When God Hides His Face - Isaiah 59

- **Deuteronomy 31 Referred to Moses last Message to Israel.**
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Summarized of the Judges. When Israel was obedient, God blessed them. When they went after other gods, God punished them into slavery. When they turned back to God, God sent a judge to free them.
- Genesis 4:14 Behold, Thou hast driven me out this day from the <u>face</u> of the earth; and from Thy <u>face</u> shall I be <u>hid</u>; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, *that* every one that findeth me shall slay me.
- Matthew 6:14,15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- Deuteronomy 31:17 Then My anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will <a href="https://www.nil.goo.ni
- Luke 15 Referred to prodigal son returning to his senses.
- Daniel 4 Referred to that Nebuchadnezzar returned to his senses.
- Psalms 78 Referred to Israelites tempted God 10 times.
- Deuteronomy 31:18 And I will surely <u>hide</u> My <u>face</u> in that day for all the evils which they shall have wrought, in that they are turned unto other gods.
- Deuteronomy 32:20 And He said, I will <u>hide</u> My <u>face</u> from them, I will see what their end *shall be*: for they *are* a very froward generation, children in whom *is* no faith.
- Acts 19 Summarized of believers burning occult books.
- **Exodus 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.**
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.

- Hebrews 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.
- Luke 18:8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?
- Job 13:24 Wherefore <u>hidest</u> Thou Thy <u>face</u>, and holdest me for Thine enemy? Job 1&2 Referred to satan tempting Job to turn him from God
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Job 34:29 When He giveth quietness, who then can make trouble? and when He <u>hideth</u> *His* <u>face</u>, who then can behold Him? whether *it be done* against a nation, or against a man only:
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Psalms 10:11 He hath said in his heart, God hath forgotten: <u>He hideth His</u> <u>face</u>; He will never see *it*.
- Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.
- Psalms 13:1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » How long wilt Thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt Thou htm
- Psalms 22:24 For He hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath He <u>hid</u> His <u>face</u> from Him; but when He cried unto Him, He heard.
- Psalms 51:4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.
- Psalms 27:9 <u>Hide</u> not Thy <u>face</u> *far* from me; put not Thy servant away in anger: Thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Psalms 30:7 LORD, by Thy favour Thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: Thou didst <u>hide</u> Thy <u>face</u>, *and* I was troubled.
- Psalms 44:24 Wherefore <u>hidest</u> Thou Thy <u>face</u>, *and* forgettest our affliction and our oppression?
- 1 Samuel 12 Summarized of David & Bathsheba
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great

- occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.Psalms 69:17 And <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jhi/https://doi
- Psalms 51:9 Hide Thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.
- Psalms 88:14 LORD, why castest Thou off my soul? why hidest Thou Thy face from me?
- Psalms 102:2 <u>Hide</u> not Thy <u>face</u> from me in the day *when* I am in trouble; incline Thine ear unto me: in the day *when* I call answer me speedily.
- Psalms 104:29 Thou <u>hidest</u> Thy <u>face</u>, they are troubled: Thou takest away their breath, they die, and return to their dust.
- Psalms 143:7 Hear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: <u>hide</u> not Thy <u>face</u> from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.
- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Isaiah 8:17 And I will wait upon the LORD, that <u>hideth</u> His <u>face</u> from the house of Jacob, and I will look for (to) Him.
- Isaiah 50:6 I gave My back to the smiters, and My cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I <u>hid</u> not My <u>face</u> from shame and spitting.
- Isaiah 54:8 In a little wrath I <u>hid</u> My <u>face</u> from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Matthew 15:8 This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with their lips; but their heart is far from Me.
- Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid *His* face from you, that He will not hear.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Isaiah 64:7 And *there is* none that calleth upon Thy name, that stirreth up himself to take hold of Thee: for Thou hast <u>hid</u> Thy <u>face</u> from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities.
- Jeremiah 16:17 For Mine eyes *are* upon all their ways: they are not <u>hid</u> from My <u>face</u>, neither is their iniquity <u>hid</u> from Mine eyes.
- Jeremiah 33:5 They come to fight with the Chaldeans, but *it is* to fill them with the dead bodies of men, whom I have slain in Mine anger and in My fury, and for all whose wickedness I have <u>hid My face</u> from this city.

- Ezekiel 39:23 And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their <u>iniquity</u>: because they <u>trespassed against Me</u>, therefore <u>hid</u> I My <u>face</u> from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword. 24 According to their <u>uncleanness</u> and according to their <u>transgressions</u> have I done unto them, and <u>hid</u> My <u>face</u> from them.
- Leviticus Referred to the laws for priests to be clean before God or die.
- Ezekiel 39:29 Neither will I <u>hide</u> My <u>face</u> any more from them: for I have poured out My spirit upon the house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.
- 2 Corinthians 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
- Micah 3:4 Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but He will not hear them: He will even <u>hide</u> His <u>face</u> from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and <u>hide</u> us from the <u>face</u> of Him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- Matthew 23:39 For I say unto you, Ye shall not see Me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed *is* He that cometh in the Name of the Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 15:6 After that, He was seen of above five hundred <u>brethren</u> at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.
- Leviticus 26:19 And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass:
- Deuteronomy 28:23 And thy heaven that *is* over thy head shall be brass, and the earth that is under thee *shall be* iron.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- Luke 10:27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- 1 Samuel 4:21 And she named the child Ichabod, saying, The glory is departed from Israel: because the ark of God was taken, and because of her father in law and her husband.
- Revelation 3:11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man <u>take</u> thy crown.

- Revelation 6:4 And there went out another horse *that was* red: and *power* was given to him that sat thereon to <u>take</u> peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.
- Revelation 2:1-7 V1,2 Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith He that holdeth the seven stars in His right hand, Who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks; 2 I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars:
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Matthew 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:
- Revelation 2:3-5 And hast borne, and hast patience, and for My Name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted. 4 Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. 5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the Word with signs following. Amen.
- Ezekiel 8&9 Summarized of the ungodliness in the temple.
- Ezekiel 9:3 And the glory of the God of Israel was gone up from the cherub, whereupon he was, to the threshold of the house. And he called to the man clothed with linen, which had the writer's inkhorn by his side;
- Revelation 2:6 But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. 7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- Revelation 3:7-13 V7-9 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith He that is Holy, He that is True, He that hath the key of David, He that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth; 8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept My Word, and hast not denied My Name. 9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.
- Acts 8:21 Thou (Simon Magus) hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

- Revelation 3:10,11 Because thou hast kept the Word of My patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. 11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. ...
- Revelation 3:12,13 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the Name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from My God: and I will write upon him My new Name. 13 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Summarized of King Saul's sins against God.

- 1 Samuel 28:6 And when Saul enquired of the LORD, the LORD answered him not, neither by dreams, nor by Urim, nor by prophets.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the Word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it; 14 And enquired not of the LORD: therefore He slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.
- 1 Corinthians 11:29,30 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.
- Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
