How God Hates Belial - Proverbs 6E

- Proverbs 6 Summarized the charastics of Belial thus far.
- Proverbs 6:16 These six *things* doth the LORD hate: yea, seven *are* an abomination unto Him:
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Mark 5 & Luke 8 Referred to the Gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; ...
- Proverbs 6:17-19 A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, 18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, 19 A false witness *that* speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.
- Strongs #08130 sane' saw-nay' AV-hate 136, enemies 3, enemy 2, foes 1, hateful 1, misc 3; 146 1) to hate, be hateful 1a) (Qal) to hate 1a1) of man 1a2) of God 1a3) hater, one hating, enemy (participle) (subst) 1b) (Niphal) to be hated 1c) (Piel) hater (participle) 1c1) of persons, nations, God, wisdom.
- Strongs #08441 tow'ebah *to-ay-baw'* or to'ebah *to-ay-baw'* AV-abomination 113, abominable thing 2, abominable 2; 117 1) a disgusting thing, abomination, abominable 1a) in ritual sense (of unclean food, idols, mixed marriages) 1b) in ethical sense (of wickedness etc)
- John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Deuteronomy 1:27 And ye murmured in your tents, and said, Because the LORD hated us, He hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.
- Exodus 17:4 And Moses cried unto the LORD, saying, What shall I do unto this people? they be almost ready to stone me.
- Summarized of many miracles God did for the Israelites coming out of Egypt.
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 9:28 Lest the land whence Thou broughtest us out say, Because the <u>LORD</u> was not able to bring them into the land which He promised them, and because He <u>hated</u> them, He hath brought them out to slay them in the wilderness.

- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Acts 5 Referred to God judging Ananias & Sapphira.
- Galatians 3:24,25 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. 25 But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.
- Deuteronomy 12:31 Thou shalt not do so unto the <u>LORD</u> thy <u>God</u>: for every abomination to the <u>LORD</u>, which He <u>hateth</u>, have they done unto their gods; for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 (Summarized) V9 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, ...
- Luke 9:26 For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father's, and of the holy angels.
- Deuteronomy 16:22 Neither shalt thou set thee up *any* image; which the <u>LORD</u> thy <u>God</u> <u>hateth</u>.
- Job 37-39 Referred to Job questioning God & His reply.
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- 1 Kings 18 Summarized of the shoot-out on Mount Carmel between Baal & the Lord God V39 And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, He is the God; the LORD, He is the God.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Psalms 11:5 The <u>LORD</u> trieth (tests) the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence His soul <u>hateth</u>.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Psalms 45:7 Thou lovest righteousness, and <u>hatest</u> wickedness: therefore <u>God</u>, thy <u>God</u>, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.
- Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of

- wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
- Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
- Proverbs 1:29 For that they <u>hated</u> knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD:
- Proverbs 6:16 These six *things* doth the <u>LORD</u> <u>hate</u>: yea, seven *are* an abomination unto Him:
- Proverbs 8:13 The fear of the <u>LORD</u> is to <u>hate</u> evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward (perverse) mouth, do I <u>hate</u>.
- Luke 4 Jesus quoted Isaiah 61:1-3 Luke 4:21 And He began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.
- Isaiah 61:8 For I the <u>LORD</u> love judgment, I <u>hate</u> robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.
- Malachi 1:8 And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.
- Amos 6:8 The <u>Lord GOD</u> hath sworn by Himself, saith the <u>LORD</u> the <u>God</u> of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and <u>hate</u> his palaces: therefore will I deliver up the city with all that is therein.
- Jeremiah 21:5 And I myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger, and in fury, and in great wrath.
- Zechariah 8:17 And let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbour; and love no false oath: for all these *are things* that I <u>hate</u>, saith the <u>LORD</u>.
- Malachi 2:16 For the <u>LORD</u>, the <u>God</u> of Israel, saith that He <u>hateth</u> putting away : for *one* covereth violence with his garment, saith the <u>LORD</u> of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously.
- Malachi 2:16 For the LORD God of Israel says That He hates divorce, For it covers one's garment with violence, Says the LORD of hosts. Therefore take heed to your spirit, That you do not deal treacherously.
- Mark 10:4-9 And they said, Moses suffered to write a bill of divorcement, and to put her away. 5 And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the hardness of your heart he wrote you this precept. 6 But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. 7 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife; 8 And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh. 9 What

- therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.
- Hebrews 1:9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and <u>hated</u> iniquity; therefore <u>God</u>, *even* thy <u>God</u>, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.
- Romans 7:7 What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Referred to David tested as he kept 1 step ahead of Saul wanting to kill him.
- Luke 18 Summarized of the account of the pharisee & the publican.
- Luke 10 Summarized of the parable of the Good Samaritan.
- Matthew 23:13 But <u>woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in *yourselves*, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.
- Luke 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not with Me scattereth.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 23:14 <u>Woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am

- meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Matthew 23:15 <u>Woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.
- Matthew 23:16 <u>Woe</u> unto you, *ye* blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor!
- Matthew 23:23 <u>Woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier *matters* of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.
- **Explained the mis-use of Corban.**
- Matthew 23:25 <u>Woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.
- Matthew 23:27 <u>Woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead *men's* bones, and of all uncleanness.
- Matthew 23:29-32 <u>Woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous, 30 And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets. 31 Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets. 32 Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me;
- Acts 8, 13, & 19, has 3 examples of casting out demons after Jesus ascended.
- 1 Corinthians 9:16 For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, <u>woe</u> is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!
- Jude 1:11 <u>Woe</u> unto them (Christians)! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the

- gainsaying of Core.
- Numbers 23-25 Summary of Balaam.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Revelation 8:13 And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, <u>Woe</u>, <u>woe</u>, to the inhabiters of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!
- Revelation 9:12 One <u>woe</u> is past; *and*, behold, there come two woes more hereafter.
- Revelation 11:14 The second <u>woe</u> is past; *and*, behold, the third <u>woe</u> cometh quickly.
- Revelation 12:12 Therefore rejoice, *ye* heavens, and ye that dwell in them.

 <u>Woe</u> to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.
- Matthew 24:22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.
- Mark 7:2023 And He said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man.
- Mark 7:21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,
- Mark 7:22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:
- Mark 7:23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
