- Colossians 1:13,14 Who hath <u>delivered us from the power of darkness</u>, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of His dear Son: 14 In Whom we have redemption through His Blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

- Hebrews 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.
- Colossians 1:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the Firstborn of every creature:
- John 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known Me, Philip? he that hath seen Me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?
- Colossians 1:16 For by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him:
- John 19:11 Jesus answered, Thou (Pilate) couldest have no power at all against Me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered Me unto thee hath the greater sin.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

More Service Notes:

- Colossians 1:17-20 And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist. 18 And He is the Head of the body, the church: Who is the beginning, the Firstborn from the dead; that in all *things* He might have the preeminence. 19 For it pleased *the Father* that in Him should all fulness dwell; 20 And, having made peace through the Blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, *I say*, whether *they be* things in earth, or things in heaven.
- Titus 2:14 Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.
- Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of *His* glory, and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the Word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high:
- Hebrews 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His Own Blood He entered in once into the Holy Place, having obtained eternal redemption *for us*.
- Hebrews 9:15 And for this cause He is the Mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions *that* were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the

- promise of eternal inheritance.
- 1 Peter 1:18-20 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; 19 But with the precious Blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: 20 Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,
- 1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the Just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:
- Revelation 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for Thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by Thy Blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;
- Revelation 14:3 And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred *and* forty *and* four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.
- Galatians 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.
- Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
- John 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on His Name:
- Romans 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.
- Romans 8:23 And not only *they*, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, *to wit*, the redemption of our body.
