The Ten Virgins - Matthew 25A

- Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- John 16:8 And when He (Holy Spirit) is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Matthew 25:1-13 V1 Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.
- Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.
- John 14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus returning.
- Matthew 25:2 And five of them were wise, and five were foolish.
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Proverbs 2:6 For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.
- Strongs #3474 moros *mo-ros'* AV-foolish 7, fool 5, foolishness 1; 13 1) foolish 2) impious, godless
- Matthew 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.
- Strongs rhaka rhak-ah' AV-Raca 1; 1) empty, i.e. a senseless, empty headed man 2) a term of reproach used among the Jews in the time of Christ
- Matthew 25:3 They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:
- No oil referrs to No Holy Spirit.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- John 16:8 And when He (Holy Spirit) is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Matthew 25:4 But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.
- John 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God,

- and Who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of Him, and He would have given thee living water.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Matthew 10:1 And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.
- Matthew 25: While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Mark 14:37,38 And he cometh, and findeth them sleeping, and saith unto Peter, Simon, sleepest thou? couldest not thou watch one hour? 38 Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak.
- John 9:4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- Matthew 25:6-8 And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him. 7 Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. 8 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.
- Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
- Matthew 25:9 But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves.
- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Matthew 25:10 And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut.
- Luke 14:23 And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.

- Matthew 25:11 Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us.
- 2 Corinthains 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Matthew 25:12 But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not. 13 <u>Watch</u> therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of Man cometh.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- Matthew 24:36 But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.
- Luke 19:46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Ezekiel 23:37 That they have committed <u>adultery</u>, and blood *is* in their hands, and with their <u>idols</u> have they committed <u>adultery</u>, and have also caused their sons, whom they bare unto Me, to pass for them through *the fire*, to devour *them*.
- Idolatry is spiritual adultery to God.
- Exodus 13:15 And it came to pass, when Pharaoh would hardly let us go, that the LORD slew all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: therefore I sacrifice to the LORD all that openeth the matrix, being males; but all the firstborn of My children I redeem.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from <u>pollutions of idols</u>, and *from fornication*, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Acts 15:29 That ye abstain from meats offered to <u>idols</u>, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from <u>fornication</u>: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.
- Acts 21:25 As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written *and* concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from *things* offered to idols, and from blood, and from

strangled, and from fornication.

- Romans 2:22 Thou that sayest a man should not commit <u>adultery</u>, dost thou commit <u>adultery</u>? thou that abhorrest <u>idols</u>, dost thou commit <u>sacrilege</u>?
- 1 Corinthians 5:10 Yet not altogether with the <u>fornicators</u> of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with <u>idolaters</u>; for then must ye needs go out of the world. 11 But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is <u>called a brother (Believer) be a fornicator</u>, or covetous, or an <u>idolater</u>, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.
- 1 Corinthians 5:1,2 It is reported commonly that there is fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife. 2 And ye are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he that hath done this deed might be taken away from among you.
- 1 Corinthians 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither <u>fornicators</u>, nor <u>idolaters</u>, nor <u>adulterers</u>, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,
- Colossians 3:5 Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; <u>fornication</u>, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is <u>idolatry</u>:
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Revelation 2:20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce My servants to commit <u>fornication</u>, and to eat things sacrificed unto <u>idols</u>.
- Matthew 7:17,18 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. 18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.
- Zechariah 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the <u>spirit of grace and of supplications</u>: and they shall look upon Me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourneth for *his* only *son*, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Luke 2:40 And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom:

- and the grace of God was upon him.
- Philemon 1:25 The <u>grace</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with your <u>spirit</u>. Amen. « Written from Rome to Philemon, by Onesimus a servant. »
- Hebrews 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me.
- Luke 23:36 And the soldiers also mocked Him, coming to Him, and offering him vinegar,
- Matthew 27:40 And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the cross.
- Matthew 7:21-27 V21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven.
- John 6:29,29 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
- Matthew 7:22 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy Name? and in Thy Name have cast out devils? and in Thy Name done many wonderful works?
- Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
- Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- Revelation 13:13,14 And he (beast) doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men, 14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles

- which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; <u>In My name shall</u> they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Acts 19 Referred to the 7 sons of Sceva trying to cast out demons in Jesus' name.
- 1 Corinthians 13:2,3 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. 3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. Matthew 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 7:24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of Mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock. 26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.
- Acts 8:9-25 V9-12 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: 10 To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power of God. 11 And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries. 12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that

believeth not shall be damned.

- Acts 8:13-19 Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done. 14 Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the Word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John: 15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost: 16 (For as yet He was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus.) 17 Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost. 18 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, 19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.
- Luke 10:17,20 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name. 20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.
- Acts 8:20,21 But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. 21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Acts 5 Referred to Ananias & Saphira judged.
- Acts 8:22 Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Acts 8:23-25 For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity. 24 Then answered Simon, and said, Pray ye to the Lord for me, that none of these things which ye have spoken come upon me. 25 And they, when they had testified and preached the Word of the Lord, returned to Jerusalem, and preached the gospel in many villages of the Samaritans.
- John 9:4 I must work the works of Him that sent Me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
