in His bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young.
