

The Children Of Belial - Proverbs 6D

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Proverbs 6 Summarized of Solomon's admonitions in this chapter.

Proverbs 6:12 A naughty <01100> person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth.

Proverbs 6:12 (NKJV) A worthless person, a wicked man, Walks with a perverse mouth;

Strong's #01100 beliya'al *bel-e-yah'-al* AV-Belial 16, wicked 5, ungodly 3, evil 1, naughty 1 ungodly men 1; 27 1) worthlessness 1a) worthless, good for nothing, unprofitable, base fellow 1b) wicked 1c) ruin, destruction (construct).

1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

Genesis 3:16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

Ephesians 2:21 In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:

2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

Psalms 110:1 « A Psalm of David. » The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Strong's #955 Belial *bel-ee'-al* or Beliar *bel-ee'-ar* AV-Belial 1; Belial = worthless or wicked 1) a name of Satan

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Psalms 139:23,24 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: 24 24 And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Deuteronomy 13:13 *Certain* men, the children of Belial <01100>, are gone out from among you, and have withdrawn the inhabitants of their city, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which ye have not known;

Deuteronomy 13:13 (NKJV) Corrupt men have gone out from among you and enticed the inhabitants of their city, saying, Let us go and serve other gods — which you have not known

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy

God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...

Deuteronomy 15:9 Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked <01100> heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

Deuteronomy 15:9 (NKJV) Beware lest there be a wicked thought in your heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand, and your eye be evil against your poor brother and you give him nothing, and he cry out to the LORD against you, and it become sin among you.

Referred to the sale of land with reference to the year of release.

Judges 19:22 Now as they were making their hearts merry, behold, the men of the city, certain sons of Belial <01100>, beset the house round about, *and* beat at the door, and spake to the master of the house, the old man, saying, Bring forth the man that came into thine house, that we may know him.

Judges 19 Summarized of the Levite man threatened with rape.

Leviticus 18 Referred to God's laws on immorality.

Judges 19:22 (NKJV) As they were enjoying themselves, suddenly certain men of the city, perverted men, surrounded the house *and* beat on the door. They spoke to the master of the house, the old man, saying, Bring out the man who came to your house, that we may know him *carnally!*

Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

Acts 15:19,20 Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Judges 20:13 Now therefore deliver *us* the men, the children of Belial <01100>, which *are* in Gibeah, that we may put them to death, and put away evil from Israel. But the children of Benjamin would not hearken to the voice of their brethren the children of Israel:

Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

Pray confessing sins & of ancestors & of those affiliated with & of leaders.

Numbers Summarized of David numbering Israel & God's judgment.

1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers,

intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

Judges 20:13 (NKJV) Now therefore, deliver up the men, the perverted men who *are* in Gibeah, that we may put them to death and remove the evil from Israel! But the children of Benjamin would not listen to the voice of their brethren, the children of Israel.

1 Samuel 1:16 Count not thine handmaid for a daughter of Belial <01100>: for out of the abundance of my complaint and grief have I spoken hitherto.

1 Samuel 1:16 (NKJV) Do not consider your maidservant a wicked woman, for out of the abundance of my complaint and grief I have spoken until now.

1 Samuel 1:13-16 Now Hannah, she spake in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she had been drunken.

14 And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee. **15** And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I *am* a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD. **16** Count not thine handmaid for a daughter of Belial: for out of the abundance of my complaint and grief have I spoken hitherto.

1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?

1 Samuel 2:12 Now the sons of Eli *were* sons of Belial <01100>; they knew not the LORD.

1 Samuel 2:12(NKJV) Now the sons of Eli *were* corrupt; they did not know the LORD.

1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

Revelation 2 & 3 Referred to the letters to the 7 churches.

Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Acts 6:3,4 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business. **4** But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word.

1 Samuel 10:27 But the children of Belial <01100> said, How shall this man save us? And they despised him, and brought him no presents. But he held

his peace.

- 1 Samuel 10:27 (NKJV) But some rebels said, How can this man save us? So they despised him, and brought him no presents. But he held his peace.
- 2 Samuel 6:16 And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart.
- 1 Samuel 25:17 Now therefore know and consider what thou wilt do; for evil is determined against our master, and against all his household: for he *is such* a son of Belial <01100>, that *a man* cannot speak to him.
- 1 Samuel 25:17 (NKJV) Now therefore, know and consider what you will do, for harm is determined against our master and against all his household. For he *is such* a scoundrel that *one* cannot speak to him.
- 1 Samuel 25 Summarized of Nabal, Abigail & David's men.
- Jeremiah 5:3 O LORD, are not Thine eyes upon the truth? Thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; Thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- 1 Samuel 25:25 Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial <01100>, *even* Nabal: for as his name *is*, so *is* he; Nabal *is* his name, and folly *is* with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send.
- 1 Samuel 25:25 (NKJV) Please, let not my lord regard this scoundrel Nabal. For as his name *is*, so *is* he: Nabal *is* his name, and folly *is* with him. But I, your maidservant, did not see the young men of my lord whom you sent.
- Acts 5:1-10 But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, 2 And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet. 3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? 4 Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. 5 And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things. 6 And the young men arose, wound him up, and carried him out, and buried him. 7 And it was about the space of three hours after, when his wife, not knowing what was done, came in. 8 And Peter answered unto her, Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much? And she said, Yea, for so much. 9 Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out. 10 Then fell she down

straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband.

