## **Zeal For Ungodly Traditions - Galatians 1C**

- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ... 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Acts 9 Referred to Jesus calling Saul Paul from persecuting the Christrians. Galatians 1:10-24 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Galatians 1:10 (AV) For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.
- Galatians 1:10 (NKJV) For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ.
- Acts 14 Summarized of Paul & Barnabas in Lystra.
- Matthew 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the Living God. 17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
- Galatians 1:11 (AV) But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.
- Galatians 1:11 (NKJV) But I make known to you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man.

- Acts 5:38,39 And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought: 39 But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God.
- Referred to Isaiah & Moses seeing God.
- Galatians 1:18 Then after three years (in Arabia) I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days.
- Galatians 1:13 (AV) For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:
- Galatians 1:13 (NKJV) For you have heard of my former conduct in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy it.
- Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.
- Acts 9:2 And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.
- Galatians 1:14 (AV) And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers.
- Galatians 1:14 (NKJV) And I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries in my own nation, being more exceedingly zealous for the traditions of my fathers.
- Galatians 1:15 (AV) But when it pleased God, Who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by His grace,
- Galatians 1:15 (NKJV) But when it pleased God, Who separated me from my mother's womb and called me through His grace,
- John 2:16,17 And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not My Father's house an house of merchandise. 17 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.
- Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My Words shall not pass away.
- Job 38-40 Summarized of God answering Job & Job repenting.
- Jeremiah 1:5 Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a

- prophet unto the nations.
- John the Baptist, Samson & Samuel were called of God in the womb or before.
- Acts 13:48 And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the Word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.

- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God.
- Galatians 1:17 (AV) Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.
- Galatians 1:17 (NKJV) nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me; but I went to Arabia, and returned again to Damascus.
- Mark 1:3 The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.
- Galatians 1:18 (AV) Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days.
- Galatians 1:18 (NKJV) Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and remained with him fifteen days.
- Acts 13:2 As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.
- Exodus 19:10,11 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, 11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.

- Galatians 1:19 (AV) But other of the apostles saw I none, save James the Lord's brother.

- Galatians 1:20 (AV) Now the things which I write unto you, behold, before God, I lie not.
- Galatians 1:20 (NKJV) (Now concerning the things which I write to you, indeed, before God, I do not lie.)
- Matthew 5:37 But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil.
- Galatians 1:21 (AV) Afterwards I came into the regions of Syria and Cilicia;
- Galatians 1:21 (NKJV) Afterward I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia.
- Summarized of Paul's missionary journeys.
- Galatians 1:22 (AV) And was unknown by face unto the churches of Judaea which were in Christ:
- Galatians 1:22 (NKJV) And I was unknown by face to the churches of Judea which were in Christ.
- John 9:22 These words spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue.
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died;
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's in perils list.
- Galatians 1:23 (AV) But they had heard only, That he which persecuted us in times past now preacheth the faith which once he destroyed.
- Galatians 1:23 (NKJV) But they were hearing only, He who formerly persecuted us now preaches the faith which he once tried to destroy.
- John 4 Referred to the woman at the well saved & brought the whole town to Jesus.
- Acts 12:2 And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.
- Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
- Acts 12 Referred to God getting Peter out of jail.
- Acts 27:24 Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.
- Galatians 1:24 (AV) And they glorified God in me.

Summarized of modern persecutions of Christians.

Exposed the falacy of pre-trib rapture.

- Mark 13:32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.
- Luke 19:13 And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- 2 Timothy 4:1-5 V1,2 I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, Who shall judge the quick and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom; 2 Preach the Word; be instant in season, out of season (not favourable); reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.
- 1 Chronicles 16:22 Saying, Touch not Mine anointed, and do My prophets no harm.
- 2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

- Deuteronomy 18:11 (Not be) Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- 2 Timothy 4:5 But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.
- Luke 8 Summarized of the Gadarene demoniac coming to Jesus. V35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.
