## The Beginning Of Knowledge - Proverbs 1B

- Matthew 7 Summarized of the Parable of the houses built on the Rock or sand.
- 1 Corinthians 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Isaiah 55:6 Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Proverbs 1:2 To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding;
- Proverbs 1:7-9 V7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not with Me scattereth.
- Galatians 4:6 And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Isaiah 6 Summarized Isaiah's vision of God in Heaven.
- Acts 26 Summarized Saul's vosion of Jesus on the road to Damascas.
- Acts 5 Referred to God judging Ananias & Saphirah. V11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.
- Ephesians 2:20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;
- Zephaniah 3:2 She obeyed not the voice; she received not correction; she trusted not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God.
- Proverbs 1:3 To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;
- Proverbs 1:8 My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

- Proverbs 31 Referred to the Virtuous Woman.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- Proverbs 1:9 For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.
- Referred to Daniel & Joseph being Godly men, God raised them up to authority.
- 2 Chronicles 1 Referred to Solomon's vision of God. V10 Give me now wisdom and knowledge, that I may go out and come in before this people: for who can judge this thy people, that is so great?
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind & spiritual death.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy *is* understanding.
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- 1 John 2:13,14 I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him *that is* from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father. 14 I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him *that is* from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you,

- and ye have overcome the wicked one.
- Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every <u>tree</u> that is pleasant to the sight, and <u>good</u> for food; the <u>tree</u> of life also in the midst of the garden, and the <u>tree</u> of knowledge of <u>good</u> and <u>evil</u>.
- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.
- Matthew 16:23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.
- Job 1:6 & 2:1 Satan appeared before God in Heaven.
- Luke 22:3 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- Genesis 2:17 But of the <u>tree</u> of the knowledge of <u>good</u> and <u>evil</u>, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Genesis 3:3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.
- Genesis 3:22 And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Matthew 7:17 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. 18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.
- Referred to Psalms 53 similar to Psalms 14.
- Psalms 14:1-7 V1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good.
- Matthew 18:6 But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in Me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Hebrews 5:9 And being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him;

- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Psalms 14:2 The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.
- Matthew 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.
- Matthew 2512 But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not.
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
- Psalms 14:3 They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Psalms 14:4-6 Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD. 5 There were they in great fear: for God is in the generation of the righteous. 6 Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because the LORD is his refuge.
- Referred to Moses after 40 years in Egypt, it took 40 years to get Egypt out of Moses.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Psalms 14:7 Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.
- 1 Peter 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him Who hath called you out of darkness into His marvellous light:
- Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man <u>leave</u> his <u>father</u> and his <u>mother</u>, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be <u>one</u> flesh.
- Matthew 19:5 And said, For this cause shall a man <u>leave</u> <u>father</u> and <u>mother</u>, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be <u>one</u> flesh?

- Ephesians 5:31 For this cause shall a man <u>leave</u> his <u>father</u> and <u>mother</u>, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be <u>one</u> flesh.
- Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My Name, there am I in the midst of them.
- Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Genesis 18:19 For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which He hath spoken of him.
- Deuteronomy 4:9 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but <u>teach them thy sons</u>, and thy sons' sons;
- Deuteronomy 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.
- Psalms 78:3-6 Which we have heard and known, and our <u>fathers have told us</u>. 4 We will not hide *them* from their children, shewing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and His strength, and His wonderful works that He hath done. 5 For He established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our <u>fathers</u>, that they should make them known to their children: 6 That the generation to come might know *them*, *even* the children *which* should be born; *who* should arise and declare *them* to their children:
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- 2 Timothy 3:15 And that <u>from a child thou hast known the Holy Scriptures</u>, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