1 Samuel 30:22 Then answered all the wicked men and *men* of Belial <01100>, of those that went with David, and said, Because they went not with us, we will not give them *ought* of the spoil that we have recovered, save to every man his wife and his children, that they may lead *them* away, and depart.

1 Samuel 30 Summarized of Ziklag attacked & all rescued.

1 Samuel 30:22 (NKJV) Then all the wicked and worthless men of those who went with David answered and said, Because they did not go with us, we will not give them *any* of the spoil that we have recovered, except for every man's wife and children, that they may lead *them* away and depart.

2 Samuel 16:7 And thus said Shimei when he cursed, Come out, come out, thou bloody man, and thou man of Belial <01100>:

2 Samuel 16:7 (NKJV) Also Shimei said thus when he cursed: Come out! Come out! You bloodthirsty man, you rogue!

Referred to David fleeing from Absalom.

2 Samuel 20:1 And there happened to be there a man of Belial <01100>, whose name *was* Sheba, the son of Bichri, a Benjamite: and he blew a trumpet, and said, We have no part in David, neither have we inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to his tents, O Israel.

2 Samuel 20:1 (NKJV) And there happened to be there a rebel, whose name *was* Sheba the son of Bichri, a Benjamite. And he blew a trumpet, and said: We have no share in David, Nor do we have inheritance in the son of Jesse; Every man to his tents, O Israel!

Referred to Israel leaving Rehoboam for too high taxes.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

2 Samuel 22:5 When the waves of death compassed me, the floods of ungodly men <01100> made me afraid;

2 Samuel 22:5 (NKJV) When the waves of death surrounded me, The floods of ungodliness made me afraid.

2 Samuel 23:6 But *the sons* of Belial <01100> *shall be* all of them as thorns thrust away, because they cannot be taken with hands:

2 Samuel 23:6 (NKJV) But *the sons* of rebellion *shall all be* as thorns thrust away, Because they cannot be taken with hands.

1 Kings 21:10 And set two men, sons of Belial <01100>, before him, to bear witness against him, saying, Thou didst blaspheme God and the king. And

***then* carry him out, and stone him, that he may die.**

1 Kings 21:10 (NKJV) and seat two men, scoundrels, before him to bear witness against him, saying, You have blasphemed God and the king.

***Then* take him out, and stone him, that he may die.**

1 Kings 21 Summarized of Jezebel, Ahab & Naboth's vineyard.

1 Kings 21:13 And there came in two men, children of Belial <01100>, and sat before him: and the men of Belial <01100> witnessed against him, *even* against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying, Naboth did blaspheme God and the king. Then they carried him forth out of the city, and stoned him with stones, that he died.

1 Kings 21:13 (NKJV) And two men, scoundrels, came in and sat before him; and the scoundrels witnessed against him, against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying, Naboth has blasphemed God and the king! Then they took him outside the city and stoned him with stones, so that he died.

Deuteronomy 19:18,19 And the judges shall make diligent inquisition: and, behold, if the witness be a false witness, and hath testified falsely against his brother; 19 Then shall ye do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shalt thou put the evil away from among you.

2 Chronicles 13:7 And there are gathered unto him vain men, the children of Belial <01100>, and have strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and tenderhearted, and could not withstand them.

2 Chronicles 13:7 (NKJV) Then worthless rogues gathered to him, and strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and inexperienced and could not withstand them.

1 Kings 12 Summarized of Jeroboam & his false religion.

Exodus 32 Referred to Moses dealing with Israel for the golden calf idol.

Job 34:18 *Is it fit* to say to a king, *Thou art* wicked <01100>? *and* to princes, *Ye are* ungodly?

Job 34:18 (NKJV) *Is it fitting* to say to a king, *You are* worthless, *And* to nobles, *You are* wicked?

Luke 13:32 And he said unto them, Go ye, and tell (Herod) that fox, Behold, I cast out devils, and I do cures to day and to morrow, and the third day I shall be perfected.

Mark 6:17 For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her.

Psalms 18:4 The sorrows of death compassed me, and the floods of ungodly men <01100> made me afraid.

Psalms 18:4 (NKJV) The pangs of death surrounded me, And the floods of ungodliness made me afraid.

Psalms 41:8 An evil <01100> disease, *say they*, cleaveth fast unto him: and *now* that he lieth he shall rise up no more.

Psalms 41:8 (NKJV) An evil disease, *they say*, clings to him. And *now* that he lies down, he will rise up no more.

Psalms 101:3 I will set no wicked <01100> thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside; *it* shall not cleave to me.

Psalms 101:3 (NKJV) I will set nothing wicked before my eyes; I hate the work of those who fall away; It shall not cling to me.

Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.

2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

Proverbs 16:27 (NKJV) An ungodly man digs up evil, And *it is* on his lips like a burning fire.

Proverbs 19:28 An ungodly <01100> witness scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.

Proverbs 19:28 (NKJV) A disreputable witness scorns justice, And the mouth of the wicked devours iniquity.

Nahum 1:11 There is *one* come out of thee, that imagineth evil against the LORD, a wicked <01100> counsellor.

Nahum 1:11 (NKJV) From you comes forth *one* who plots evil against the LORD, A wicked counselor.

Nahum 1:15 Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace! O Judah, keep thy solemn feasts, perform thy vows: for the wicked <01100> shall no more pass through thee; he is utterly cut off.

Nahum 1:15 (NKJV) Behold, on the mountains The feet of him who brings good tidings, Who proclaims peace! O Judah, keep your appointed feasts, Perform your vows. For the wicked one shall no more pass through you; He is utterly cut off.
