Wisdom Delivers From Evil Men - Proverbs 2B

- John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that Light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
- 1 Peter 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvellous light:

- 1 Corinthians 8:13 Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.
- Isaiah 43:2 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.
- Proverbs 2:12 (AV) To deliver thee from the way of the evil man, from the man that speaketh froward things; (NKJV) To deliver you from the way of evil, From the man who speaks perverse things,
- Matthew 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil (from

- the evil one): For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 (AV) Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners. (NKJV) Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Luke 11:33 No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth it in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light.
- Luke 9:26 For whosoever shall be ashamed of Me and of My Words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when He shall come in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the Holy angels.
- Proverbs 2:13 (AV) Who leave the paths of uprightness, to walk in the ways of darkness; (NKJV) From those who leave the paths of uprightness To walk in the ways of darkness;
- Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, & broad is the way, that leads to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- 2 Kings 20 Referred to the evil ways of Manasseh & his repentance.
- Jonah Summarized of Jonah rebelling & returning to do God's will with all Nineveh getting saved.
- Job 38,39 Referred to God answering Job.
- Proverbs 2:15 (AV) Whose ways are crooked, and they froward in their paths: (NKJV) Whose ways are crooked, And who are devious in their paths; Proverbs 16:30 He shutteth his eyes to devise froward (evil) things: moving

- his lips he bringeth evil to pass.
- Referred to many virtuous Godly women.
- Proverbs 2:16 (AV) (Godly Wisdom) To deliver thee from the strange woman, even from the stranger which flattereth with her words;
- Proverbs 2:16 (NKJV) To deliver you from the immoral woman, From the seductress who flatters with her words,
- Genesis 39 Referred to Joseph tempted by his master's wife. V12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- 1 Kings 11:3,7,8 And he had 700 wives, princesses, & 300 concubines: & his wives turned away his heart. 7 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that *is* before Jerusalem, & for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. 8 & likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense & sacrificed unto their gods.
- Daniel 2:21 And He changeth the times and the seasons: He removeth kings, and setteth up kings: He giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- Proverbs 2:17 (AV) Which forsaketh the guide of her youth, and forgetteth the covenant of her God. (NKJV) Who forsakes the companion of her youth, And forgets the covenant of her God.
- Numbers 5 Referred to the spirit jealousy on a man.
- Genesis 2:22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.
- Proverbs 2:18 (AV) For her house inclineth unto death, and her paths unto the dead. (NKJV) For her house leads down to death, & her paths to the dead; Exodus 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- Leviticus 18:6 (Message) V6 Don't have sex with a close relative. I am GOD.
- John 8 Referred to the woman taken in adultery brought to Jesus. V11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Proverbs 2:19 (AV) None that go unto her return again, neither take they hold of the paths of life.
- Proverbs 2:19 (NKJV) None who go to her return, Nor do they regain the paths of life —
- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;
- Judges 16:30 And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with all his might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that were therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than they which he slew in his life.
- Psalms 51 Referred to David's repentance.

- Acts 5:10,11 Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband. 11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Matthew 25 Referred to the parable of the Talents.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Proverbs 2:20 (AV) That thou mayest walk in the way of good men, and keep the paths of the righteous.
- Proverbs 2:20 (NKJV) So you may walk in the way of goodness, And keep to the paths of righteousness.

- 1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

- Proverbs 2:22 (AV) But the wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the transgressors shall be rooted out of it.
- Proverbs 2:22 (NKJV) But the wicked will be cut off from the earth, And the unfaithful will be uprooted from it.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- Acts 7:60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep. (Stephen)
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, & stood & confessed their sins, & the iniquities of their fathers.
- Matthew 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but <u>deliver</u> us from <u>evil</u>: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.
- Luke 11:4 (AV) And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but <u>deliver</u> us from <u>evil</u>.
- Luke 11:4 (NKJV) And forgive us our sins, For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: & nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe (in Jesus); In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He hath made Him to be sin for us, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.
- John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.

More Service Notes:

Leviticus 18:6-30 (Message) - 6 Don't have sex with a close relative. I am GOD. 7 Don't violate your father by having sex with your mother. She is your mother. Don't have sex with her. 8 Don't have sex with your father's wife. That violates your father. 9 Don't have sex with your sister, whether she's your father's daughter or your mother's, whether she was born in the same house or elsewhere. 10 Don't have sex with your son's daughter or your daughter's daughter. That would violate your own body. 11 Don't have sex with the daughter of your father's wife born to your father. She is your sister. 12 Don't have sex with your father's sister; she is your aunt, closely related to your father. 13 Don't have sex with your mother's sister; she is your aunt, closely related to your mother. 14 Don't violate your father's brother, your uncle, by having sex with his wife. She is your aunt. 15 Don't have sex with your daughter-in-law. She is your son's wife; don't have sex with her. 16 Don't have sex with your brother's wife; that would violate your brother. 17 Don't have sex with both a woman and her daughter. And don't have sex with her granddaughters either. They are her close relatives. That is wicked. 18 Don't marry your wife's sister as a rival wife and have sex with her while your wife is living, 19 Don't have sex with a woman during the time of her menstrual period when she is unclean. 20 Don't have sex with your neighbor's wife and violate yourself by her. 21 Don't give any of your children to be burned in sacrifice to the god Molech — an act of sheer blasphemy of your God. I am GOD. 22 Don't have sex with a man as one does with a woman. That is abhorrent. 23 Don't have sex with an animal and violate yourself by it. A woman must not have sex with an animal. That is perverse. 24 Don't pollute yourself in any of these ways. This is how the nations became polluted, the ones that I am going to drive out of the land before you. 25 Even the land itself became polluted and I punished it for its iniquities — the land vomited up its inhabitants. 26 You must keep my decrees and laws — natives and foreigners both. You must not do any of these abhorrent things, 27 The people who lived in this land before you arrived did all these things and polluted the land. 28 And if you pollute it, the land will vomit you up just as it vomited up the nations that preceded you. 29 Those who do any of these abhorrent things will be cut off from their people. 30 Keep to what I tell you; don't engage in any of the abhorrent acts that were practiced before you came. Don't pollute yourselves with them. I am GOD, your God.
