Wisdom Crieth Without - Proverbs 1D

- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- Proverbs 1:20 (AV) Wisdom crieth without; she uttereth her voice in the streets:
- Proverbs 1:20 (NKJV) Wisdom calls aloud outside; She raises her voice in the open squares.
- Acts 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, Him declare I unto you.
- Romans 1 & 1 Timothy 4:2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;
- Proverbs 1:21 (AV) She crieth in the chief place of concourse, in the openings of the gates: in the city she uttereth her words, *saying*,
- Proverbs 1:21 (NKJV) She cries out in the chief concourses, At the openings of the gates in the city She speaks her words:
- Matthew 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Proverbs 1:22 (AV) How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? and the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge?
- Proverbs 1:22 (NKJV) How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity (blissful ignorance)? For scorners delight in their scorning, And fools hate knowledge.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Proverbs 1:23 (AV) Turn you at My reproof: behold, I will pour out My Spirit unto you, I will make known My Words unto you.
- Proverbs 1:23 (NKJV) Turn at My rebuke; Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you; I will make My Words known to you.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

- Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning Himself.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' final coming
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Isaiah 55:6 Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:
- Proverbs 1:24 (AV) Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out My hand, and no man regarded;
- Proverbs 1:24 (NKJV) Because I have called and you refused, I have stretched out My hand and no one regarded,
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Matthew 28:11 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

- Proverbs 1:25 (AV) But ye have set at nought all My counsel, and would none of My reproof:
- Proverbs 1:25 (NKJV) Because you disdained all My counsel, And would have none of My rebuke,
- Romans 1 Referred to the descent into apostacy.
- Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me.
- Deut 13 referred to the false prophet enticing to serve other gods.
- Luke 11:24-26 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh

- through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. 25 And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished. 26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.
- Proverbs 1:26 (AV) I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh:
- Proverbs 1:26 (NKJV) I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your terror comes,
- 2 Kings 18 Referred to Sennacherib & Hezekiah.
- Proverbs 1:27 (AV) When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you.
- Proverbs 1:27 (NKJV) When your terror comes like a storm, And your destruction comes like a whirlwind, When distress and anguish come upon you.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God's final judgment on a disobedient Israel sending foreign invaders.
- Proverbs 1:28 (AV) Then shall they call upon Me, but I will not answer; they shall seek Me early, but they shall not find Me:
- Proverbs 1:28 (NKJV) Then they will call on Me, but I will not answer; They will seek Me diligently, but they will not find Me.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- 1 Samuel 28 Summarized of Saul judged for asking of the witch at Endor.
- Proverbs 1:29 (AV) For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD:
- Proverbs 1:29 (NKJV) Because they hated knowledge And did not choose the fear of the LORD,
- Proverbs 1:30 (AV) They would none of My counsel: they despised all My reproof.
- Proverbs 1:30 (NKJV) They would have none of My counsel *And* despised My every rebuke.
- Proverbs 1:31 (AV) Therefore shall they eat of the fruit of their own way, and be filled with their own devices.
- Proverbs 1:31 (NKJV) Therefore they shall eat the fruit of their own way, And be filled to the full with their own fancies.
- Proverbs 1:32 (AV) For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.
- Proverbs 1:32 (NKJV) For the turning away of the simple will slay them, And the complacency of fools will destroy them;

- James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.
- Proverbs 1:33 (AV) But whose hearkeneth unto Me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil.
- Proverbs 1:33 (NKJV) But whoever listens to Me will dwell safely, And will be secure, without fear of evil.
- Psalms 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Luke 1:17 And he shall go before Him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.
- Mark 1:3 The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.
- Acts 7:52 Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? and they have slain them which shewed before of the coming of the Just One; of whom ye have been now the betrayers and murderers:
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Luke 2:40 And the Child grew, and waxed strong in Spirit, filled with <u>wisdom</u>: and the grace of God was upon Him.
- Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind.
- Luke 2:52 And Jesus increased in <u>wisdom</u> and stature, and in favour with God and man.
- Luke 2 Summarized of Jesus in Jerusalem at age 12. V47 And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.
- Luke 7:35 But wisdom is justified of all her children.
- Luke 10:21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in Spirit, and said, I thank Thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that Thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in Thy sight.
- Judges 7 Referred to Gideon's army with torches & pitchers.
- Luke 11:31 The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the <u>wisdom</u> of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon *is* here.
- Luke 23:21 But they cried, saying, Crucify Him, crucify Him.
- Luke 11:49 Therefore also said the <u>wisdom</u> of God, I will send them prophets and apostles, and *some* of them they shall slay and persecute:
- Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the

- same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.
- Acts 4:4 Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand.
- Matthew 25 Referred to the Parable of the talents. V21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.
- Luke 12:42 And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and <u>wise</u> steward, whom *his* lord shall make ruler over his household, to give *them their* portion of meat in due season?
- Luke 16:8 And the lord commended the unjust steward, because he had done wisely: for the children of this world are in their generation wiser than the children of light.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Luke 21:12 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for My Name's sake.
- Luke 21:15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay (contradict) nor resist.
- Revelation 13:5 And there was given unto him (beast) a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.
- Hebrews 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

Luke 21:12-19 - 12 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for My Name's sake. 13 And it shall turn to you for a testimony. 14 Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: 15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. 16 And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. 17 And ye shall be hated of all men for My Name's sake. 18 But there shall not an hair of your head perish. 19 In your patience possess ye your souls.
