## Perspectives - Godly Or Not - Proverbs 3B

- Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning Himself.
- **Proverbs 3:7-12 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Proverbs 3:7 (AV) Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.
- Proverbs 3:7 (NKJV) Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil.
- Romans 12:1-3 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. 3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am Holy.
- Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this Man.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- 1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Romans 12:2 (NKJV) And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- Proverbs 3:8 (AV) It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.
- Proverbs 3:8 (NKJV) It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones.
- Isaiah 58:8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.
- Psalms 44:4 Thou art my King, O God: command deliverances for Jacob.

- Psalms 68:1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm or Song of David. » Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him.
- Psalms 86:17 Shew me a token for good; that they which hate me may see it, and be ashamed: because thou, LORD, hast holpen me, and comforted me.
- Acts 7:18,19 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, 19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Proverbs 3:9 (AV) Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase:
- Proverbs 3:9 (NKJV) Honor the LORD with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase;
- Psalms 24:1 « A Psalm of David. » The earth is the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
- Mark 7:11-13 But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, It is Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; he shall be free. 12 And ye suffer him no more to do ought for his father or his mother; 13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him (Blind Bart), Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
- John 11 Referred to Lazarus raised from the dead & that the Jews wanted to kill him & Jesus. V53 Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put Him to death.
- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- Acts 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Exodus 20:10 But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is

- within thy gates:
- Proverbs 3:10 (AV) So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.
- Proverbs 3:10 (NKJV) So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.
- Matthew 26:29 But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of <u>this fruit of</u> <u>the vine</u>, until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom.
- Proverbs 3:11 (AV) My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction:
- Proverbs 3:11 (NKJV) My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor detest His correction;
- Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:
- Luke 15 Referred to the Prodigal son V17 And when he <u>came to himself</u>, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- Jonah Summarized of God calling Jonah, his running away, & God chastening him till he returned.
- Proverbs 3:12 (AV) For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son *in whom* he delighteth.
- Proverbs 3:12 (NKJV) For whom the LORD loves He corrects, Just as a father the son *in whom* he delights.
- Romans 12:2 (NKJV) And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Romans 12:3 (AV) For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- Romans 12:3 (NKJV) For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, <u>not to think of himself more highly than he ought to</u>

- <u>think</u>, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.
- James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Proverbs 1:7 The <u>fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge</u>: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- Proverbs 1:29 For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the <u>fear</u> of the LORD:
- Proverbs 2:5 Then shalt thou <u>understand the fear of the LORD</u>, and find the knowledge of God.
- Proverbs 3:7 Be not wise in thine own eyes: <u>fear the LORD, and depart from</u> evil.
- Proverbs 8:13 The <u>fear of the LORD is to hate evil</u>: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward (perverse) mouth, do I hate.
- Luke 11:26 Referred to seven worse entering unsaved if demons cast out.
- Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy *is* understanding.
- Proverbs 10:27 The <u>fear of the LORD</u> prolongeth days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.
- Ezekiel 1317-23 referred to witches afflicting God's people. V23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- Proverbs 14:26 In the <u>fear of the LORD</u> is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- Isaiah 43:2 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.

- Proverbs 14:27 The <u>fear of the LORD</u> is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.
- Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
- Proverbs 15:16 Better *is* little with the <u>fear of the LORD</u> than great treasure and trouble therewith.
- Proverbs 15:33 The <u>fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom</u>; and before honour *is* humility.
- Proverbs 16:6 By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the <u>fear of the</u> LORD *men* depart from evil.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.
- Proverbs 19:23 The <u>fear of the LORD</u> tendeth to life: and he that hath it shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.
- Proverbs 22:4 By humility *and* the <u>fear of the LORD</u> *are* riches, and honour, and life.
- Proverbs 23:17 Let not thine heart envy sinners: but *be thou* in the <u>fear of the LORD</u> all the day long.
- Proverbs 24:21 My son, <u>fear thou the LORD</u> and the king: *and* meddle not with them that are given to change:
- Proverbs 29:25 The <u>fear</u> of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.
- Proverbs 3:7 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and <u>depart from</u> evil.
- Proverbs 13:19 The desire accomplished is sweet to the soul: but *it is* abomination to fools to depart from evil.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that <u>believe</u>; <u>In My Name</u> shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Proverbs 14:16 A wise *man* feareth, and <u>departeth from evil</u>: but the fool rageth, and is confident.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Proverbs 16:6 By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD *men* depart from evil.
- Proverbs 16:17 The highway of the upright is to depart from evil: he that

keepeth his way preserveth his soul.

- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;
- Proverbs 17:13 Whoso rewardeth <u>evil</u> for good, <u>evil</u> shall not <u>depart</u> from his house.
- Deuteronomy 7:15 And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all *them* that hate thee.
- Pray for God to protect Believers in Jesus' Name from the modern diseases. John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.
- Deuteronomy 28:60 Moreover He will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall cleave unto thee.
- Malachi 3:7-11 Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept *them*. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the LORD of hosts. But ye said, Wherein shall we return? 8 Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings. 9 Ye *are* cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, *even* this whole nation. 10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that *there shall* not *be room* enough *to receive it*. 11 And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.
- Hebrews 12:5 (AV) And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:
