Our Hearts Keeping Godly Commandments - Proverbs 3A

- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died;
- Romans 7:24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?
- Romans 7:19 For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- 1 John 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us. John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Proverbs 3:1 (AV) My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

 Proverbs 3:1 (NKJV) My son, do not forget my law, But let your heart keep my commands;
- Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments for God's order.
- Matthew 5-7 Jesus gave us the "Blessed Be" in the Beatitudes.
- Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Luke 10:27 And He answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Proverbs 3:2 (AV) For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

 Proverbs 3:2 (NKJV) For length of days and long life And peace they will add to you.
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.

- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.
- Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- Proverbs 3:3 (AV) Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:
- Proverbs 3:3 (NKJV) Let not mercy and truth forsake you; Bind them around your neck, Write them on the tablet of your heart,
- Luke 10 Summarized of the parable of the Good Samaratan.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- John 18:38 Pilate saith unto Him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.
- Deuteronomy 17:18,19 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: & it shall be with him, & he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the Words of this law and these statutes, to do them:

- Proverbs 3:4 (NKJV) so find favor & high esteem In the sight of God & man. Summarized of slaves risen to high positions by God creating favour for them like Joseph, Daniel, & Esther.
- Proverbs 3:5 (AV) Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

 Proverbs 3:5 (NKJV) Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;
- John 11:43,44 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and

- acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father.
- Acts 9 Summarized of Saul's vision of Jesus. V4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou Me?
- Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.
- 1 Samuel 17 Summarized of David Versus Goliath. V45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the Name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.
- Proverbs 3:6 (AV) In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths. Proverbs 3:6 (NKJV) In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.
- Acts 16:7,9,10 After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit suffered them not. 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us. 10 And after he had seen the vision, immediately we endeavoured to go into Macedonia, assuredly gathering that the Lord had called us for to preach the gospel unto them.
- Ezekiel 36:25-38 V25 Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- Referred to the Israelites at mount Sinai & the golden calf, & Josiah cleaning out the idols, etc.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- Jeremiah 18:3 Then I went down to the potter's house, and, behold, he wrought a work on the wheels.
- Ezekiel 36:27 And I will put My Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in My statutes, and ye shall keep My judgments, and do them.
- John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall

hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' 1000 year rule on earth.

Ezekiel 36:28 And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be My people, and I will be your God.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.

Exodus 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Luke 14:26 If any man come to Me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.

Revelation 3 Referred to the letter Laodicean Church.

James 1:19-27 - V19-22 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: 20 For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God. 21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted Word, which is able to save your souls. 22 But be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

Job 37-39 God answering Job & Job's repentance.

James 1:23-25 For if any be a hearer of the Word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: 24 For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. 25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, <u>If a man love Me, he will keep My Words</u>: and My Father will <u>love</u> him, and We will come unto him, and make Our abode with him.

Philippians 4:7 And the <u>peace</u> of God, which <u>passeth</u> all <u>understanding</u>, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not

unto men;

- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Summarized of the curses & blessings proclaimed on the mountains.
- Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities *deserve*, and hast given us *such* deliverance as this;
- Job 11:6 And that he would shew thee the secrets of wisdom, that *they are* double to that which is! Know therefore that God exacteth of thee *less* than thine iniquity *deserveth*.

More Service Notes:

- Ezekiel 36:29-38 I will also save you from all your uncleannesses: and I will call for the corn, and will increase it, and lay no famine upon you. 30 And I will multiply the fruit of the tree, and the increase of the field, that ye shall receive no more reproach of famine among the heathen. 31 Then shall ye remember your own evil ways, and your doings that were not good, and shall lothe yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and for your abominations. 32 Not for your sakes do I this, saith the Lord GOD, be it known unto you: be ashamed and confounded for your own ways, O house of Israel. 33 Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day that I shall have cleansed you from all your iniquities I will also cause you to dwell in the cities, and the wastes shall be builded. 34 And the desolate land shall be tilled, whereas it lay desolate in the sight of all that passed by. 35 And they shall say, This land that was desolate is become like the garden of Eden; and the waste and desolate and ruined cities are become fenced, and are inhabited. 36 Then the heathen that are left round about you shall know that I the LORD build the ruined places, and plant that that was desolate: I the LORD have spoken it, and I will do it. 37 Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will yet for this be enquired of by the house of Israel, to do it for them; I will increase them with men like a flock. 38 As the Holy flock, as the flock of Jerusalem in her solemn feasts; so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men: and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- James 1:26-27 If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain. 27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.
