## Is Your Liberty Being Spied Out - Galatians 2A

- Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Genesis 3 Referred to Eve deceived.
- John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.
- **Galatians 2:1-10 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Galatians 2:1 (AV) Then fourteen years after I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and took Titus with *me* also.
- Galatians 2:1 (NKJV) Then after fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and also took Titus with *me*.
- Galatians 2:2 (AV) And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.
- Galatians 2:2 (NKJV) And I went up by revelation, and communicated to them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to those who were of reputation, lest by any means I might run, or had run, in vain.
- Galatians 2:3 (AV) But neither Titus, who was with me, being a Greek, was compelled to be circumcised:
- Galatians 2:3 (NKJV) Yet not even Titus who was with me, being a Greek, was compelled to be circumcised.
- Acts 16:3 Him (Timothy) would Paul have to go forth with him; and took and circumcised him because of the Jews which were in those quarters: for they knew all that his father was a Greek.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
- Romans 5:12,17 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and

- death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: 17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Galatians 2:4 (AV) And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:
- Strongs #5569 pseudadelphos *psyoo-dad'-el-fos* AV-false brother 2; 1) a false brother 2) one who ostentatiously professes to be a Christian, but is destitute of Christian knowledge and piety
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Galatians 2:4 (NKJV) And *this occurred* because of false brethren secretly brought in (who came in by stealth to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage),
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live. (not be in congregation of the Lord)
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Deuteronomy 13:3 Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;
- Galatians 2:5 (AV) To whom we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the truth of the gospel might continue with you.

- Galatians 1:17,18 Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus. 18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days.
- Galatians 2:5 (NKJV) to whom we did not yield submission even for an hour, that the truth of the gospel might continue with you.
- Exodus 32:26 Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.
- Galatians 2:6 (AV) But of these who seemed to be somewhat, (whatsoever they were, it maketh no matter to me: God accepteth no man's person:) for they who seemed to be somewhat in conference added nothing to me:
- Galatians 2:6 (NKJV) But from those who seemed to be something whatever they were, it makes no difference to me; God shows personal favoritism to no man for those who seemed *to be something* added nothing to me.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Galatians 2:7 (AV) But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as *the gospel* of the circumcision *was* unto Peter;
- Galatians 2:7 (NKJV) But on the contrary, when they saw that the gospel for the uncircumcised had been committed to me, as *the gospel* for the circumcised *was* to Peter
- Galatians 2:8 (AV) (For He that wrought effectually in Peter to the apostleship of the circumcision, the same was mighty in me toward the Gentiles:)
- Galatians 2:8 (NKJV) (for He who worked effectively in Peter for the apostleship to the circumcised also worked effectively in me toward the Gentiles),
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Galatians 2:9 (AV) And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we *should go* unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.
- Galatians 2:9 (NKJV) and when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that had been given to me, they gave me

- and Barnabas the right hand of fellowship, that we *should go* to the Gentiles and they to the circumcised.
- Mark 14:27 And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- **Deuteronomy 18:9-14 Referred to God's laws on the occult.**
- Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Galatians 2:10 (AV) Only *they would* that we should remember the poor; the same which I also was forward to do.
- Galatians 2:10 (NKJV) *They desired* only that we should remember the poor, the very thing which I also was eager to do.
- Galatians 2:4 (NKJV) And *this occurred* because of false brethren <5569> secretly brought in (who came in by stealth to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage),
- Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.
- 2 Corinthians 11:26 *In* journeyings often, *in* perils of waters, *in* perils of robbers, *in* perils by *mine own* countrymen, *in* perils by the heathen, *in* perils in the city, *in* perils in the wilderness, *in* perils in the sea, *in* perils among false brethren <5569>;
- Summarized of many of these instances when Paul was in peril.
- John 8:32,33 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. 33 They answered Him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest Thou, Ye shall be made free?
- Summarized of many instances when Israelites were in bondage.
- Romans 8:15 For ye have not received the <u>spirit of bondage again to fear;</u> but ye have received the <u>Spirit of adoption</u>, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- Proverbs 23:17 Let not thine heart envy sinners: but be thou in the fear of

- the LORD all the day long.
- Romans 8:21 Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Galatians 2:4 And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into <u>bondage</u>:
- Galatians 4:3 Even so we, when we were children, were in <u>bondage under</u> the elements of the world:
- Galatians 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?
- Galatians 4:24,25 Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar. 25 For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children.
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- 2 Peter 2:19 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the <u>servants of corruption</u>: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.
- Jude 1:3 (AV) Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should <u>earnestly contend for the faith</u> which was once delivered unto the saints.
- Jude 1:3 (NKJV) Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.
- Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
