

The Farewell Tribute Of David - Psalms 72

1 Chronicles 22:7-10 (Summarized) And David said to Solomon, My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build an house unto the Name of the LORD my God: 8 But the Word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thou hast shed blood abundantly, and hast made great wars: thou shalt not build an house unto My Name, because thou hast shed much blood upon the earth in My sight. 9 Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days. 10 He shall build an house for My Name; and he shall be My son, and I will be his Father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Psalms 127 & Psalms 72 David wrote these for Solomon.

Psalms 110:1 « A Psalm of David. » The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at My right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Joshua 3:7 And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee.

1 Timothy 2:1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, *and* giving of thanks, be made for all men;

2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's in perils list.

1 Chronicles 21 Summarized of David numbered Israel & God's judgment.

1 Timothy 2:2 For kings, and *for* all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Psalms 72:1 (NKJV) « *A Psalm* of Solomon. » Give the king Your judgments, O God, And Your righteousness to the king's Son.

1 Kings 3:9 Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge Thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this Thy so great a people?

Psalms 72:2 (AV) He shall judge Thy people with righteousness, and Thy poor with judgment.

Psalms 72:2 (NKJV) He will judge Your people with righteousness, And Your poor with justice.

Referred to Jesus' 1000 years rule.

Deuteronomy 17:18,19 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:

Deuteronomy 17:16,17 But he shall not multiply horses to himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt, to the end that he should multiply horses: forasmuch as the LORD hath said unto you, Ye shall henceforth return no more that way. 17 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold.

1 Kings 3 Summarized of Solomon judging the 1 baby & the 2 mothers.

Nehemiah 5 Summarized of the rich oppressing the poor.

Psalms 72:5 (AV) They shall fear Thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations.

Numbers 11 Summarized of Moses setting up the 70 elders.
