- Colossians 1:20,21 And, having made peace through the Blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. 21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Summarized of Jesus' resurrection.
- Matthew 28:2 And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it.
- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of the fall of mankind.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to God's 10 Commandments**
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- Numbers 22:12 And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed.
- Numbers 25 Referred to Balaam telling Balak how to get Israel to sin so God would curse them.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

- Matthew 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
- 1 Kings 11:3,4 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.
- 1 Kings 11:7,8 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that *is* before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. 8 And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.
- 1 Kings 14:21-31 V21 And Rehoboam the son of Solomon reigned in Judah. Rehoboam *was* forty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the LORD did choose out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his name there. And his mother's name *was* Naamah an Ammonitess.
- Summarized of Rehoboam following the young counselors & the splitting up of Israel.
- 2 Kings 21:4 And he built altars in the house of the LORD, of which the LORD said, In Jerusalem will I put My Name.
- 1 Kings 14:22 And Judah did evil in the sight of the LORD, and they provoked him to jealousy with their sins which they had committed, above all that their fathers had done.
- Psalms 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.
- Exodus 34:14 For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose Name is Jealous, is a jealous God:
- Ex 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me;
- Deuteronomy 23:2 A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD.
- Referred to the Judges of Israel turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc. and it got worse each time.
- 1 Kings 14:23 For they also built them high places, and images, and groves, on every high hill, and under every green tree.
- Leviticus 26:1 Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in

- your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they (god's angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
- 1 Kings 14:24 And there were also sodomites in the land: *and* they did according to all the abominations of the nations which the LORD cast out before the children of Israel.
- Leviticus 18 & 20 Referred to God's laws on immorality.
- Jeremiah 18 Referred to the potter & the clay.
- Job 1:10 Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land.
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- 1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.
- Exodus 32 Summarized of Israel sinning with the golden calf & Moses interceeding.
- Deut 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- 1 Kings 14:25-30 And it came to pass in the fifth year of king Rehoboam, that Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem: 26 And he took away the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house; he even took away all: and he took away all the shields of gold which Solomon had made. 27 And king Rehoboam made in their stead brasen (bronze) shields, and committed them unto the hands of the chief of the guard, which kept the door of the king's house. 28 And it was so, when the king went into the house of the LORD, that the guard bare them, and brought them back into the guard chamber. 29 Now the rest of the acts of Rehoboam, and all that he did, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? 30 And there was war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam all their days.
- Summarized of Jeroboam ruling the 10 tribes & the calf statues for them to worship.
- 1 Kings 14:31 And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And his mother's name was Naamah an Ammonitess. And Abijam his son reigned in his stead.
- 1 Kings 14:22 And Judah did evil in the sight of the LORD, and they

- provoked him to jealousy with their <u>sins</u> which they had committed, above all that their fathers had done.
- 1 Kings 15:26 And he <u>did evil in the sight of the LORD</u>, and walked in the way of his father, and in his <u>sin</u> wherewith he made Israel to <u>sin</u>.
- 1 Kings 15:34 And he <u>did evil in the sight of the LORD</u>, and walked in the way of Jeroboam, and in his <u>sin</u> wherewith he made Israel to <u>sin</u>.
- 1 Kings 16:19 For his <u>sins</u> which he <u>sinned in doing evil in the sight of the LORD</u>, in walking in the way of Jeroboam, and in his <u>sin</u> which he did, to make Israel to sin.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- 1 Kings 22:52 And <u>he did evil in the sight of the LORD</u>, and walked in the way of his father, and in the way of his mother, and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to <u>sin</u>:
- 2 Kings 13:2 And he <u>did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD</u>, and followed the <u>sins</u> of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, which made Israel to <u>sin</u>; he departed not therefrom.
- 2 Kings 13:11 And he <u>did that which was</u> evil in the <u>sight of the LORD</u>; he departed not from all the <u>sins</u> of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel <u>sin</u>: *but* he walked therein.
- 2 Kings 14:24 And he <u>did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD</u>: he departed not from all the <u>sins</u> of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.
- 2 Kings 15:9 And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, as his fathers had done: he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.
- 2 Kings 15:18 And <u>he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD</u>: he departed not all his days from the <u>sins</u> of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.
- 2 Kings 15:24 And <u>he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD</u>: he departed not from the <u>sins</u> of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.
- 2 Kings 15:28 And <u>he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD</u>: he departed not from the <u>sins</u> of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.
- 2 Kings 21:16 Moreover Manasseh shed innocent blood very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; beside his <u>sin</u> wherewith he made Judah to sin, in doing *that which was* evil in the sight of the

LORD.

Summarized of Manasseh's repentance & turning back to God.

- 1 Kings 13 Referred to the prophesy of Josiah to clean up Israel.
- 1 Chronicles 21:17 And David said unto <u>God</u>, *Is it* not I *that* commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have <u>sinned</u> and done <u>evil</u> indeed; but *as for* these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, O <u>LORD</u> my <u>God</u>, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on thy people, that they should be plagued.
- Ecclesiastes 8:12 Though a <u>sinner</u> do <u>evil</u> an hundred times, and his *days* be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear <u>God</u>, which fear before him:
- Matthew 18:21,22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Isaiah 1:4 Ah <u>sinful</u> nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of <u>evildoers</u>, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the <u>LORD</u>, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.
- Jeremiah 16:10 And it shall come to pass, when thou shalt shew this people all these words, and they shall say unto thee, Wherefore hath the <u>LORD</u> pronounced all this great <u>evil</u> against us? or what *is* our iniquity? or what *is* our sin that we have committed against the LORD our God?
- Psalms 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Jeremiah 44:23 Because ye have burned incense, and because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD, nor walked in his law, nor in his statutes, nor in his testimonies; therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day.
- Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Acts 15:5 But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses.
- Galatians 1:4 Who gave Himself for our <u>sins</u>, that He might deliver us from this present <u>evil</u> world, according to the will of <u>God</u> and our Father:

- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
