- Fausset's Bible Dictionary SURETISHIP Person for person. {Gen 43:9} The hand was given in token of undertaking the office or becoming responsible for a debt: {Job 17:13; Prov 6:1; Ps 119:122; Isa 38:14} "undertake (harbeeniy) for me," Hebrew "be surety for me." Christ is the "surety (enguos) of a better testament"; {Heb 7:22; 9:11-15} Jer 30:21, "who is this that engaged his heart to approach unto Me?" literally, pledged his life, a thing unique: Messiah alone made His life responsible for ours. "Heart" implies the courage it needed to undertake such a tremendous suretiship; the question implies admiration at His union of Godhead and manhood qualifying Him for the work.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 2 Timothy 2&3 Referred to Paul warning Timothy to watch out for some bad people.

- Jeremiah 30:21 (AV) And their nobles shall be of themselves, and their governor shall proceed from the midst of them; and I will cause him to draw near, and he shall approach unto Me: for who *is* this that engaged <06148> his heart to approach unto Me? saith the LORD.
