

The Bewitching Powers Of Legalism - Galatians 3A

Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called
The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for
those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath
made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and
scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any
means hurt you.

Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet
shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

The theme of the letter to the Galatians was exposing

Galatians 2:4 And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who
came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that
they might bring us into bondage:

Luke 20:23 But He perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why
tempt ye Me?

Luke 21:15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your
adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.

Galatians 3:1-5 (AV) & (NKJV)

Galatians 3:1 (AV) O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye
should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been
evidently set forth, crucified among you?

Galatians 3:1 (NKJV) O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you
should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly
portrayed among you as crucified?

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's
clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Acts 19 Referred to the 7 sons of Sceva beat up by the demons V15 And the
evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who
are ye?

2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom
we have not preached, or *if* ye receive another spirit, which ye have not
received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well
bear with *him*.

Psalms 63:11 But the king shall rejoice in God; every one that sweareth by him shall glory: but the mouth of them that speak lies shall be stopped.

Matthew 23:17 Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?

Acts 8:9,10 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: 10 To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power of God.

Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

John 10:20 And many of them said, He hath a devil, and is mad; why hear ye Him?

Acts 26:24 And as he thus spake for himself, Festus said with a loud voice, Paul, thou art beside thyself; much learning doth make thee mad.

Acts 7:57 Then they cried out with a loud voice, and stopped their ears, and ran upon him with one accord,

Luke 8:35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

Galatians 3:4 (AV) Have ye suffered so many things in vain? if *it be* yet in vain.

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

Romans 14:1 Him that is weak in the faith receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations.

Strong's #940 baskaino *bas-kah'-ee-no* AV-bewitch 1; 1) to speak ill of one, to slander, traduce him 2) to bring evil on one by feigning praise or an evil eye 3) to charm, to bewitch

Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.

Genesis 3 Summarized of mankind's deception & fall.

1 Corinthians 10:14 Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry.

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy

God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils (demons) by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Matthew 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils.

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
