## **Turning Away To Another Gospel - Galatians 1B**

- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Galatians 1:1 Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)
- Acts 9 Referred to Saul's conversion at the vision of Jesus.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Matthew 21 Referred to Jesus cleaning out the Temple.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Luke 14:33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be My disciple.
- Galatians 1:6 (AV) I marvel that ye are so soon removed from Him that called you into the grace of Christ unto <u>another gospel</u>:
- 1 Corinthians 5:1 It is reported commonly that there is fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife.
- Galatians 1:6 (NKJV) I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him Who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel,
- Galatians 1:6 (Message) I can't believe your fickleness—how easily you have turned traitor to Him Who called you by the grace of Christ by <a href="mailto:embracing a variant message">embracing a variant message</a>!
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Galatians 1:7 (AV) Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you,

- and would pervert the gospel of Christ.
- Proverbs 10:12 Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.
- 1 Peter 4:8 And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity (love) shall cover the multitude of sins.
- 1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- Galatians 1:7 (NKJV) which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of Eve deceived & the fall of Mankind.
- Genesis 3:1 Genesis 3Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- Galatians 1:7 (Message) It is <u>not a minor variation</u>, you know; it is completely other, an <u>alien message</u>, a <u>no-message</u>, a lie about God. Those who are provoking this agitation among you are turning the Message of Christ on its head.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or *if* ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or <u>another gospel</u>, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with *him*.
- Galatians 1:8 (AV) But though we, or an angel from heaven, <u>preach any</u> other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.
- Galatians 1:8 (NKJV) But even if we, or an angel from heaven, <u>preach any</u> other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.
- Galatians 1:8 (Message) Let me be blunt: If one of us—even if an angel from heaven!—were to <u>preach something other than what we preached originally</u>, let him be <u>cursed</u>.
- Acts 17:3 Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out

- of My Father's hand.
- Galatians 1:9 (AV) As we said before, so say I now again, If any *man* <u>preach</u> <u>any other gospel</u> unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.
- Deuteronomy 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.
- Galatians 1:9 (NKJV) As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone <u>preaches any other gospel</u> to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.
- Galatians 1:9 (Message) I said it once; I'll say it again: If anyone, regardless of reputation or credentials, <u>preaches something other than what you received originally</u>, let him be <u>cursed</u>.
- Strongs #3346. metatithemi *met-at-ith'-ay-mee*; from <u>3326</u> and <u>5087</u>; to transfer, i.e. (literally) transport, (by implication) exchange (reflexively) <u>change sides</u>, or (figuratively) pervert: carry over, change, remove, translate, turn.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- 2 Samuel 15:11 And with Absalom went two hundred men out of Jerusalem, that were called; and they went in their <u>simplicity</u>, and they knew not any thing.
- Summarized of Absalom scheeming to get the throne from King David his father.
- 2 Samuel 15:6 And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- 1 Chronicles 12:17 And David went out to meet them, and answered and said unto them, If ye be come peaceably unto me to help me, mine heart shall be knit unto you: but if ye be come to betray me to mine enemies, seeing there is no wrong in mine hands, the God of our fathers look thereon, and rebuke it.
- Proverbs 1:22 How long, ye <u>simple ones</u>, <u>will ye love simplicity</u>? and the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge?
- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they (younger widows) learn to be idle,

- wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.
- Romans 12:8 Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, *let him do it* with <u>simplicity</u>; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.
- Deuteronomy 8:18 But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is He that giveth thee power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.
- Acts 4:35-37 And laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need. 36 And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, (which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,) a Levite, and of the country of Cyprus, 37 Having land, sold it, and brought the money, and laid it at the apostles' feet.
- Acts 5 Referred to Ananias & Sapphira lying to the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 1:12 For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in <u>simplicity and godly sincerity</u>, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- Luke 8 Referred to Jesus casting out the demons from the Gadarene.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 2 Corinthians 11:3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the <u>serpent beguiled</u>
  <u>Eve through his subtilty</u>, so your <u>minds should be corrupted from the</u>
  simplicity that is in Christ.
- Genesis 3:3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Strongs #572 haplotes *hap-lot'-ace* AV-simplicity 3, singleness 2, liberality 1, bountifulness 1, liberty 1; 8 1) singleness, simplicity, sincerity, mental honesty 1a) the virtue of one who is free from pretence and hypocrisy 2) not self seeking, openness of heart manifesting itself by generousity.
- Jeremiah 3:15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt <u>not learn to do after the abominations</u> of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that

- maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an <u>abomination unto the LORD</u>: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- 2 Corinthians 11:1-3 Would to God ye could bear with me a little in *my* folly: and indeed bear with me. 2 For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. 3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
- Acts 8:9,10 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: 10 To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or *if* ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or <u>another gospel</u>, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with *him*.
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God.
- Acts 15:1-5 V1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Acts 15:2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and

- elders about this question.
- Luke 21:15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
- 1 Samuel 17:36 Thy servant (David) slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the living God.
- Acts 15:3 And being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the brethren.
- Acts 15:4 And when they were come to Jerusalem, they were received of the church, and *of* the apostles and elders, and they declared all things that God had done with them.
- Acts 15:5 But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command *them* to keep the law of Moses.
- Strongs #331 anathema an-ath'-em-ah AV-accursed 4, anathema 1, bind under a great curse + 332 1; 6 1) a thing set up or laid by in order to be kept 1a) specifically, an offering resulting from a vow, which after being consecrated to a god was hung upon the walls or columns of the temple, or put in some other conspicuous place
- 2) a thing devoted to God without hope of being redeemed, and if an animal, to be slain; therefore a person or thing doomed to destruction 2a) a curse 2b) a man accursed, devoted to the direct of woes
