- John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.
- Proverbs 4:14-19 (AV) & (NKJV) Proverbs 4:14 (AV) Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil *men*.
- Proverbs 4:14 (NKJV) Do not enter the path of the wicked, And do not walk in the way of evil.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Judges 16 Referred to Samson in immorality lead to his downfall.
- Proverbs 22:1 A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.
- Proverbs 4:15 (AV) Avoid it, pass not by it, turn from it, and pass away.
- Proverbs4:15 (NKJV)Avoid it, do not travel on it; Turn away from it & pass on.
- Luke 15:17 And when he (prodigal son) came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- John 5:14 Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, & said to him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.

- 1 Timothy 6:20 (AV) O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:
- 1 Timothy 6:20 (NKJV) O Timothy! Guard what was committed to your trust, avoiding the profane *and* idle babblings and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge
- 2 Timothy 2:23 (AV) But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that

- they do gender strifes.
- 2 Timothy 2:23 (NKJV) But avoid foolish and ignorant disputes, knowing that they generate strife.
- Romans 14:1 Him that is weak in the faith receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
- Titus 3:9 (AV) But <u>avoid</u> foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.
- Titus 3:9 (NKJV) But avoid foolish disputes, genealogies, contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and useless.
- Acts 15:1,2,20 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question. 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Exodus 34:21 Six days thou shalt work, but on the seventh day thou shalt rest: in earing time and in harvest thou shalt rest.
- Romans 14:5,6 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind. 6 He that regardeth the day, regardeth it unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard it. - Strongs #1578 ekklino *ek-klee'-no* AV-eschew 1, avoid 1, go out of the way 1; 3 1) to turn aside, deviate (from the right way and course) 2) to turn (one's self) away, to turn away from, keep aloof from one's society 3) to shun one Proverbs 1:16 For their feet run to evil, and make haste to shed blood.
- Psalms 36:4 He deviseth mischief upon his bed; he setteth himself in a way that is not good; he abhorreth not evil.
- Isaiah 57:20 But the wicked *are* like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt.
- Micah 2:1 Woe to them that devise iniquity, and work evil upon their beds! when the morning is light, they practise it, because it is in the power of their hand.
- Luke 22:66 And as soon as it was day, the elders of the people & the chief priests & the scribes came together, & led Him into their council, saying,
- John 18:28 Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover.

- John 8:44 (NKJV) You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a liar and the father of it.
