- 2 Kings 1 Referred to Elijah calling down fire from Heaven.
- Summarized how Jesus was mis-treated.
- John 1:3 All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made.
- John 5:22 For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which no one else did, they would have no sin; but now they have seen and also hated both Me and My Father.
- Summarized of many miracles Jesus did, raising Lazarus, & healing many. Romans 1:25 Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever.

- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Job 38:1-41 V1,2 Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said, 2 Who is this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge? (foolish talk)
- Job 2:9 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die. 10 But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.
- Job 38:3 Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou Me.

- Revelation 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

- Psalms 19:1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth His handywork.
- Job 38:5 Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or Who hath stretched the line upon it?
- Referred to the precise directions given to build God's Temple by Solomon.
- Job 38:6,7 Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or Who laid the corner stone thereof; 7 When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?
- Luke 19:38-40 Saying, Blessed *be* the King that cometh in the Name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest. 39 And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto Him, Master, rebuke Thy disciples. 40 And He answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.
- Luke 2:11-14 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. 12 And this *shall be* a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. 13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, 14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth

- peace, good will toward men.
- Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Job 38:8 Or Who shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, as if it had issued out of the womb?
- Genesis 7:11,12 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened. 12 And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights.
- Job 38:9 When I made the cloud the garment thereof, and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it,
- Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:
- Job 38:10,11 And brake up for it My decreed place, and set bars and doors, 11 And said, Hitherto shalt thou come, but no further: and here shall thy proud waves be stayed?

- Job 38:12,13 Hast thou commanded the morning since thy days; and caused the dayspring to know his place; 13 That it might take hold of the ends of the earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it?
- Isaiah 40:22 *It is* he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof *are* as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:
- Job 38:14,15 It is turned as clay to the seal; and they stand as a garment.

 15 And from the wicked their light is withholden, and the high arm shall be broken.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- Job 38:16,17 Hast thou entered into the springs of the sea? or hast thou walked in the search of the depth? 17 Have the gates of death been opened unto thee? or hast thou seen the doors of the shadow of death?
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- Job 38:18-20 Hast thou perceived the breadth of the earth? declare if thou

- knowest it all. 19 Where is the way where light dwelleth? and as for darkness, where is the place thereof, 20 That thou shouldest take it to the bound thereof, and that thou shouldest know the paths to the house thereof?
- John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- Job 38:21 Knowest thou it, because thou wast then born? or because the number of thy days is great? 22 Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail,
- Joshua 10:11 And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, and were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.
- Job 38:23 Which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war? 24 By what way is the light parted, which scattereth the east wind upon the earth?
- Genesis 9:13,16 I do set My bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between Me and the earth. 16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that *is* upon the earth.
- Job 38:25,26 Who hath divided a watercourse for the overflowing of waters, or a way for the lightning of thunder; 26 To cause it to rain on the earth, where no man is; on the wilderness, wherein there is no man;
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.
- Job 38:27,28 To satisfy the desolate and waste ground; and to cause the bud of the tender herb to spring forth? 28 Hath the rain a Father? or Who hath begotten the drops of dew?
- Genesis 2:6 But there went up a mist (dew) from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.
- Job 38:29-36 Out of whose womb came the ice? and the hoary frost of heaven, Who hath gendered it? 30 The waters are hid as with a stone, and the face of the deep is frozen. 31 Canst thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades, or loose the bands of Orion? 32 Canst thou bring forth Mazzaroth in his season? or canst thou guide Arcturus (great bear

& cubs) with his sons? 33 Knowest thou the ordinances of heaven? canst thou set the dominion thereof in the earth? 34 Canst thou lift up thy voice to the clouds, that abundance of waters may cover thee? 35 Canst thou send lightnings, that they may go, and say unto thee, Here we are? 36 Who hath put wisdom in the inward parts? or Who hath given understanding to the heart?

- Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the Holy *is* understanding.
- Job 38:37-41 Who can number the clouds in wisdom? or Who can stay the bottles of heaven, 38 When the dust groweth into hardness, and the clods cleave fast together? 39 Wilt thou hunt the prey for the lion? or fill the appetite of the young lions, 40 When they couch in their dens, and abide in the covert to lie in wait? 41 Who provideth for the raven his food? when his young ones cry unto God, they wander for lack of meat.
- Job 42:6-8 Wherefore I (Job) abhor *myself*, and repent in dust and ashes. And it was *so*, that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me *the thing that is* right, as My servant Job *hath*. 8 Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to My servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and My servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you *after your* folly, in that ye have not spoken of Me *the thing which is* right, like My servant Job.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
