Belial And Hands That Shed Innocent Blood - Proverbs 6H

- Proverbs 6:12 A naughty (Belial) person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth.
- Proverbs 6:16-19 These six *things* doth the LORD hate: yea, seven *are* an abomination unto him: 17 A proud look, a lying tongue, and <u>hands that shed innocent blood</u>, 18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, 19 A false witness *that* speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.
- Psalms 24:1 « A Psalm of David. » The earth is the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

- Genesis 4:7-9 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him. 8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him. 9 And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?
- Mark 10:13,14,16 And they (Mothers of Salem) brought young children to Him, that He should touch them: and His disciples rebuked those that brought them. 14 But when Jesus saw it, He was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto Me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.16 And He took them up in His arms, put His hands upon them, and blessed them.

- Referred to Jezebel's evilness & God's judgment on her.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Deuteronomy 19:10 That innocent blood be not shed in thy land, which the

LORD thy God giveth thee *for* an inheritance, and *so* <u>blood</u> be upon thee. Numbers 35:6 Summarized of the cities of Refuge.

Leviticus 24:20 Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done to him again.

Ezekiel 33 Explained of the role of the watchman.

Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

- 1 Kings 2:31-33 And the king said unto him, Do as he hath said, and fall upon him, and bury him; that thou mayest take away the innocent blood, which Joab shed, from me, and from the house of my father. 32 And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing thereof, to wit, Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah. 33 Their blood shall therefore return upon the head of Joab, and upon the head of his seed for ever: but upon David, and upon his seed, and upon his house, and upon his throne, shall there be peace for ever from the LORD.
- 2 Kings 21:16 Moreover Manasseh shed innocent blood very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; beside his sin wherewith he made Judah to sin, in doing that which was evil in the sight of the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 33 Summarized of Manasseh repenting & God's forgiveness.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- 2 Kings 24:4 And also for the <u>innocent blood that he shed</u>: for he <u>filled</u>
 Jerusalem with innocent blood; which the LORD would not pardon.
- 1 Kings 18 Referred to the shoot-out of God vs Baal.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- Psalms 106:38 And <u>shed innocent blood</u>, *even* the <u>blood</u> of their sons and of their daughters, whom they <u>sacrificed unto the idols</u> of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood.
- Deuteronomy 21 Summarized of the law for a man slain in the field.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...

- Proverbs 6:17 A proud look, a lying tongue, and <u>hands that shed innocent</u> <u>blood</u>,
- Isaiah 59:7 Their feet run to evil, and they <u>make haste to shed innocent</u> <u>blood</u>: their thoughts *are* thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction *are* in their paths.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Leviticus 24:17 And he that killeth any man shall surely be put to death.
- Jeremiah 7:6 *If* ye oppress not the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and <u>shed not innocent blood</u> in this place, neither walk after other gods to your hurt:
- Jeremiah 22:3 Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.
- Jeremiah 22:17 But thine eyes and thine heart *are* not but for thy covetousness, and <u>for to shed innocent blood</u>, and for oppression, and for violence, to do *it*.
- Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- Joel 3:19 Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence *against* the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.
- Psalms 106:34-48 V34-37 They did not destroy the nations, concerning whom the LORD commanded them: 35 But were mingled among the heathen, and learned their works. (Violating Deuteronomy 18:9-14) 36 And they served their idols: which were a snare unto them. (Violating Exodus 20) 37 Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils,
- Revelation 9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:
- Psalms 106:38,39 And shed innocent blood, *even* the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood. 39 Thus were they defiled with

- their own works, and went a whoring with their own inventions.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Psalms 106:40 Therefore was the wrath of the LORD kindled against His people, insomuch that He abhorred His own inheritance.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- Psalms 106:41 And He gave them into the hand of the heathen; and they that hated them ruled over them.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God's judging evil Israel.
- Psalms 106:42,43 Their enemies also oppressed them, and they were brought into subjection under their hand. 43 Many times did He deliver them; but they provoked *Him* with their counsel, and were brought low for their iniquity.
- Summarized of the Judges. When Israel was obedient, God blessed them. When they went after other gods, God punished them into slavery. When they turned back to God, God sent a judge to free them.
- Psalms 106:44 Nevertheless He regarded their affliction, when He heard their cry:
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Psalms 106:45 And He remembered for them His covenant, and repented according to the multitude of His mercies.
- Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such deliverance as this;
- Psalms 106:46-48 He made them also to be pitied of all those that carried them captives. 47 Save us, O LORD our God, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto Thy Holy Name, *and* to triumph in Thy praise. 48 Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting: and let all the people say, Amen. Praise ye the LORD.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve

Me.

- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Isaiah 59:1-8 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither His ear heavy, that it cannot hear: 2 But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you, that He will not hear. 3 For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness. 4 None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. 5 They hatch cockatrice' eggs, and weave the spider's web: he that eateth of their eggs dieth, and that which is crushed breaketh out into a viper. 6 Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works are works of iniquity, and the act of violence is in their hands. 7 Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction are in their paths. 8 The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goeth therein shall not know peace.
- Numbers 35:33 So ye shall not <u>pollute the land</u> wherein ye *are*: for <u>blood it</u> <u>defileth the land</u>: and the <u>land</u> cannot be cleansed of the <u>blood</u> that is shed therein, but by the <u>blood</u> of him that shed it.
- Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live.
- John 8:7,9,11 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. 9 And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst. 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Psalms 106:38 And shed innocent <u>blood</u>, <u>even</u> the <u>blood</u> of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the <u>land</u> was <u>polluted</u> with <u>blood</u>.
- Ezekiel 36:18 Wherefore I poured My fury upon them for the <u>blood</u> that they had shed upon the <u>land</u>, and for their idols *wherewith* they had <u>polluted</u> it:
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.
- Luke 22:19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Matthew 23:35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.
- Matthew 26:28 For this is <u>My Blood of the new testament</u>, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
- Mark 14:24 And He said unto them, This is <u>My Blood of the new testament</u>, which is shed for many.
- Luke 11:50 That the <u>blood</u> of all the prophets, which was <u>shed</u> from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation;
- Luke 22:20 Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, <u>This cup is the new testament in My Blood, which is shed for you</u>.
- Acts 22:20 And when the <u>blood</u> of thy martyr Stephen was <u>shed</u>, I also was standing by, and consenting unto his death, and kept the raiment of them that slew him.
- Romans 3:15 Their <u>feet are swift to shed blood</u>:
- Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with <u>blood</u>; and <u>without shedding of blood is no remission</u>.
- Revelation 16:6 For they have <u>shed the blood of saints and prophets</u>, and thou hast given them <u>blood</u> to drink; for they are worthy.
- Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
