

Crying After Wisdom And Discernment - Proverbs 2A

Acts 11:22,23 Then tidings of these things came unto the ears of the church which was in Jerusalem: and they sent forth Barnabas, that he should go as far as Antioch. 23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.

Proverbs 1 Summarized Solomon's admonitions.

Proverbs 2:1-9 AV - V1 My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee;

Proverbs 2:1 (NKJV) My son, if you receive my words, And treasure my commands within you,

Leviticus 19:32 Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honour the face of the old man, and fear thy God: I am the LORD.

Proverbs 2:2 (AV) So that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to understanding;

Proverbs 2:2 (NKJV) So that you incline your ear to wisdom, And apply your heart to understanding;

Proverbs 2:3 (AV) Yea, if thou criest after knowledge, and liftest up thy voice for understanding;

Proverbs 2:3 (NKJV) Yes, if you cry out for discernment, And lift up your voice for understanding,

1 Kings 3:9,12 Give therefore Thy servant an understanding heart to judge Thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this Thy so great a people? 12 Behold, I have done according to thy words: lo, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee.

1 Corinthians 4:12 And labour, working with our own hands: being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we suffer it:

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

Proverbs 2:4 (AV) If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures;

Proverbs 2:4 (NKJV) If you seek her as silver, And search for her as for hidden treasures;

Proverbs 2:5 (AV) Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God.

Proverbs 2:5 (NKJV) Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, And find the knowledge of God.

Isaiah 6 Summarized of Isaiah's vision of God on the throne in Heaven. V5

Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.

Referred to Paul & John's visions of Jesus.

Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Proverbs 2:6 (AV) For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of His mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

Proverbs 2:6 (NKJV) For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding;

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, & hearing by the Word of God.

Proverbs 2:7 (AV) He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous: He is a buckler to them that walk uprightly.

Proverbs 2:7 (NKJV) He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly;

Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

Genesis 3 Summarized of the fall of mankind.

Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Proverbs 2:8 (AV) He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of His saints.

Proverbs 2:8 (NKJV) He guards the paths of justice, And preserves the way of His saints.

1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 Referred to God's laws on the occult.

Hebrews 10:20 By a new and living way, which He hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh;

Proverbs 2:9 (AV) Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; yea, every good path.

Proverbs 2:9 (NKJV) Then you will understand righteousness and justice, Equity and every good path.

John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Mark 5 Referred to the Gadarene demoniac running to Jesus for help. V6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him,

Acts 17:11 These (Bereans) were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

Hebrews 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

Deuteronomy 4:6 Keep therefore and do *them*; for this *is* your wisdom and your understanding <0998> in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation *is* a wise and understanding people.

Exodus 20 Referred to God's Commandments.

Numbers 13 Summarized of the 10 spies searching the land & their reports.

Numbers 14:1 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried; and the people wept that night.

1 Chronicles 12:32 And of the children of Issachar, *which were men* that had

understanding <0998> of the times, to know what Israel ought to do; the heads of them *were* two hundred; and all their brethren *were* at their commandment.

Matthew 16:3 And in the morning, It will be foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowring. O ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times?

1 Chronicles 22:12 Only the LORD give thee wisdom and understanding <0998>, and give thee charge concerning Israel, that thou mayest keep the law of the LORD thy God.

2 Chronicles 2:12 Hiram said moreover, Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel, that made heaven and earth, who hath given to David the king a wise son, endued with prudence and understanding <0998>, that might build an house for the LORD, and an house for his kingdom.

Exodus 31:3 And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,

2 Chronicles 2:13 And now I have sent a cunning (skillful) man, endued with understanding <0998>, of Hiram my father's,

Job 20:3 I have heard the check of my reproach, and the spirit of my understanding <0998> causeth me to answer.

Job - Referred to Job's friends accusing him.

Job 28:12 But where shall wisdom be found? and where *is* the place of understanding <0998>?

Job 28:20 Whence then cometh wisdom? and where *is* the place of understanding <0998>?

Job 28:28 And unto man He said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that *is* wisdom; and to depart from evil *is* understanding <0998>.

Job 34:16 If now *thou hast* understanding <0998>, hear this: hearken to the voice of my words.

Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding <0998>.

Job 38:22,23 Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail, 23 Which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war?

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

Job 38:36 Who hath put wisdom in the inward parts? or who hath given understanding <0998> to the heart?

Job 39:17 Because God hath deprived her of wisdom, neither hath He imparted to her understanding <0998>.

Job 39:14 (Ostrich) Which leaveth her eggs in the earth, and warmeth them in dust, 15 And forgetteth that the foot may crush them, or that the wild beast may break them. 16 She is hardened against her young ones, as

though they were not hers: her labour is in vain without fear;
Job 39:26 Doth the hawk fly by thy wisdom <0998>, *and* stretch her wings toward the south?

Summarized of God saving the broken people & helping them.

Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Proverbs 1:2 To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding <0998>;

Proverbs 2:3 Yea, if thou criest after knowledge <0998>, *and* liftest up thy voice for understanding;

Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding <0998>.

Psalms 37:5 Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.

Luke 9:23 And He said to them all, If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.

Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.

Proverbs 4:1 Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding <0998>.

Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding <0998>: forget *it* not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

More Service Notes:

Proverbs 4:7 Wisdom *is* the principal thing; *therefore* get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding <0998>.

Proverbs 7:4 Say unto wisdom, Thou *art* my sister; and call understanding <0998> *thy* kinswoman:

Proverbs 8:14 Counsel *is* mine, and sound wisdom: I *am* understanding <0998>; I have strength.

Proverbs 9:6 Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding <0998>.

Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the Holy *is* understanding <0998>.

Proverbs 16:16 How much better *is it* to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding <0998> rather to be chosen than silver!

Proverbs 23:4 Labour not to be rich: cease from thine own wisdom <0998>.

Proverbs 23:23 Buy the truth, and sell *it* not; *also* wisdom, and instruction, and understanding <0998>.

Proverbs 30:2 Surely I *am* more brutish than *any* man, and have not the understanding <0998> of a man.

Isaiah 11:2 And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding <0998>, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

Isaiah 27:11 When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, *and* set them on fire: for it *is* a people of no understanding <0998>: therefore He that made them will not have mercy on them, and He that formed them will shew them no favour.

Isaiah 29:14 Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people, *even* a marvellous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise *men* shall perish, and the understanding <0998> of their prudent *men* shall be hid.

Isaiah 29:24 They also that erred in spirit shall come to understanding <0998>, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine.

Isaiah 33:19 Thou shalt not see a fierce people, a people of a deeper speech than thou canst perceive; of a stammering tongue, *that thou canst* not understand <0998>.

Jeremiah 23:20 The anger of the LORD shall not return, until He have executed, and till He have performed the thoughts of His heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly <0998>.

Daniel 1:20 And in all matters of wisdom *and* understanding <0998>, that the king enquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians *and* astrologers that *were* in all his realm.

Daniel 8:15 And it came to pass, when I, *even* I Daniel, had seen the vision, and sought for the meaning <0998>, then, behold, there stood before me as the appearance of a man.

Daniel 9:22 And he informed *me*, and talked with me, and said, O Daniel, I am now come forth to give thee skill and understanding <0998>.

Daniel 10:1 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a thing was revealed unto Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar; and the thing *was* true, but the time appointed *was* long: and he understood the thing, and had understanding <0998> of the vision.
