

Withhold Not Good - Proverbs 3E

Exodus 20 The 10 Commandments - the first table was dealing with God and the table was dealing with mankind.

Proverbs 3:21,22 My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion: 22 So shall they be life unto thy soul, and grace to thy neck.

1 Kings 10:8 Happy are thy men, happy are these thy servants, which stand continually before thee, and that hear thy wisdom.

Proverbs 3:27-35 (AV) & (NKJV)

Proverbs 3:27 (AV) Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of thine hand to do *it*.

Luke 10 Summarized of the Parable of the Good Samaritan. V33 But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him,

Ephesians 6:20 For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Proverbs 3:27 (NKJV) Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, When it is in the power of your hand to do *so*.

John 12:3-5,8 Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment. 4 Then saith one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, which should betray him, 5 Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor? 8 For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.

Proverbs 3:28 (AV) Say not unto thy neighbour, Go, and come again, and to morrow I will give; when thou hast it by thee.

Proverbs 3:28 (NKJV) Do not say to your neighbor, Go, and come back, And tomorrow I will give *it*, When you have it with you.

1 Kings 3 Referred to Solomon judging with the 2 mothers & 1 live son.

Proverbs 3:29 (AV) Devise not evil against thy neighbour, seeing he dwelleth securely by thee.

Proverbs 3:29 (NKJV) Do not devise evil against your neighbor, For he dwells by you for safety's sake.

Proverbs 3:30 (AV) Strive not with a man without cause, if he have done thee no harm.

Proverbs 3:30 (NKJV) Do not strive with a man without cause, If he has done you no harm.

Proverbs 3:31 (AV) Envy thou not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways.

Proverbs 3:31 (NKJV) Do not envy the oppressor, And choose none of his ways;

Proverbs 3:32 (AV) For the froward *is* abomination to the LORD: but his secret *is* with the righteous.

Proverbs 3:32 (NKJV) For the perverse *person is* an abomination to the LORD, But His secret counsel *is* with the upright.

Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after Mine own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.

Proverbs 3:33 (AV) The curse of the LORD *is* in the house of the wicked: but He blesseth the habitation of the just.

Proverbs 3:33 (NKJV) The curse of the LORD *is* on the house of the wicked, But He blesses the home of the just.

Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

Deuteronomy 27&28 Referred to the Curses & Blessings proclaimed from the mountains.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Proverbs 3:34 (AV) Surely he scorneth the scorners: but he giveth grace unto the lowly.

Proverbs 3:34 (NKJV) Surely He scorns the scornful, But gives grace to the humble.

Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28 Referred to satan's 5 "I will's" & God's judgment on him.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

Proverbs 3:35 (AV) The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools.

Proverbs 3:35 (NKJV) The wise shall inherit glory, But shame shall be the legacy of fools.

Exodus 34:30,33 And when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone; and they were afraid to come nigh him.

33 And till Moses had done speaking with them, he put a vail on his face.

Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard Thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Mark 7:9-13 - V9,10 And He said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition. 10 For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death:

Proverbs 3:27 (NKJV) Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, When it is in the power of your hand to do so.

Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Mark 7:11 But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, It is Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; he shall be free.

Proverbs 3:28 (NKJV) Do not say to your neighbor, Go, and come back, And tomorrow I will give *it*, When you have it with you.

Corban was dedicated unto the Lord & yet still used by the owner.

Mark 7:12 And ye suffer him no more to do ought for his father or his mother; 13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.

Galatians 2:4 And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:

Matthew 15:5 But ye say, Whosoever shall say to *his* father or *his* mother, *It is a gift*, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me;

1 Timothy 5:4-8 But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to shew piety at home, and to requite (repay) their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God.

1 Timothy 5:3 Honour widows that are widows indeed.

John 19:26,27 When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, he saith unto his mother, Woman, behold thy son! 27 Then saith he to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own home.

1 Timothy 5:5-8 Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusteth in God, and continueth in supplications and prayers night and day. 6 But she that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth. 7 And these things give in charge, that they may be blameless. 8 But if any provide not for his own (family), and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.

John 34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men

know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.

**Proverbs 3:27 (NKJV) Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due,
When it is in the power of your hand to do so.**

Luke 11:5-7 And He said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves; 6 For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? 7 And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee.

Proverbs 3:28 (NKJV) Do not say to your neighbor, Go, and come back, And tomorrow I will give *it*, When you have it with you.

Luke 11:8 I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity (persistence) he will rise and give him as many as he needeth.

Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I *am* the LORD.

Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

2 Corinthians 13:11 Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

Matthew 23:11 But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.

Romans 12:18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all *men*, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Revelation 13 Referred to the mark of the beast.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

Matthew 5:3-11 - 3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 4 Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted. 5

Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. 6 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. 7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. 8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. 9 Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. 10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for My sake.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

John 14:1-3 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Romans 13:7 Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

Galatians 6:10 As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.

Titus 2:14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

James 2:15,16 If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food, 16 And one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit?

James 5:4 Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth.

Genesis 31:29 It is in the power of my hand to do you hurt: but the God of your father spake unto me yesternight, saying, Take thou heed that thou speak not to Jacob either good or bad.

Micah 2:1 Woe to them that devise iniquity, and work evil upon their beds! when the morning is light, they practise it, because it is in the power of their hand.
