- Proverbs 4:1 (AV) Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding.
- Proverbs 4:1 (NKJV) Hear, *my* children, the instruction of a father, And give attention to know understanding;
- Psalms 39:1 « To the chief Musician, even to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David. » I said, I will take heed to my ways, that I sin not with my tongue: I will keep my mouth with a bridle, while the wicked is before me.
- Proverbs 4:2 (AV) For I give you good doctrine, forsake ye not my law.
- Proverbs 4:2 (NKJV) For I give you good doctrine: Do not forsake my law.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Hebrews 5:13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.
- Proverbs 4:3 (AV) For I was my father's son, tender and only *beloved* in the sight of my mother.
- Proverbs 4:3 (NKJV) When I was my father's son, Tender and the only one in the sight of my mother,

- Referred to David's sons.
- Proverbs 4:4 (AV) He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live.
- Proverbs 4:4 (NKJV) He also taught me, and said to me: Let your heart retain my words; Keep my commands, and live.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

- Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.
- Proverbs 4:8 (AV) Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her.
- Proverbs 4:8 (NKJV) Exalt her, and she will promote you; She will bring you honor, when you embrace her.
- Daniel 1:20 And in all matters of wisdom and understanding, that the king enquired of them, he found them (Daniel & friends) ten times better than

- all the magicians and astrologers that were in all his realm.
- Referred to Joseph in Egypt being Godly & promoted.
- Proverbs 4:9 (AV) She shall give to thine head an ornament of grace: a crown of glory shall she deliver to thee.
- Proverbs 4:9 (NKJV) She will place on your head an ornament of grace; A crown of glory she will deliver to you.
- Titus 2:4 That they (aged women) may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- Proverbs 4:10 (AV) Hear, O my son, and receive my sayings; and the years of thy life shall be many.
- Proverbs 4:10 (NKJV) Hear, my son, and receive my sayings, And the years of your life will be many.
- Proverbs 4:11 (AV) I have taught thee in the way of wisdom; I have led thee in right paths.
- Proverbs 4:11 (NKJV) I have taught you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in right paths.
- 1 Kings 11:7,8 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that *is* before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. 8 And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.
- Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.
- Proverbs 4:12 (AV) When thou goest, thy steps shall not be straitened; and when thou runnest, thou shalt not stumble.
- Proverbs 4:12 (NKJV) When you walk, your steps will not be hindered, And when you run, you will not stumble.
- 2 Samuel 22:37 Thou hast enlarged my steps under me; so that my feet did not slip.
- Psalms 91:11,12 For He shall give His angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. 12 They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.
- Proverbs 4:13 (AV) Take fast hold of instruction; let *her* not go: keep her; for she *is* thy life.
- Proverbs 4:13 (NKJV) Take firm hold of instruction, do not let go; Keep her, for she *is* your life.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which

- leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

- Psalms 127:1-5 (AV) & (NKJV)

- Deuteronomy 11:22 (NKJV) For if you carefully keep all these commandments which I command you to do to love the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways, and to hold fast to Him —
- Deuteronomy 11:23 (AV) Then will the LORD drive out all these nations from before you, and ye shall possess greater nations and mightier than yourselves.
- Deuteronomy 11:23 (NKJV) then the LORD will drive out all these nations from before you, and you will dispossess greater and mightier nations than yourselves.
- Joshua 6-8 Summarized of Jericho Versus Ai when Israel Godly versus sinful.
- Deuteronomy 11:24 (AV) Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.
- Deuteronomy 11:24 (NKJV) Every place on which the sole of your foot treads shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the River Euphrates, even to the Western Sea, shall be your territory.
