- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

- 1 Corinthians 7:35 (AV) And this I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a snare upon you, but for that which is comely, and that ye may attend upon the Lord without distraction.
- 1 Corinthians 7:35 (NKJV) And this I say for your own profit, not that I may put a leash on you, but for what is proper, and that you may serve the Lord without distraction.
- Psalms 127:3 Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is His reward.
- Proverbs 2:16 To deliver thee from the <u>strange woman</u>, *even* from the <u>stranger which</u> flattereth with her words;
